Tybalt, Juliet's cousin. Hot-headed and argumentative.



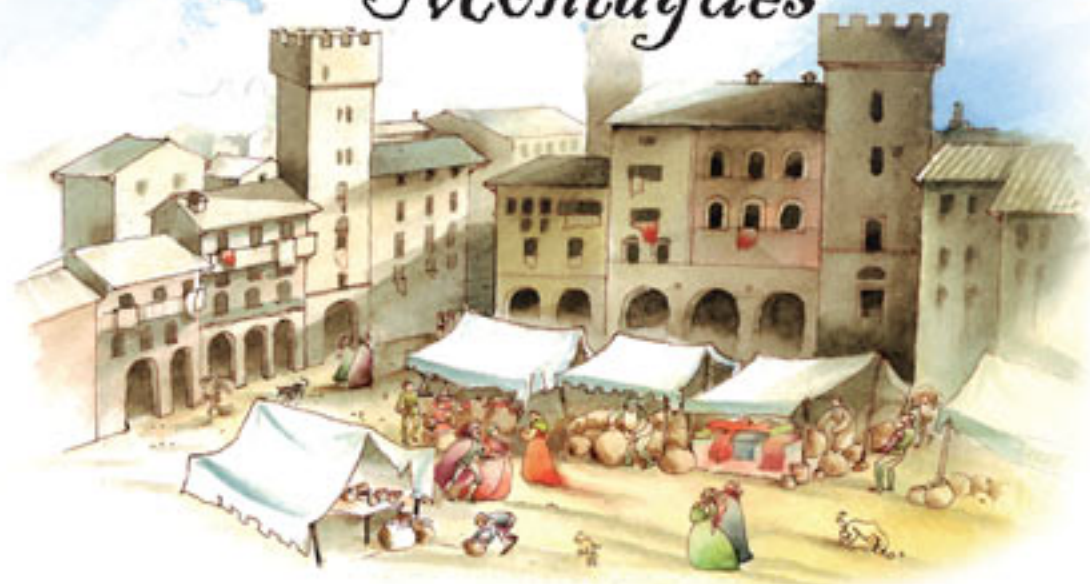
Juliet Capulet. Just 13 years old when the story begins.

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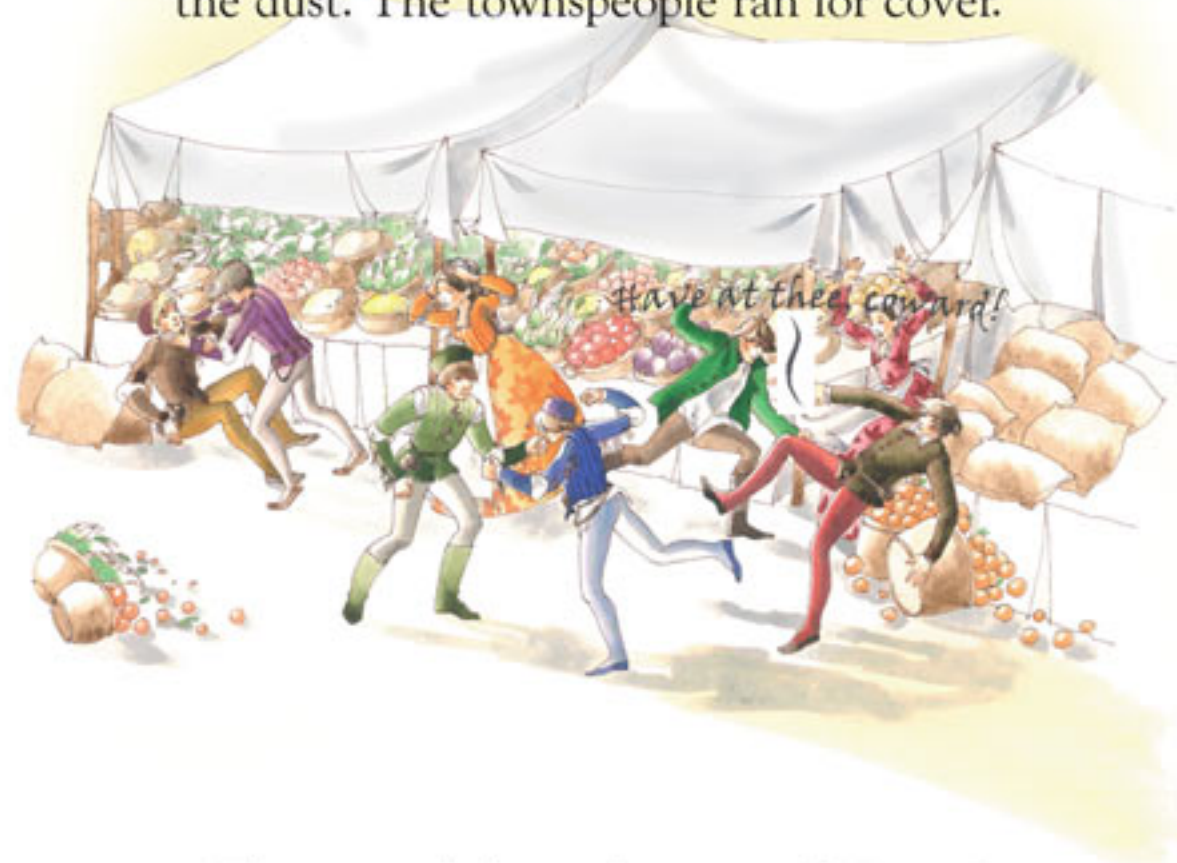

