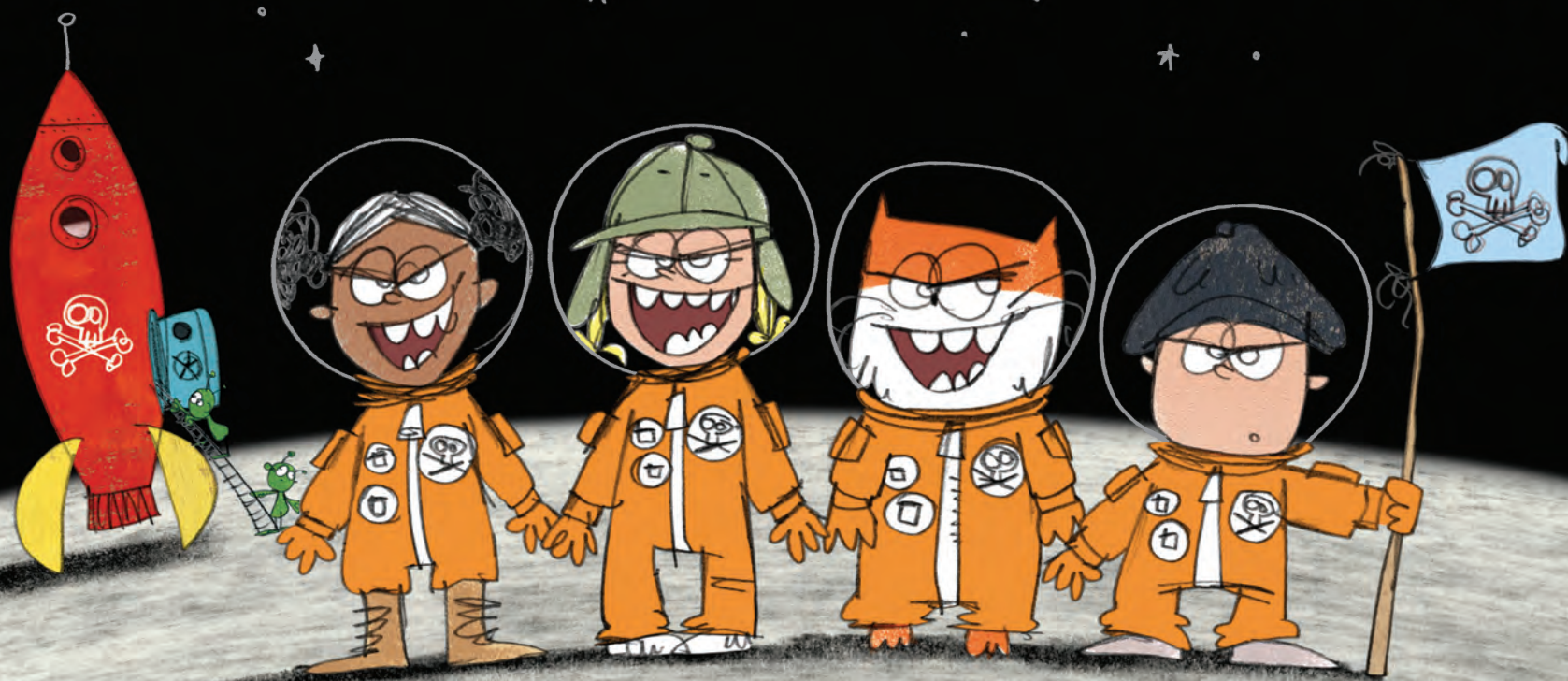


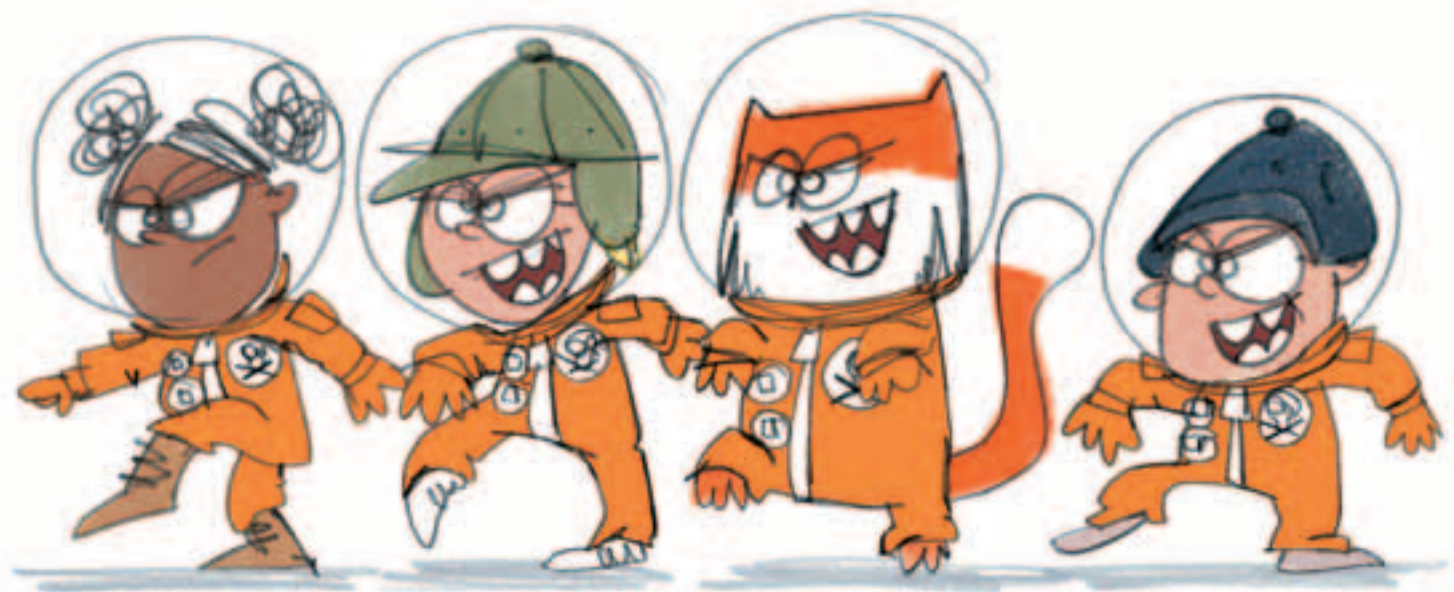

