#### Extra kit:

Scissors · Pencil · Paper fastener

### What to do:

- Carefully cut along the solid line on page 5 to remove the page from the book.
- Cut out the three windows and two slits. Use the point of a pencil to make a hole through the place marked with a cross.
- Cut out the circle on this page. Make a hole at the centre of the circle with a pencil.
- 4. Hold the circle with 1st December facing upwards. Slide it behind the front of the calendar so the points marked with a cross line up. Push the paper fastener through the pencil holes to hold the pieces together.
- Turn the paper over and fold the paper fastener down to hold the circle in place.
- Cut out the slider shape on this page.
  Fold along the dotted lines.
