Winnie's New Computer



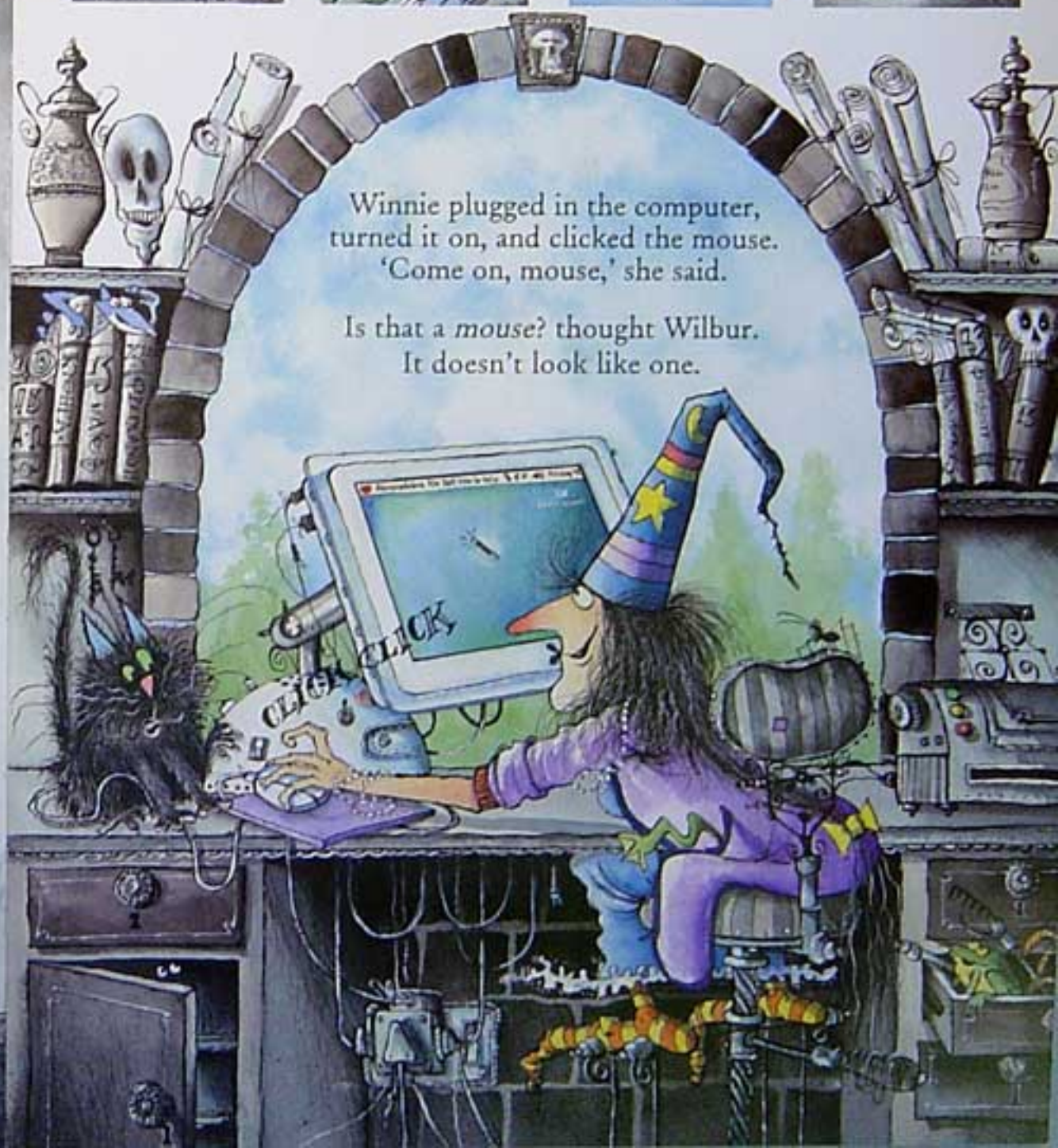
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Winnie the Witch had a new computer. She was very excited. Her cat, Wilbur, was excited too. He thought something interesting might happen and he didn't want to miss it.