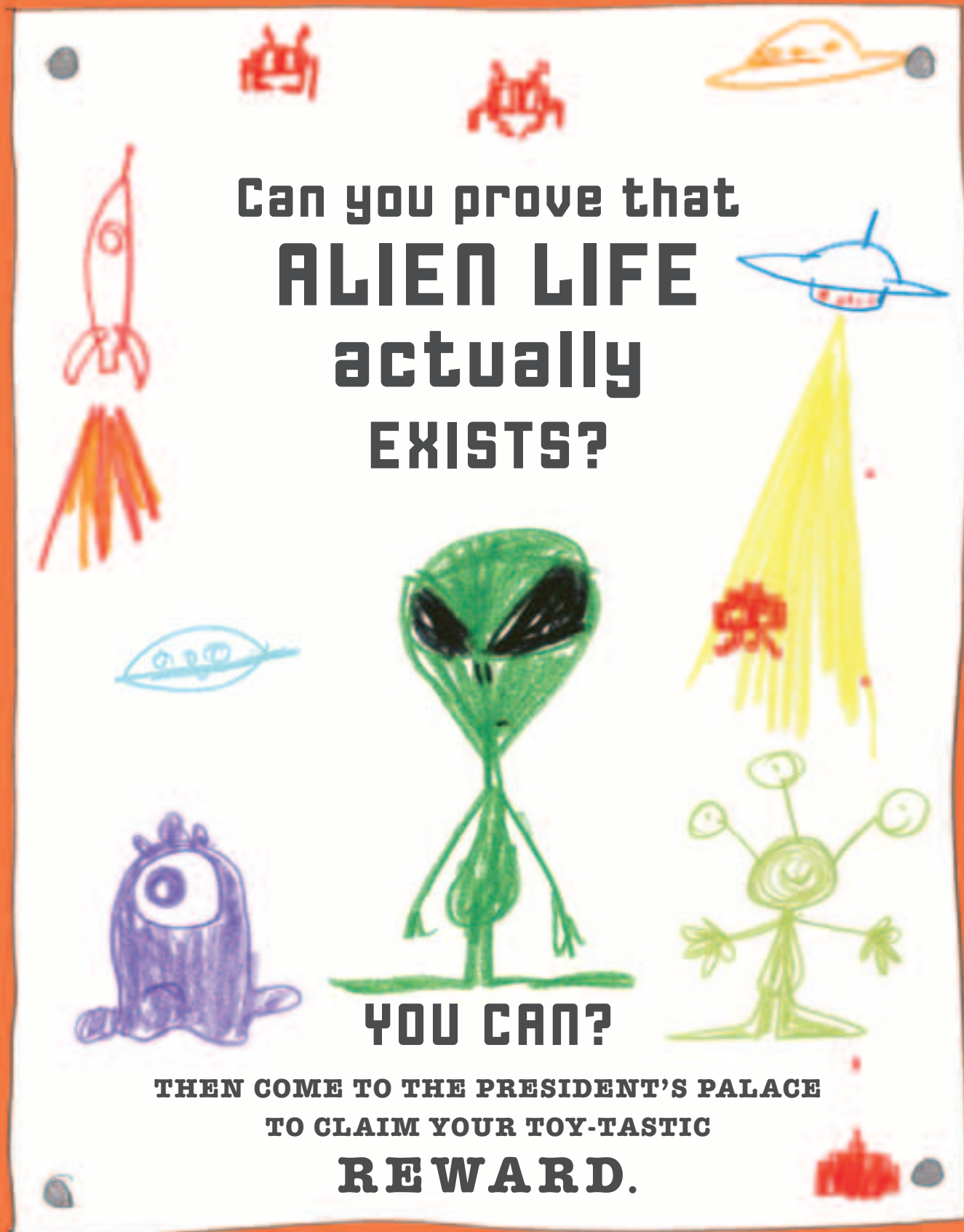
And each one was as naughty as the next.

