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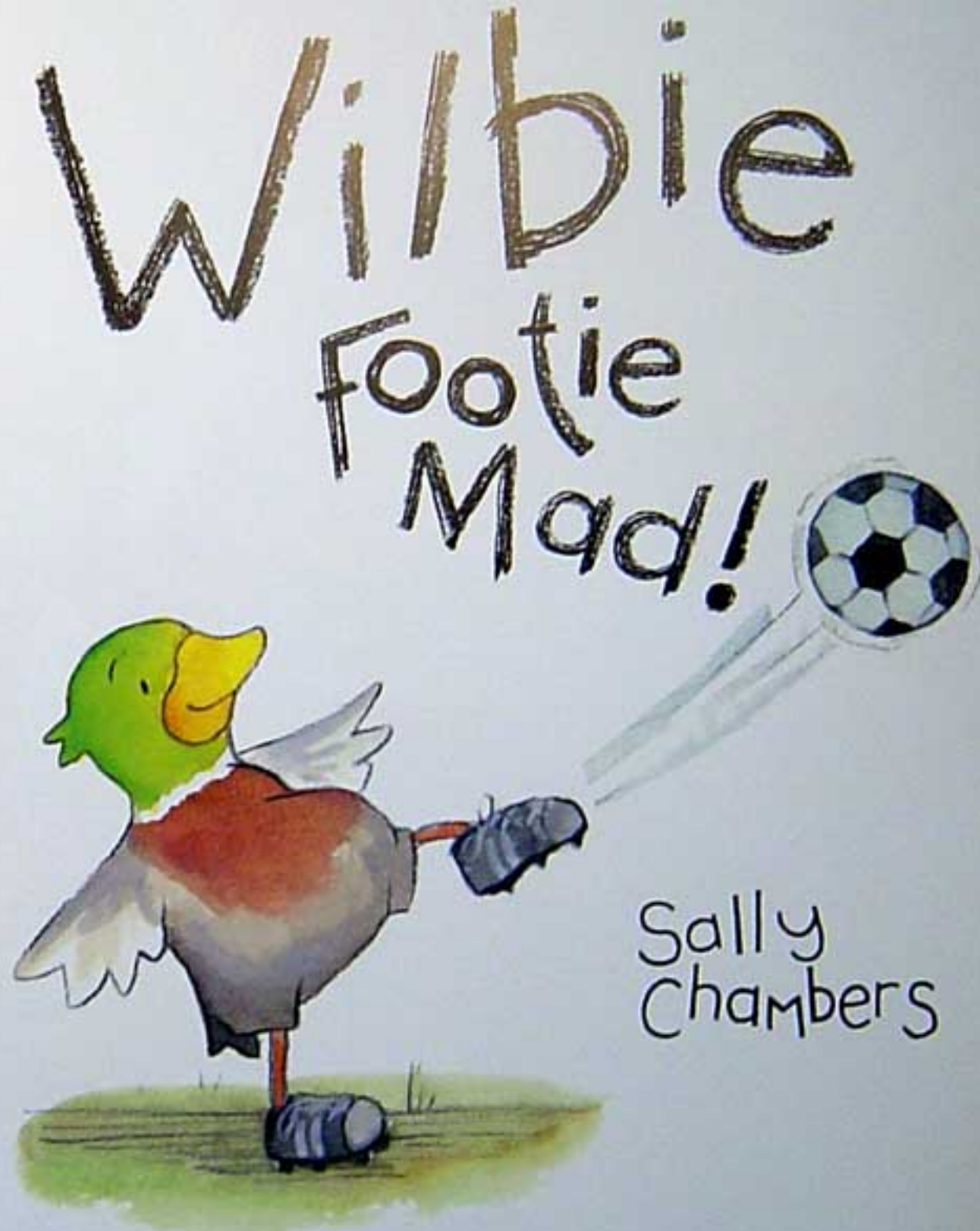

A passion for football.

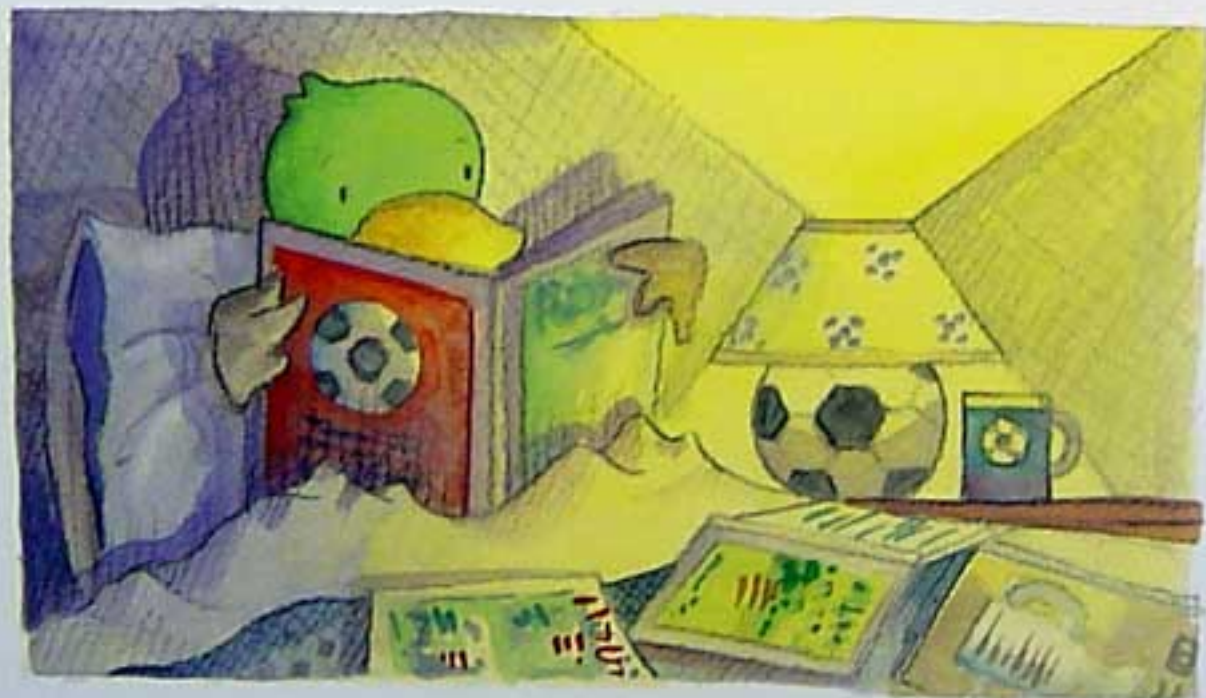
When Wilbie was small, his dad watched football
