I have no friends.

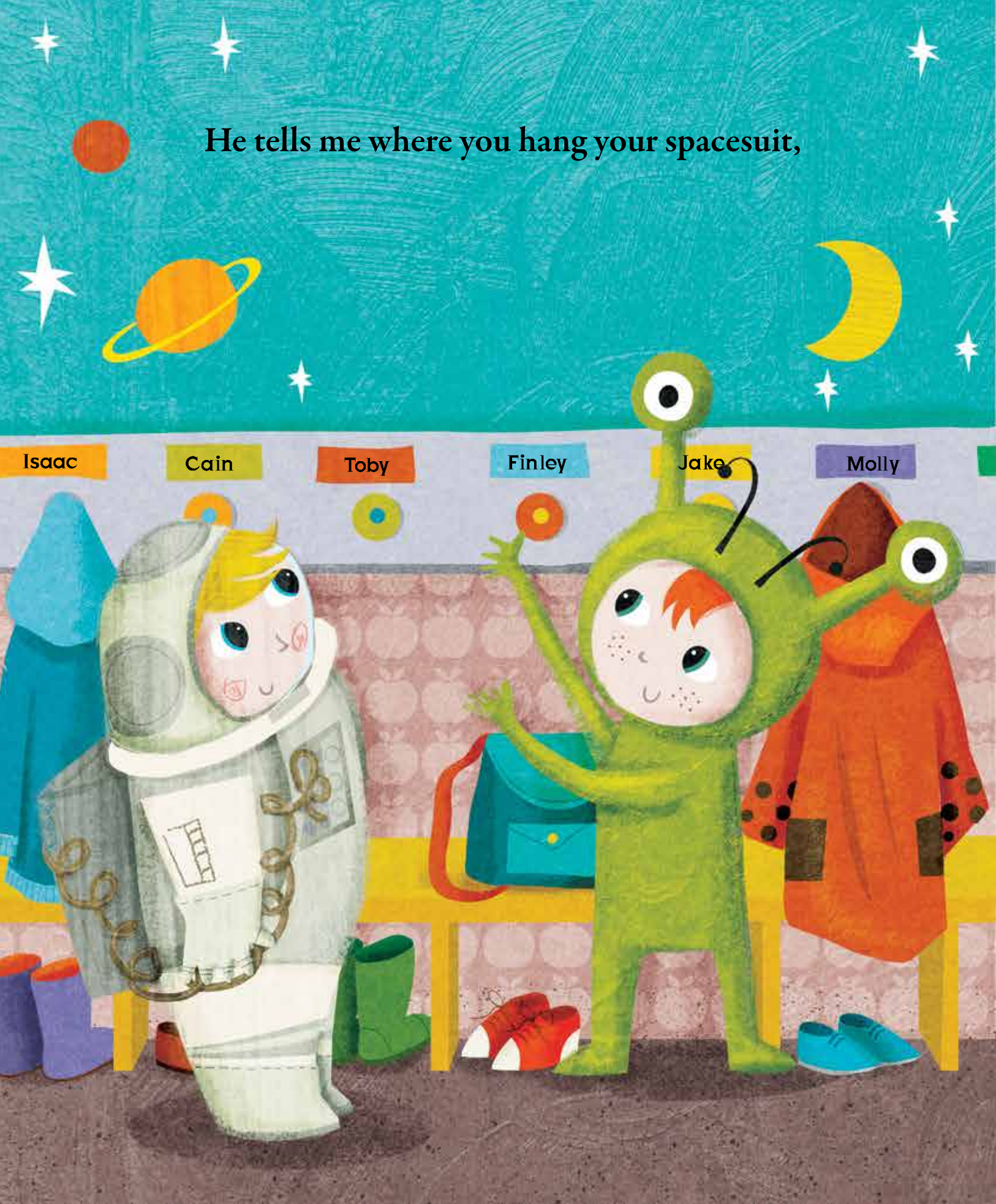
And I don't know my way around.
