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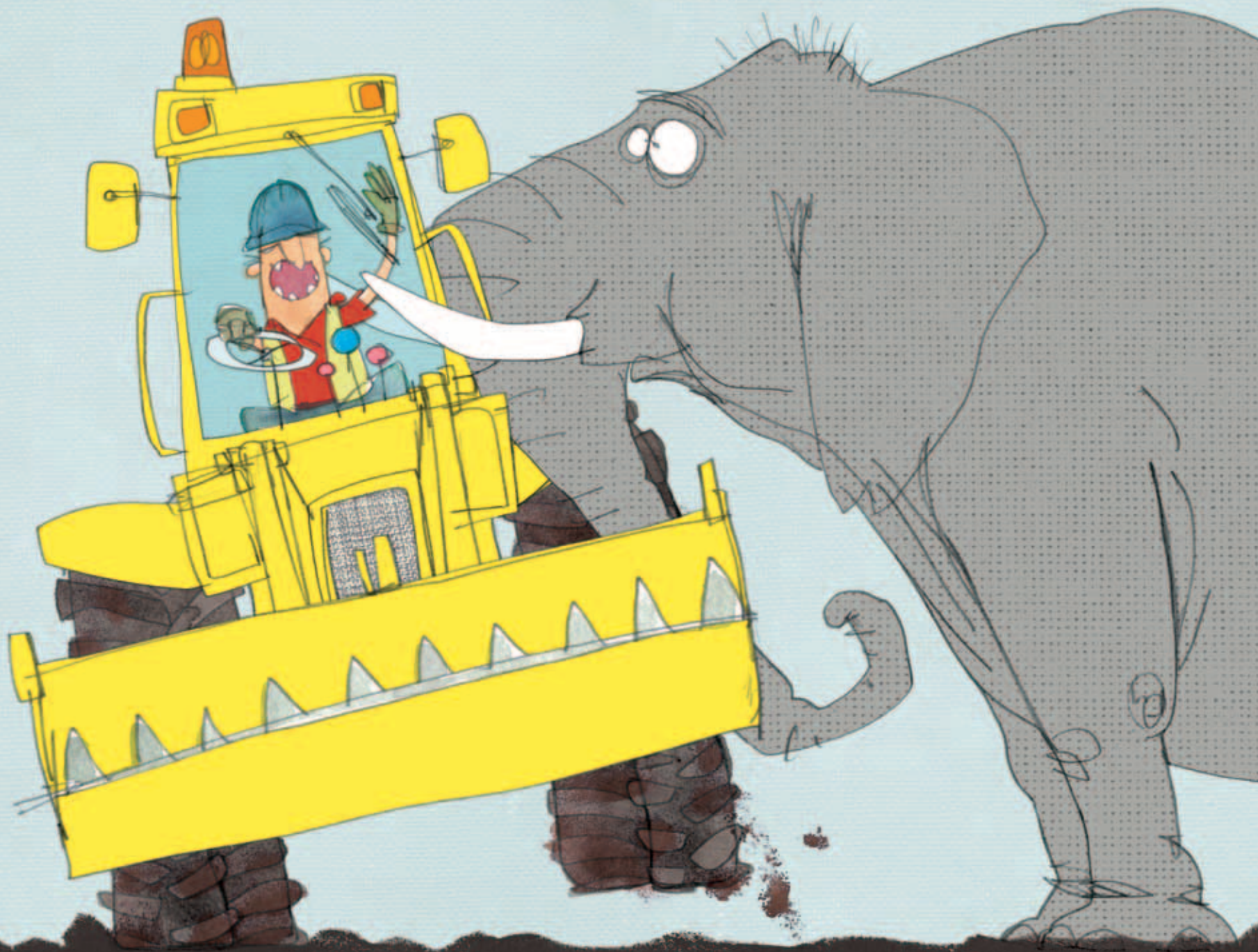

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You can't let an **elephant** drive a **digger** . . .



