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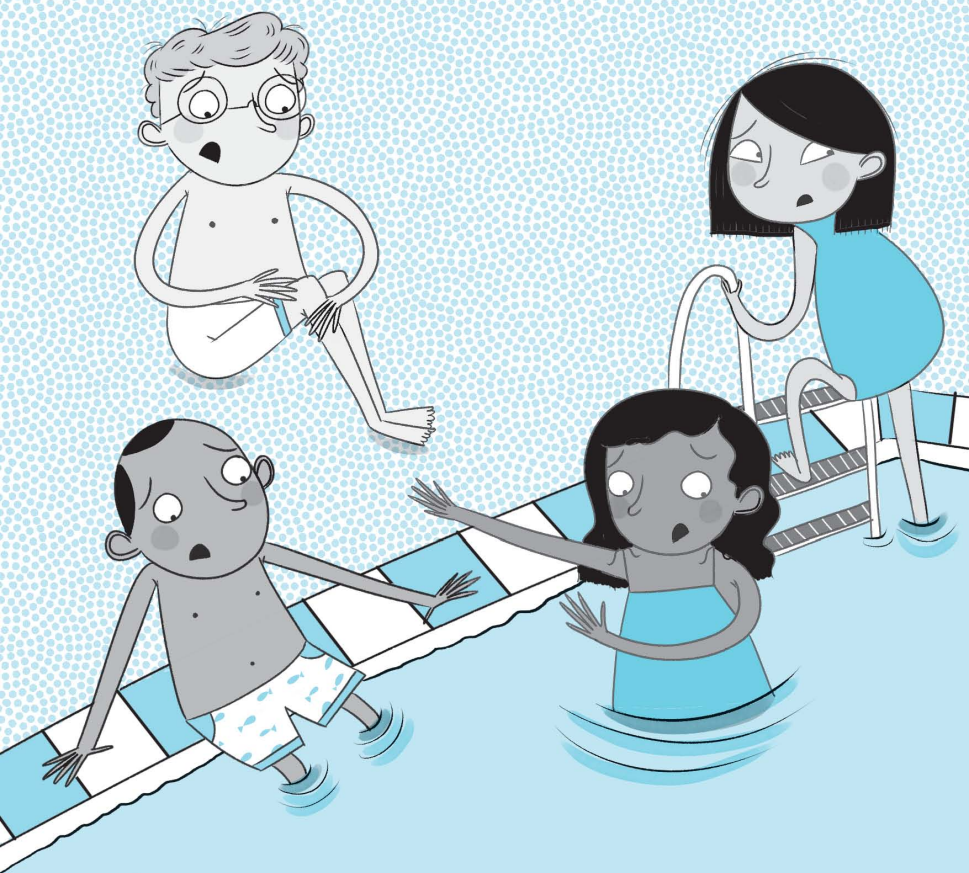

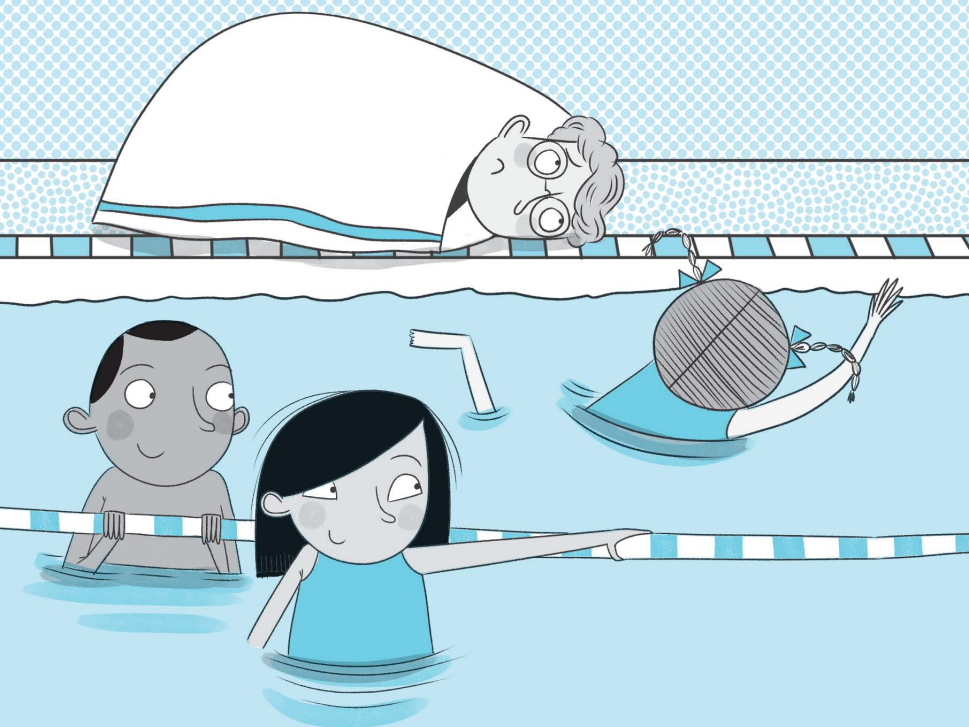
Once Joel Jack got out the pool he started rubbing his leg and shouting,

