So we all ran around the playground telling the boys in our class about the Toilet Ghost and the **JUICE BAN.**





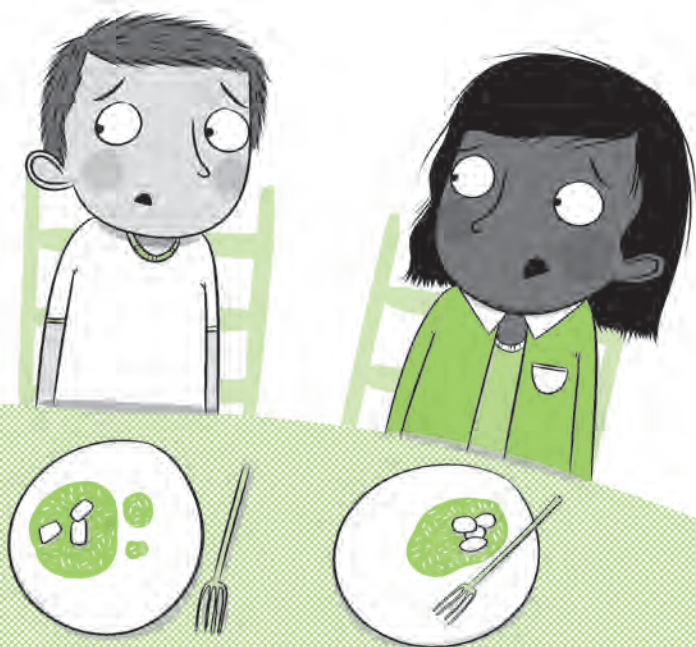
But then at lunch all the boys got **REALLY** thirsty because it was Chicken Curry day and everyone had Spicy Mouth.
