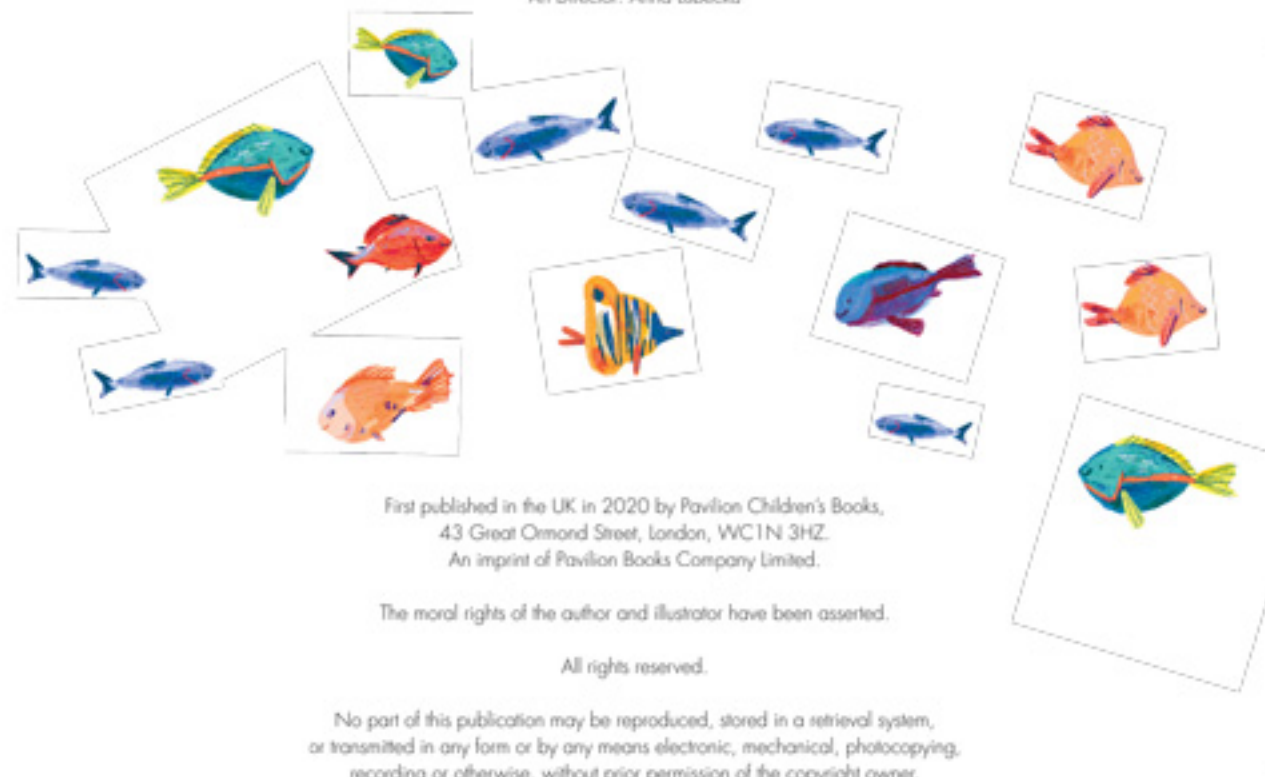


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THE BLUE GIANT

They're looking forward to a day on the beach and a trip in their little boat.



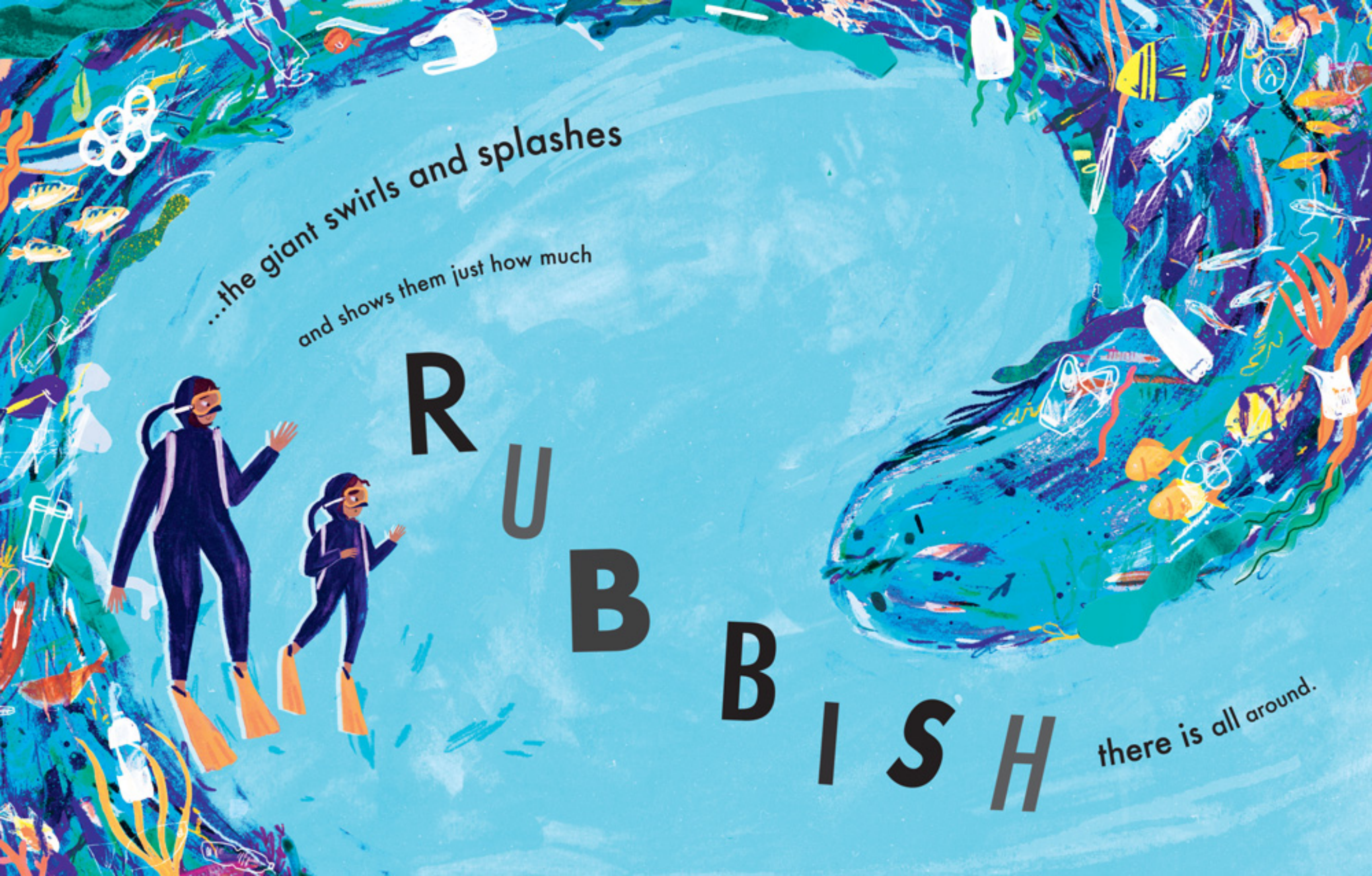
Out of the blue rises
