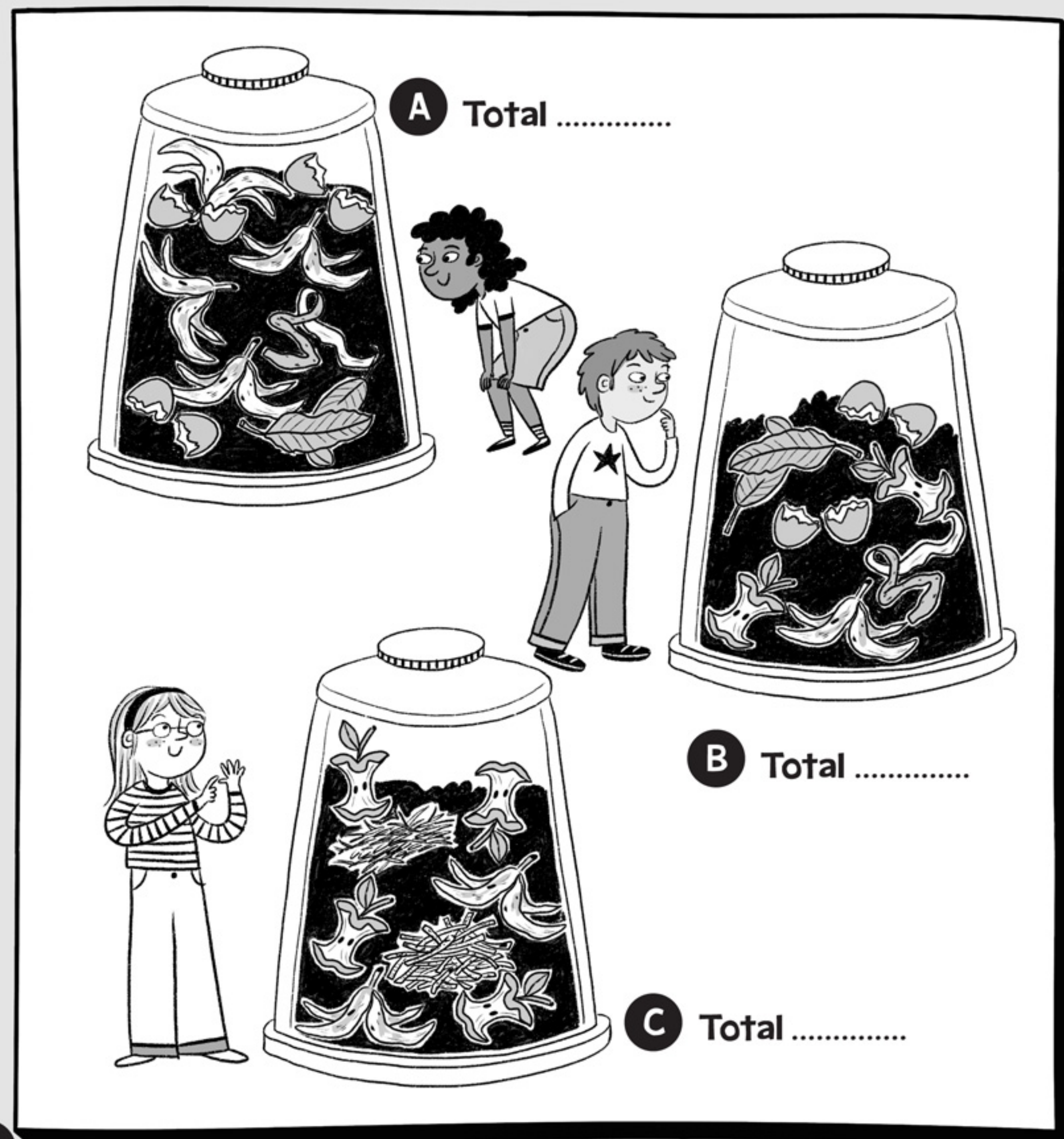
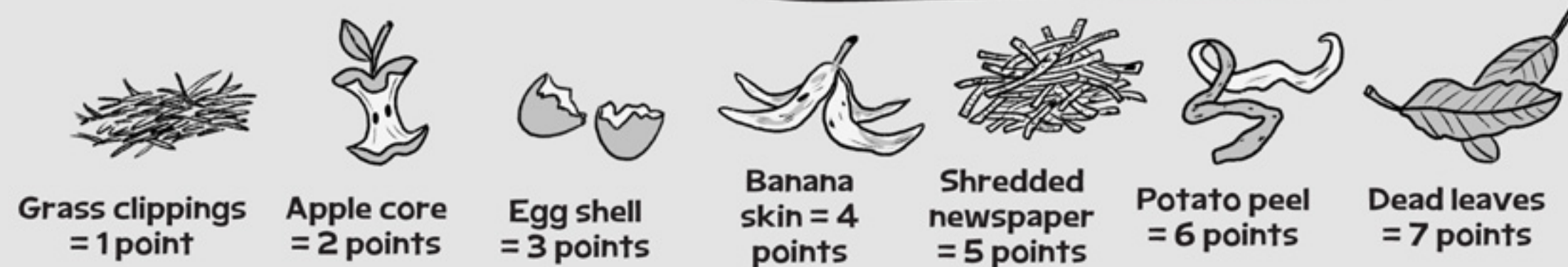


