We walk and do not run.

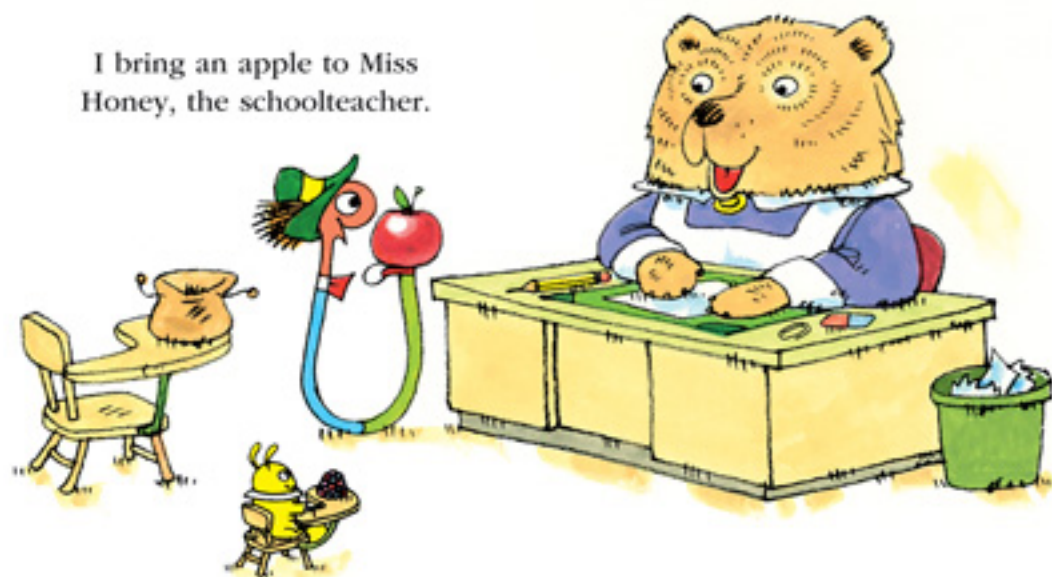


We say "Good morning" to
the school bus driver.

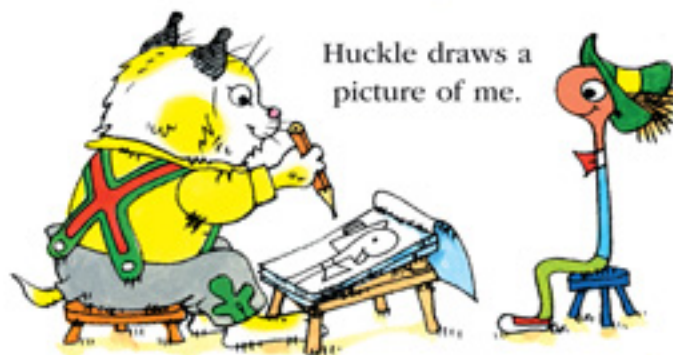
We sit quietly in our

picture of me.

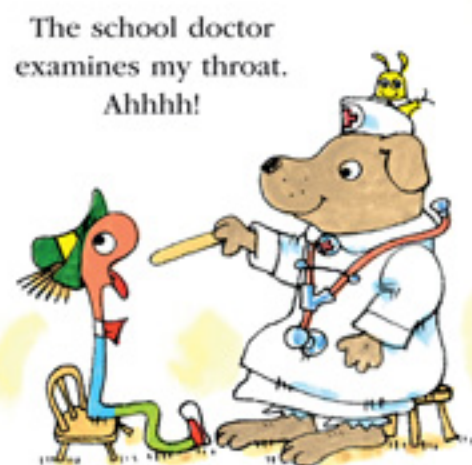


I help Sally to
string beads.

