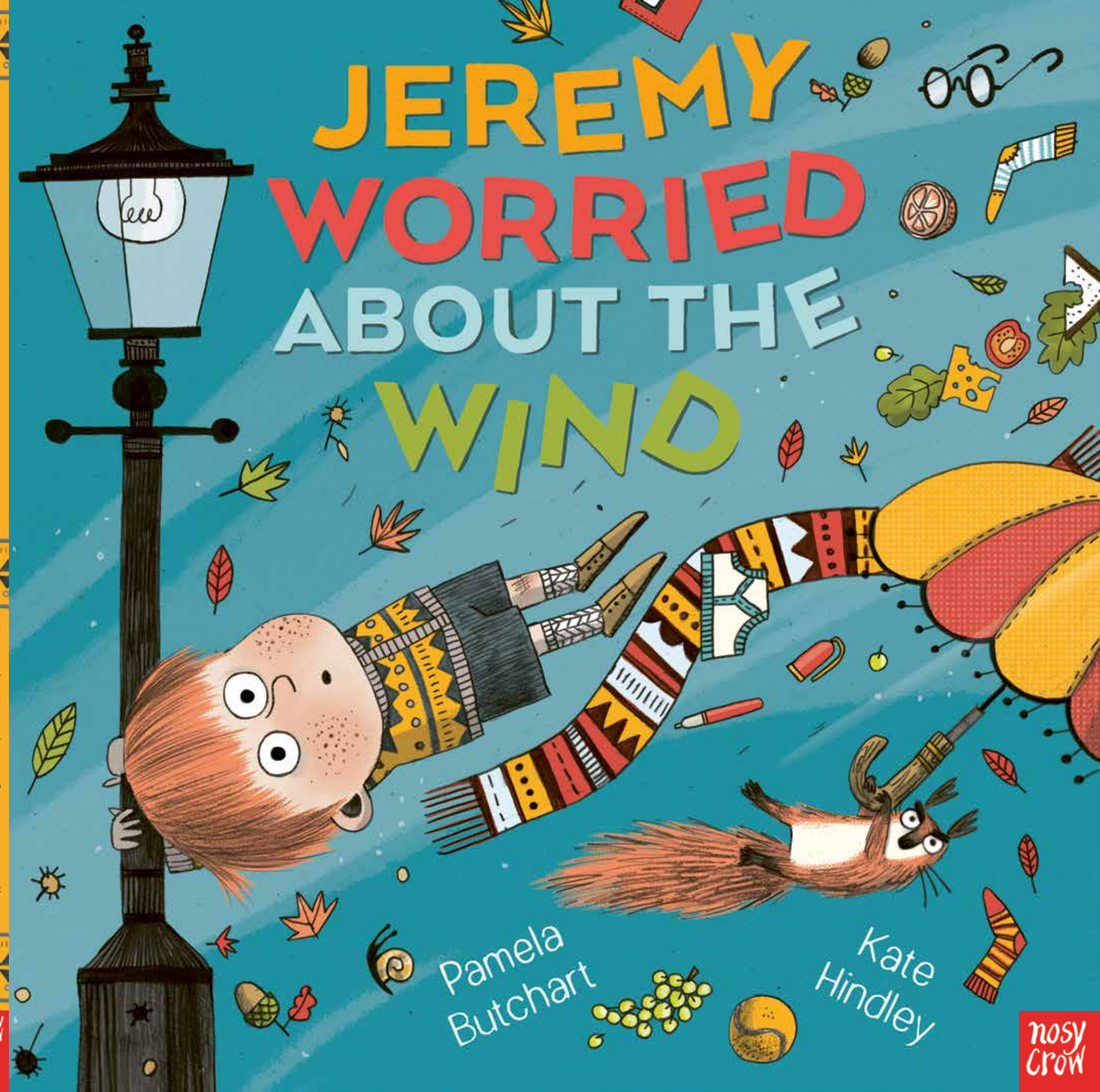


Jeremy is a worrier.