COMPOST CHAMPIONS

These compost bins are full of healthy compost, but which compost is the best?

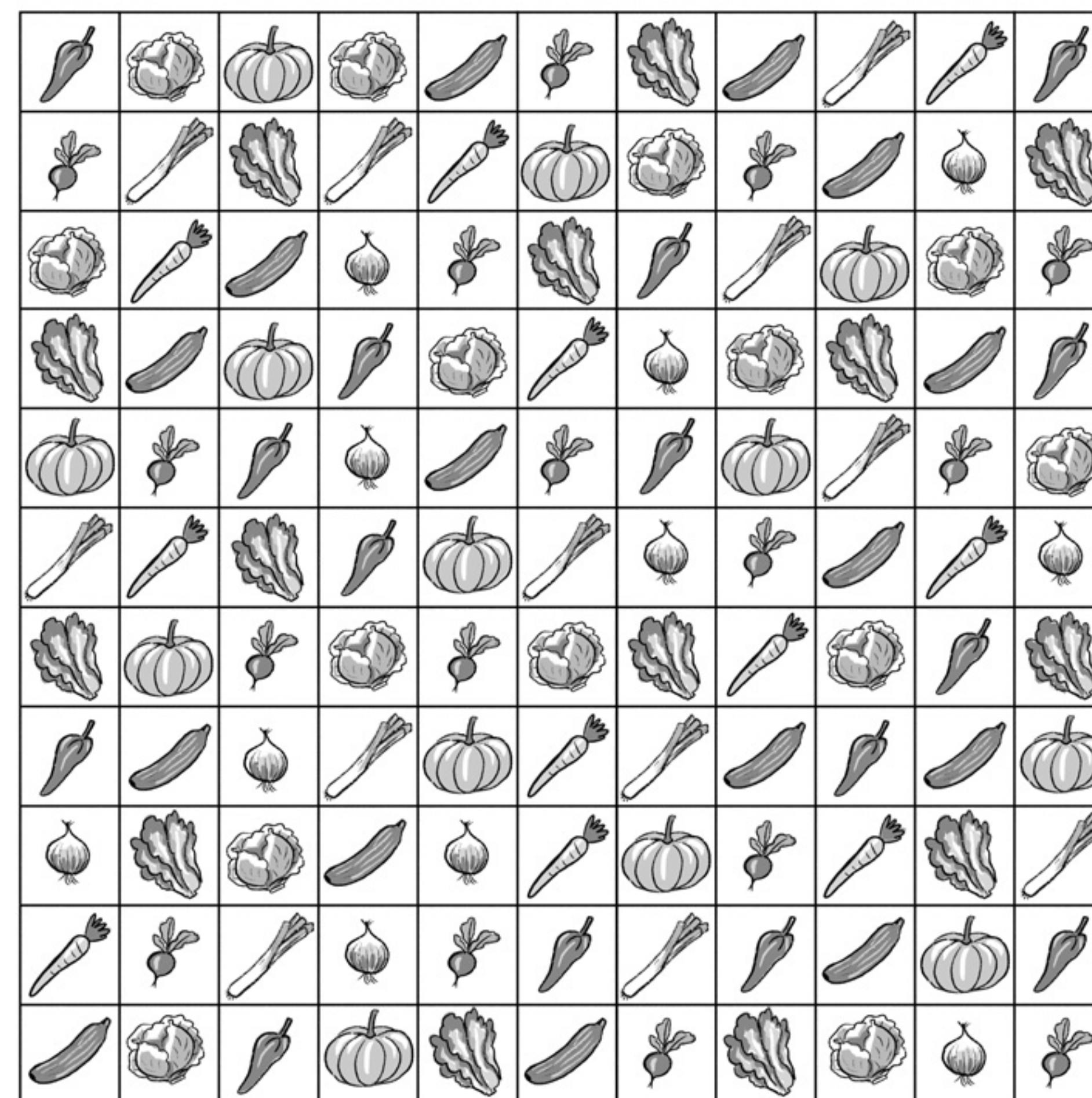
Add up the points to find out. The bin with the highest score has the best compost.