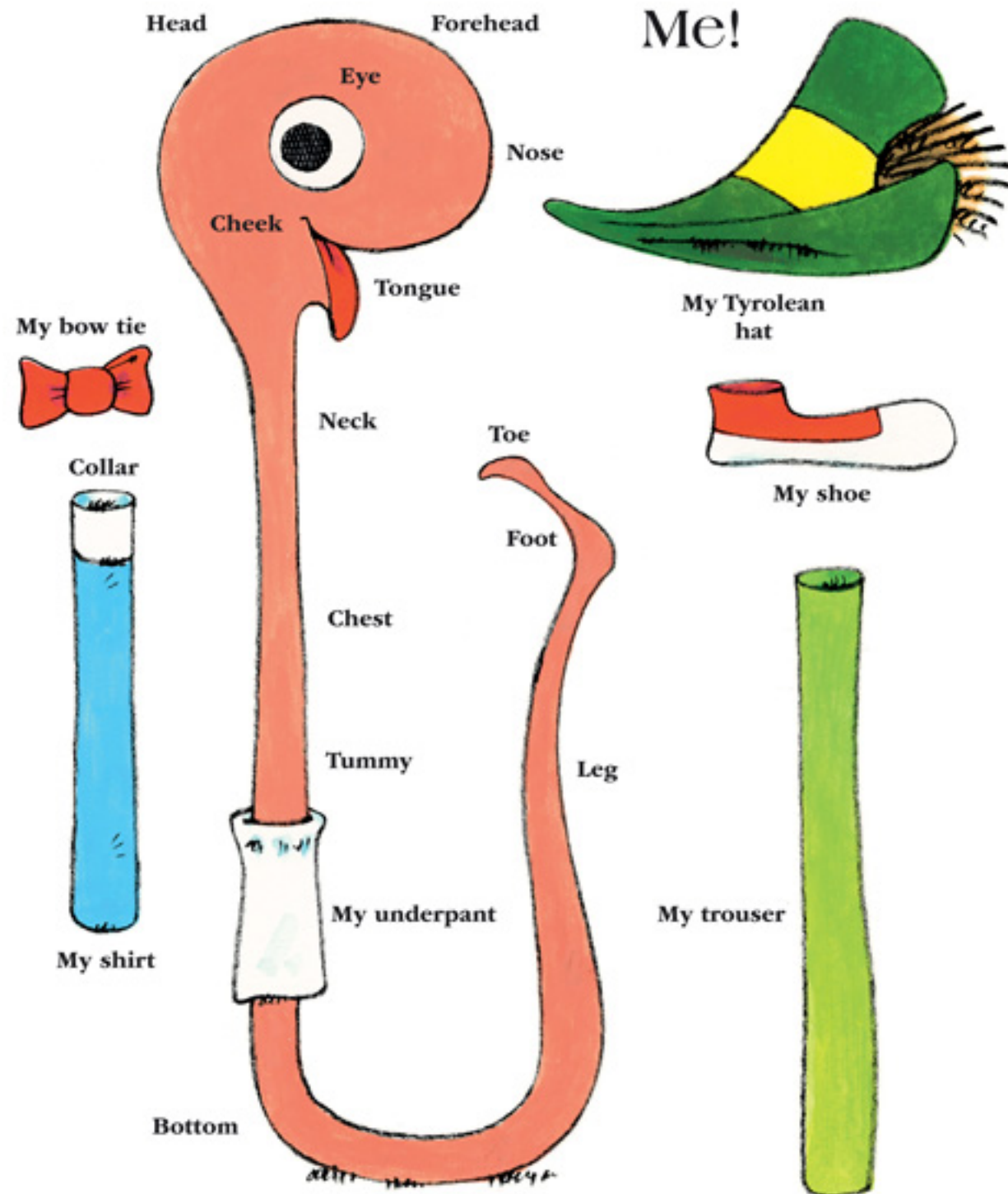


I show and tell a story

I sit up straight at the table. Sometimes I forget to take off my hat.

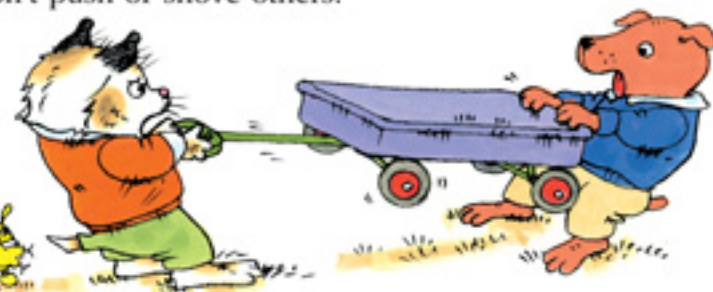
I always take my turn.

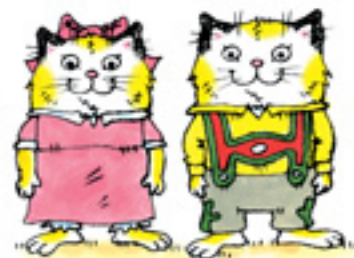
