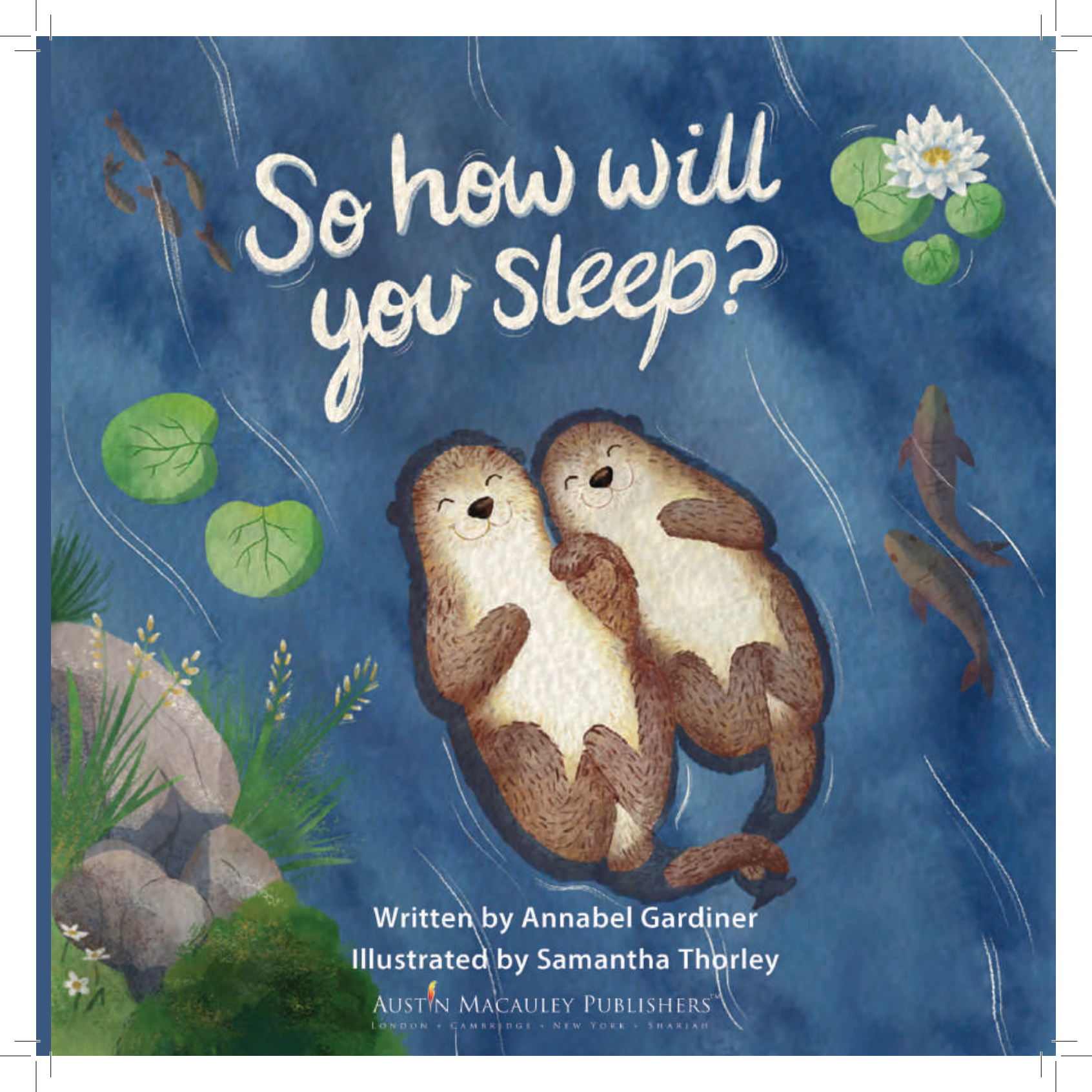




So how will you sleep?