Wash bike at the end of the weekend.

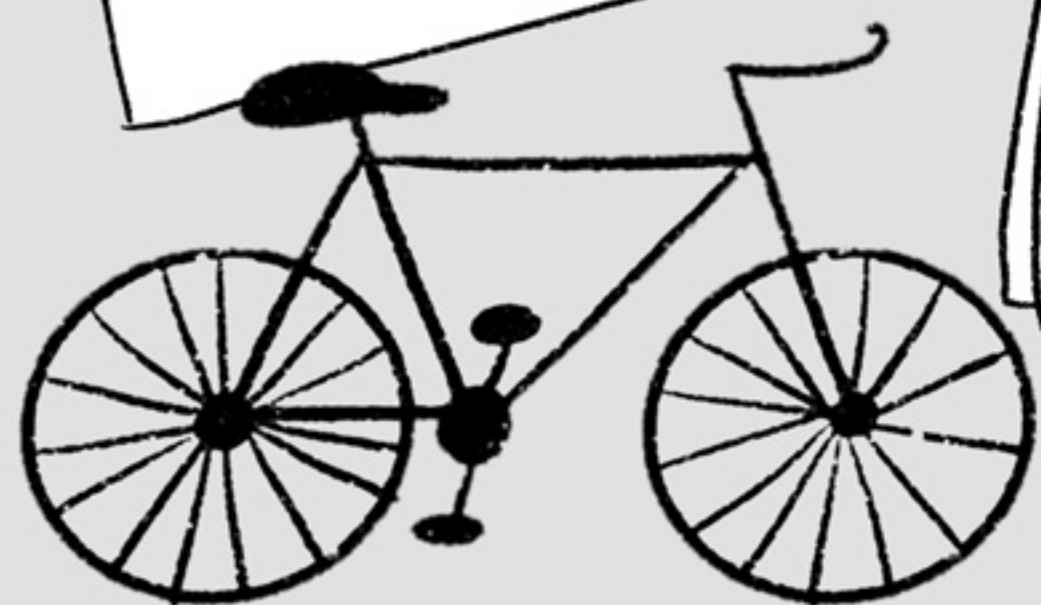
Laila's to-do list:

Wonky vegetables are veggies that used to be thrown away by shops for being too big, small or ugly. Which of these silhouettes matches this box of wonky veg exactly?