IN THE POOL!!”**

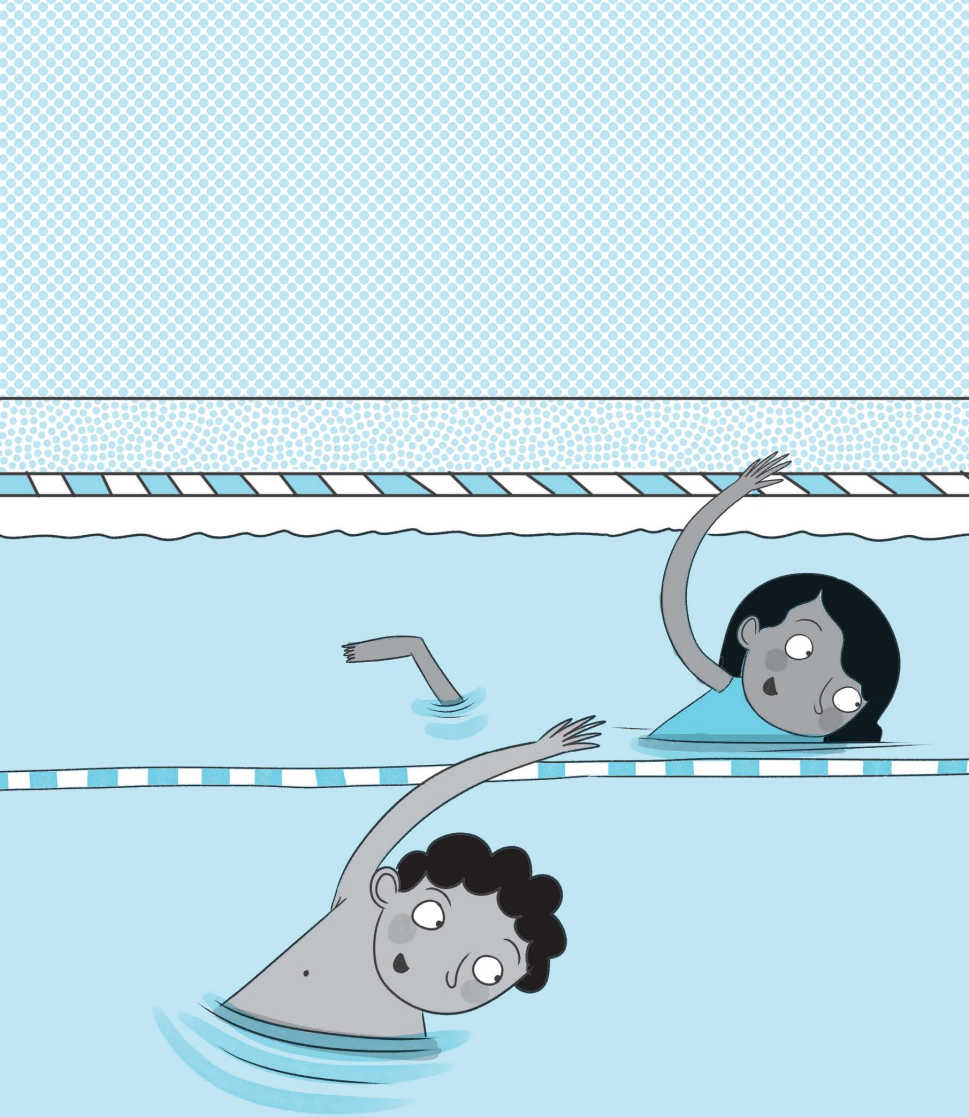

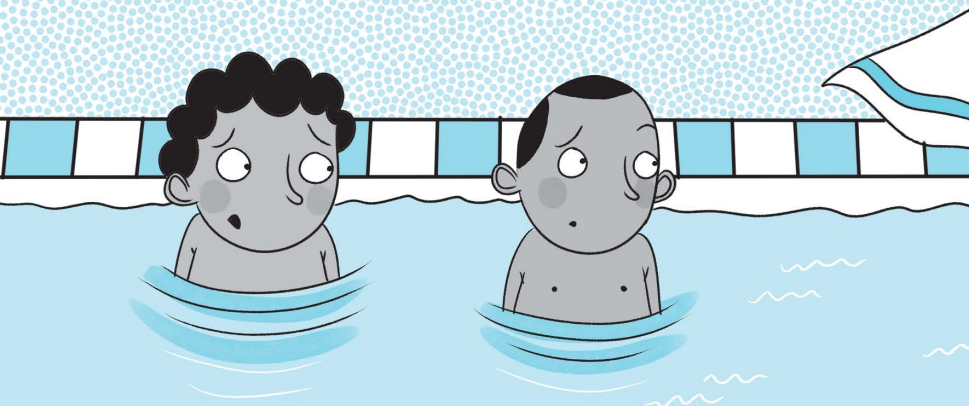




Then Mr Hobart said, "Settle down! There are **NO** sharks in this pool. Now get back into your groups and follow the **POOL RULES!**"
