A TEMPLAR BOOK

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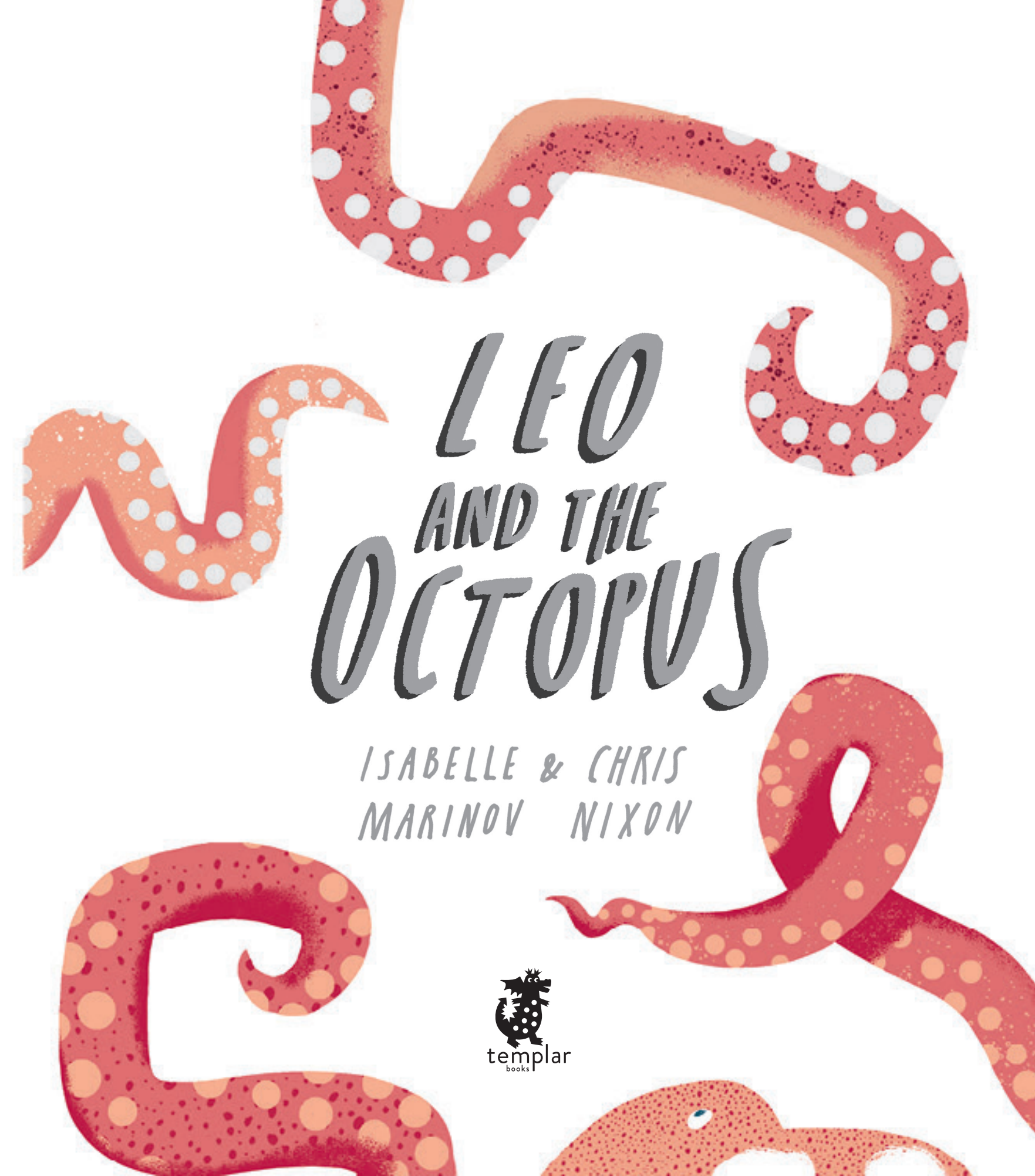
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The world was too bright for Leo. And too loud.