WHOOSH!

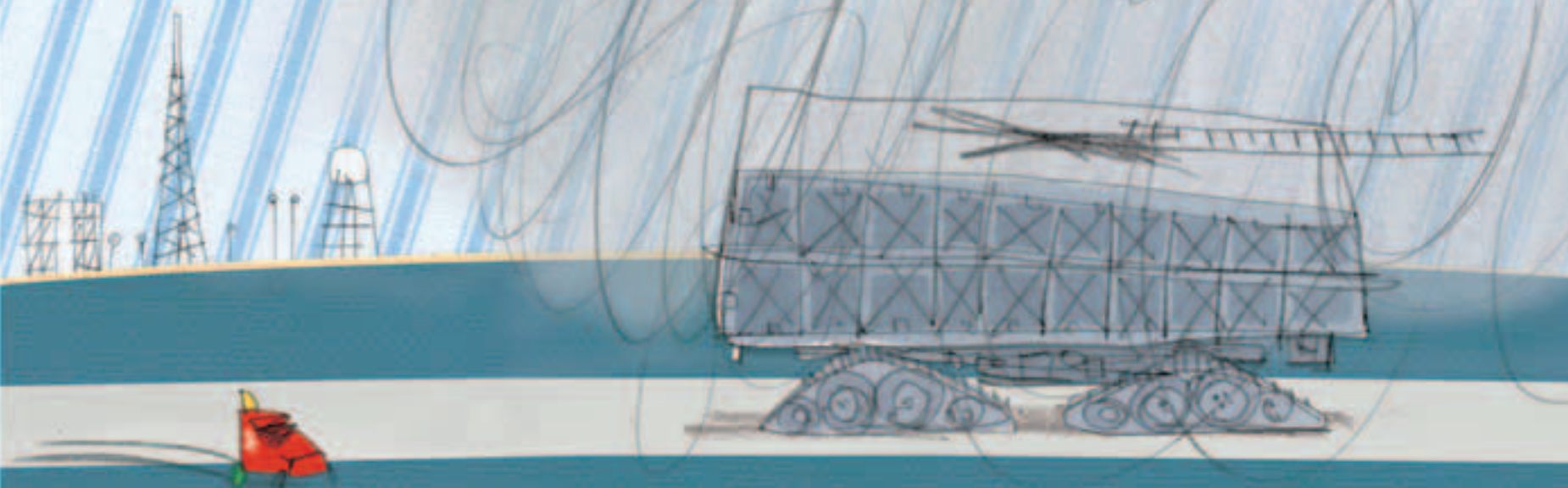


STEAL a space rocket, thought Three.
