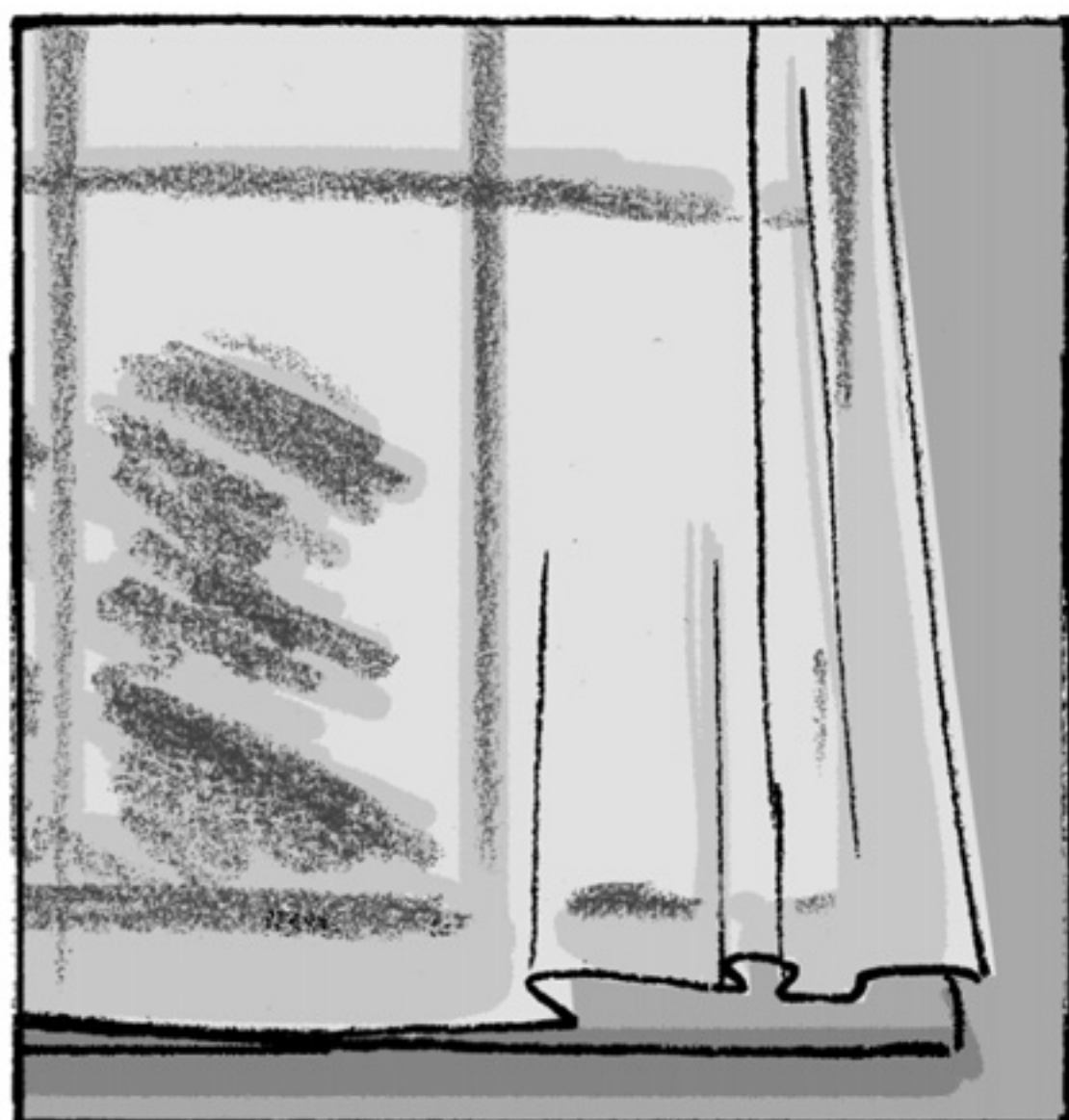


SAAAMM...
