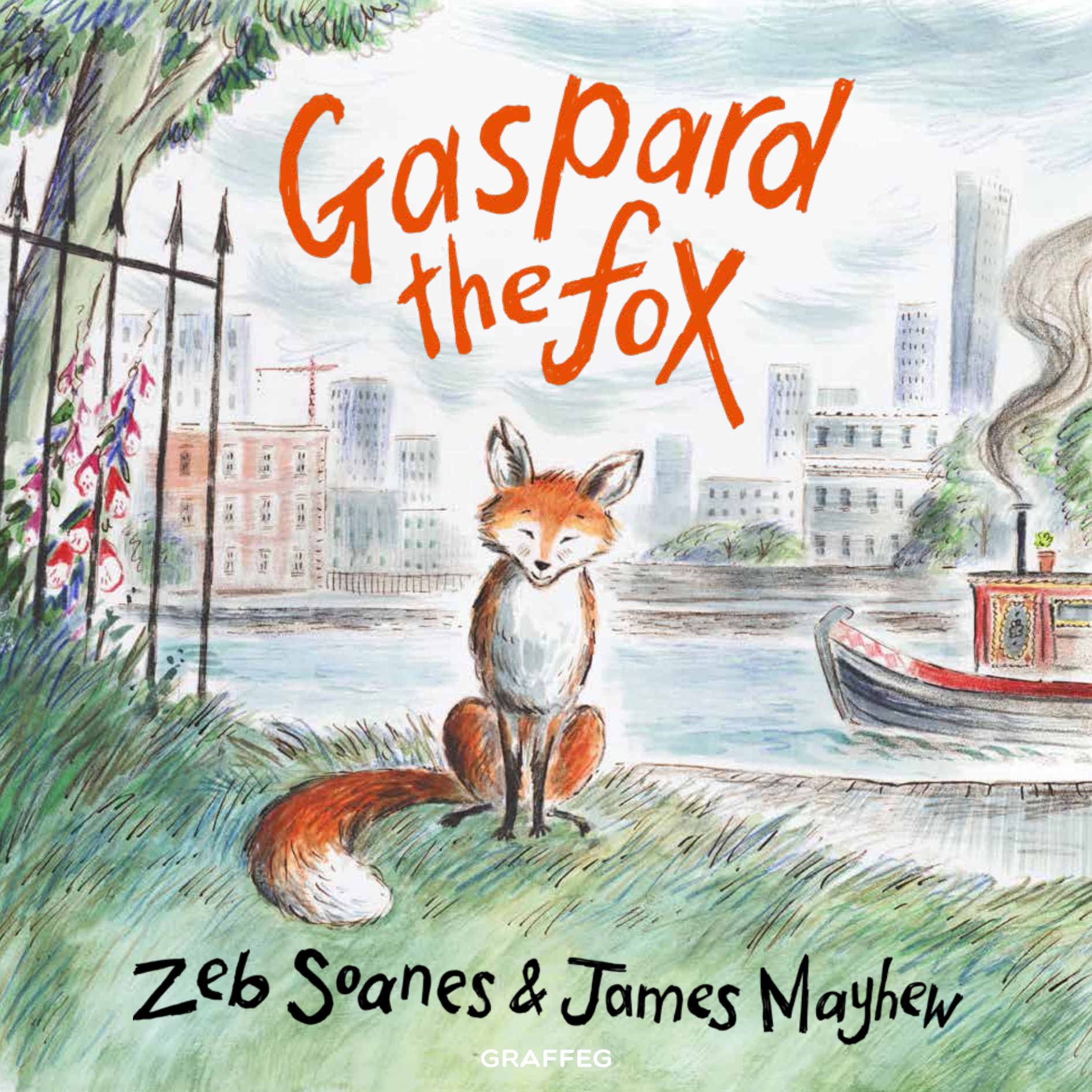




Gaspar the fox

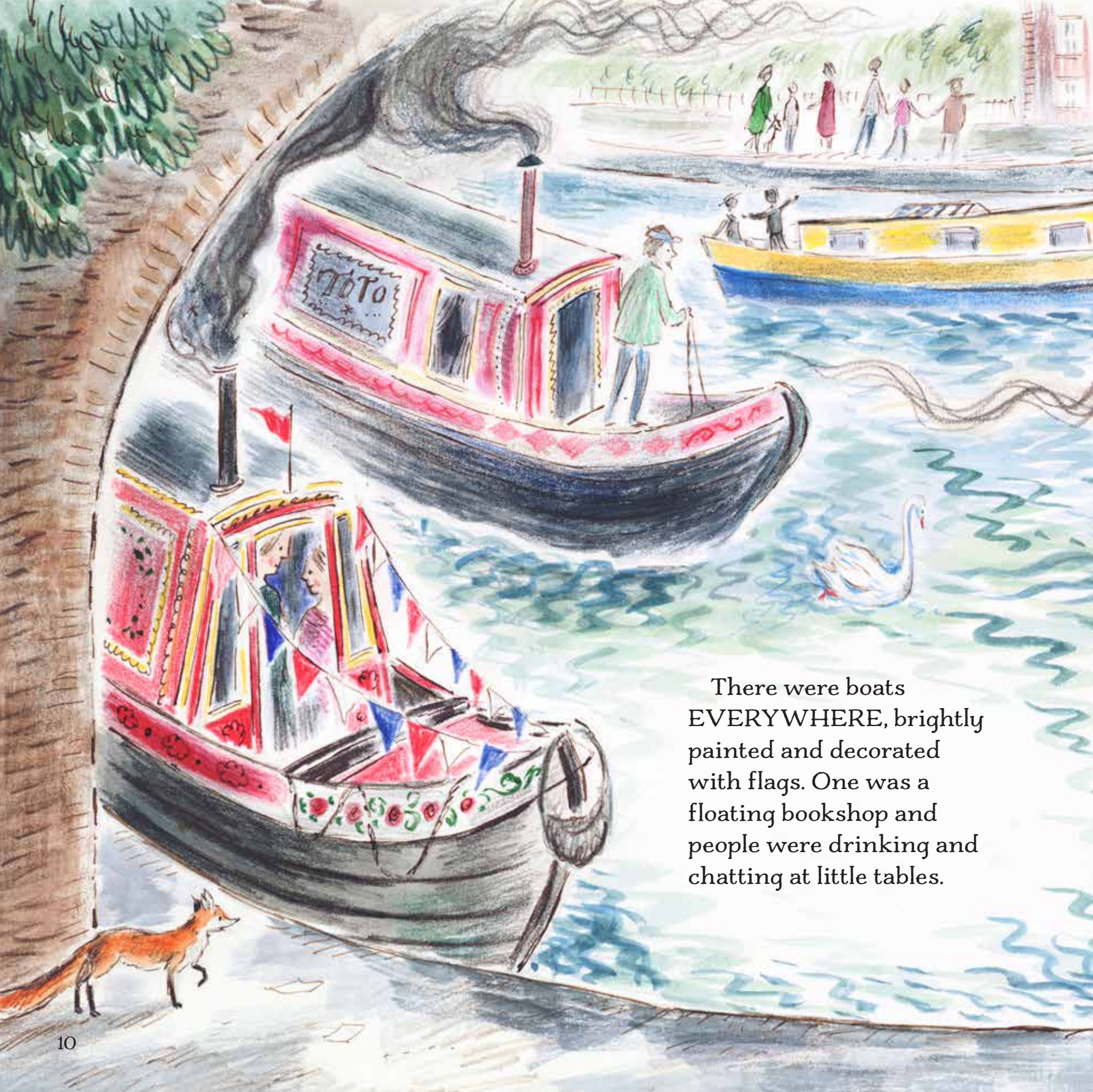
Gaspard's nose was cold and wet but the air in his den smelled warm and sweet. It was early evening and still light. He'd been asleep all day and he was hungry.