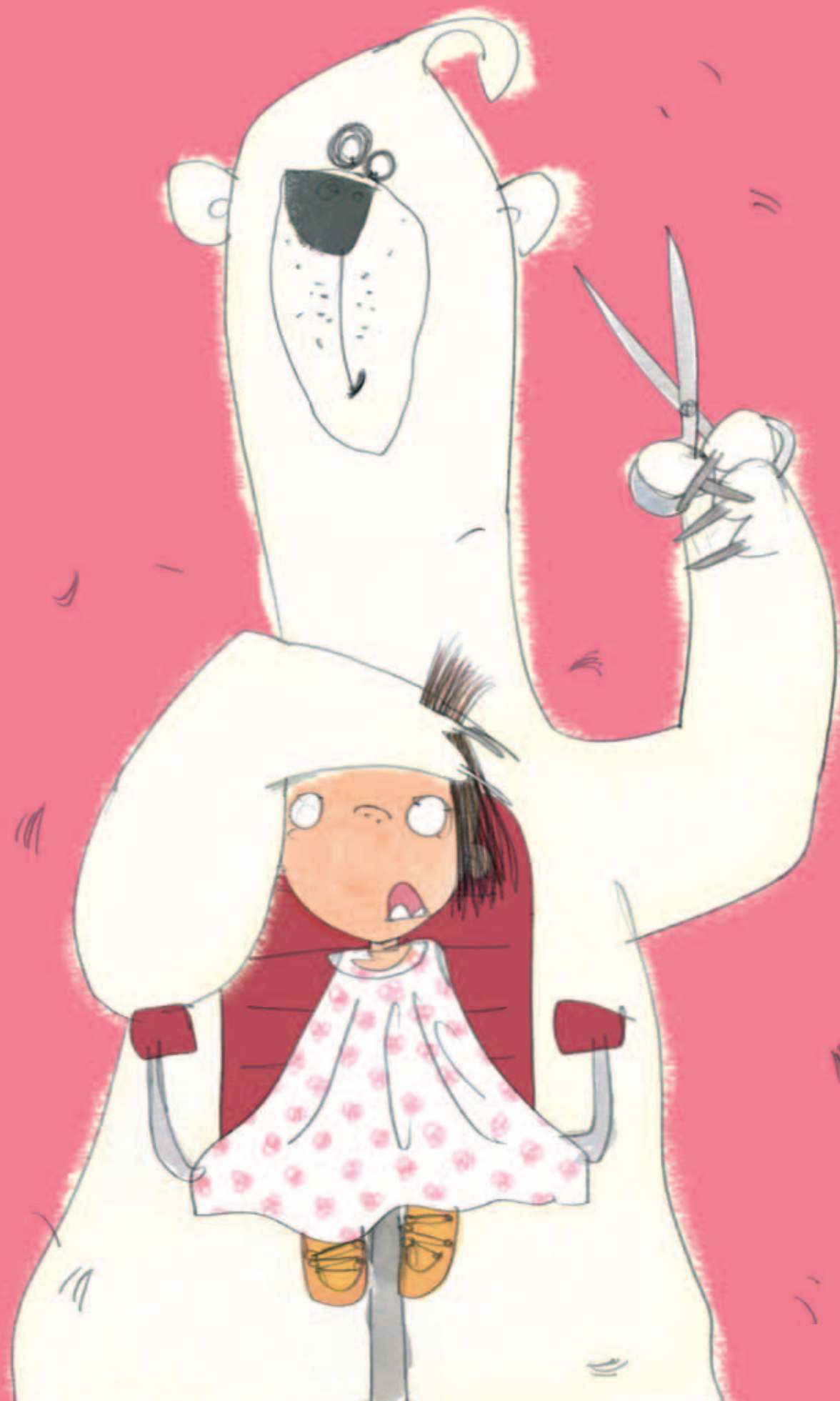
Diggers are big – but elephants **bigger**.
