ready or not!"

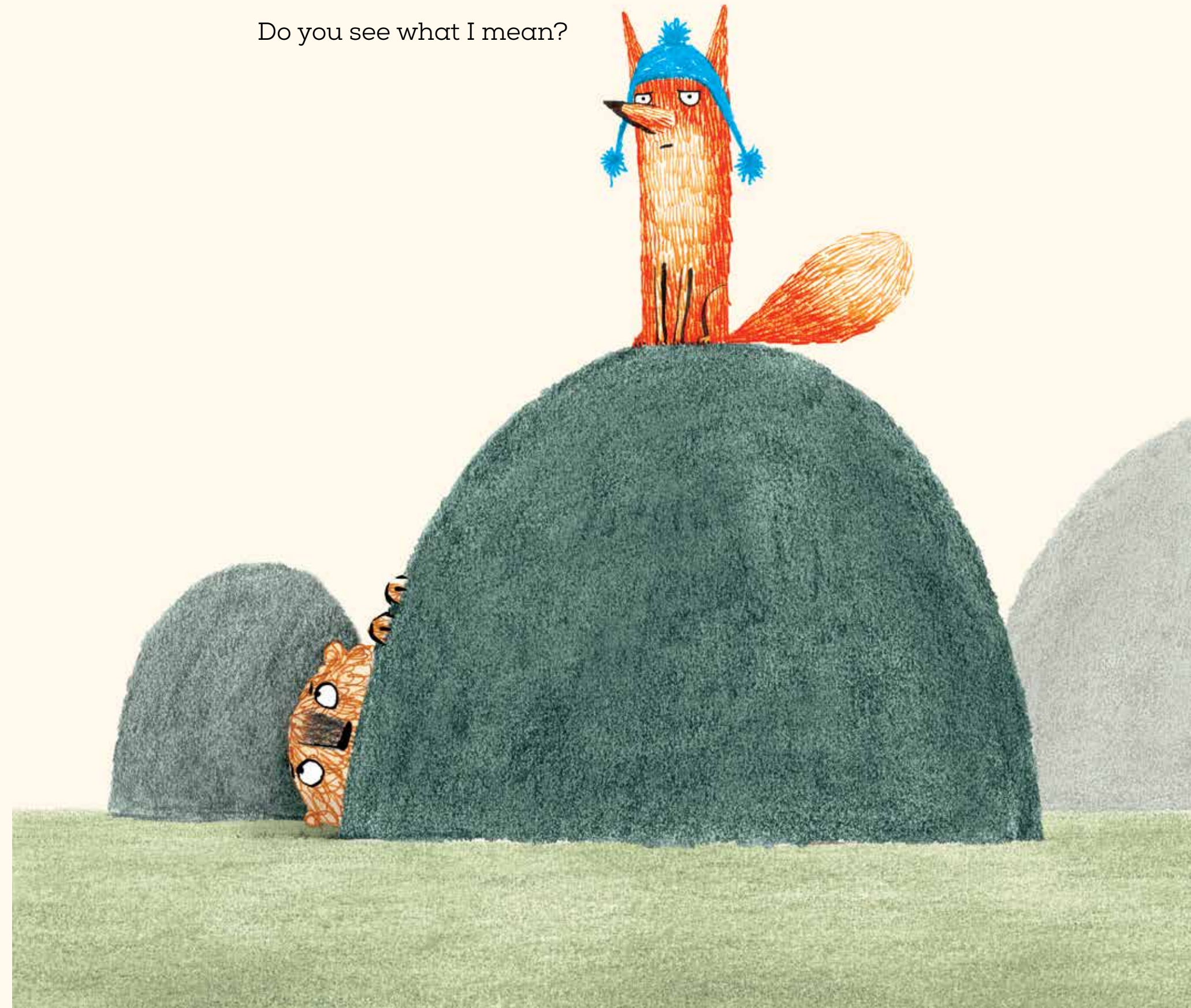


And there he is!