Capulets and Montagues



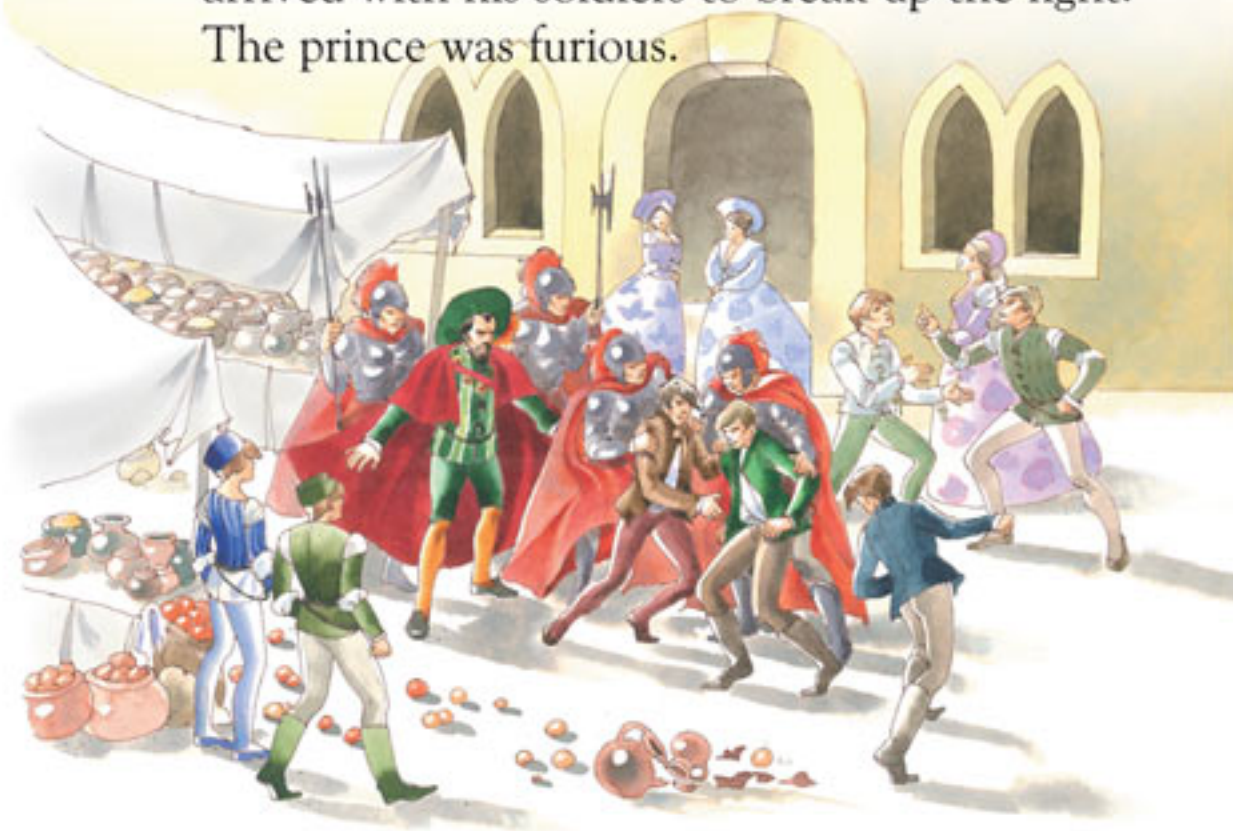
It was a warm summer's afternoon in the pretty town of Verona. People were busy shopping and chatting in the sunshine when suddenly...