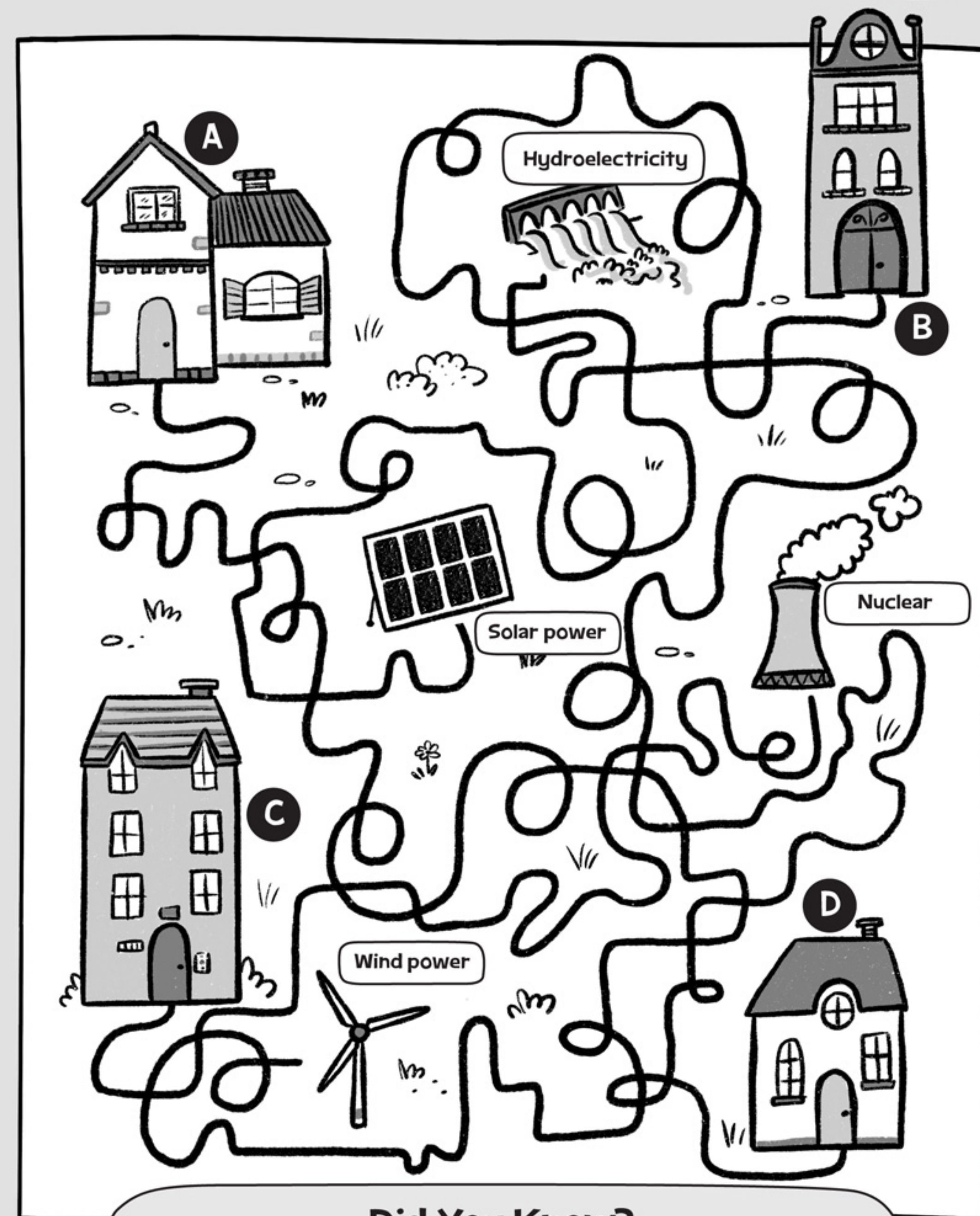


Top Tip
