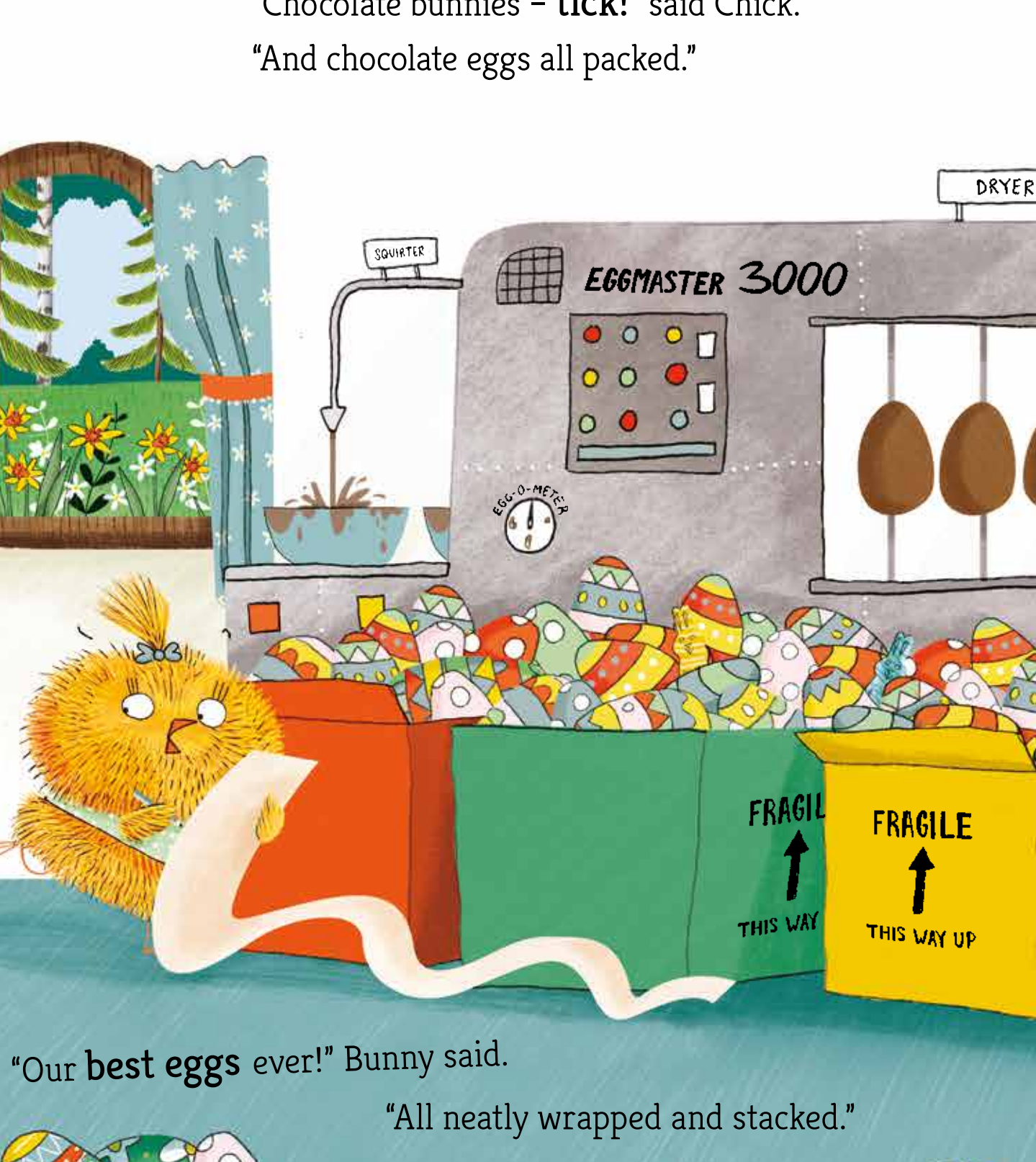


"It's very nearly **Easter**,"
