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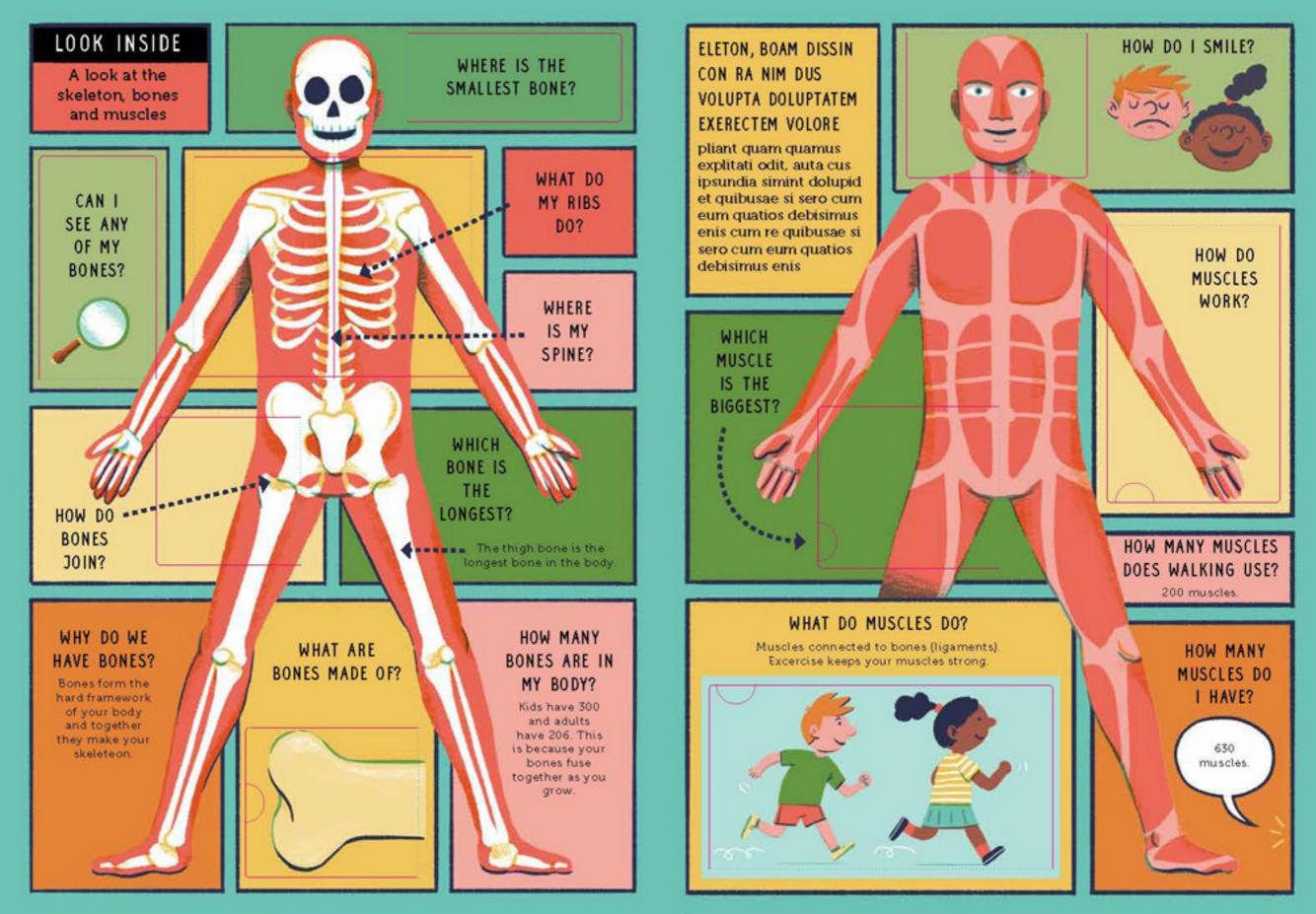

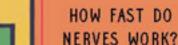
BRAIN LOOK LIKE?

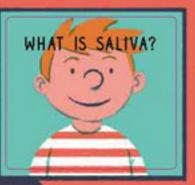

The Digestive System

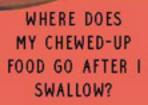
WHY DO WE EAT?

called digestion.

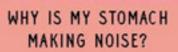




I TAKE A BITE OF FOOD. WHAT HAPPENS FIRST?

Chewing comes first. Your teeth grind the food into small pieces. Then your tongue pushes it toward the back of your mouth

Your stomach always makes rumbling noises, but usually you can't hear them. You can hear the noises if your stomach is empty.

WHERE DOES MY MASHED FOOD TRAVEL WHEN IT LEAVES MY STOMACH?

The next stop is your small intestine...

WHAT HAPPENS TO THE LEFTOVER PARTS OF MY

The leftover parts, called waste, go onto your large intestine. Your large intestine pulls out any water for your body to use.

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO DIGEST FOOD?

About 12 hours.

WHAT HAPPENS INSIDE MY STOMACH?

Special juices inside your stomach, called acids, mix your food into a thick mush.

WHAT HAPPENS TO THE WASTE?

The waste travels (as poop) from your large intestine, through your colon, out your bottom, and into the toilet.
