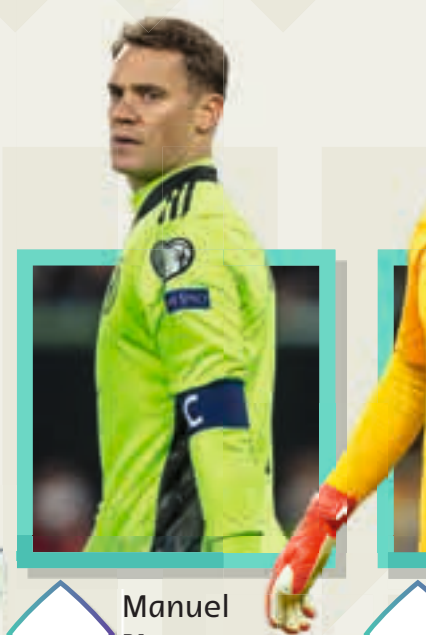
Each nation can name 23 players in its squad. On matchdays, 11 players on each team start and a maximum of five substitutes can be used per team.

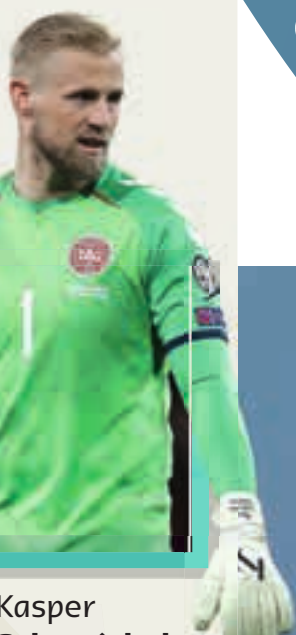

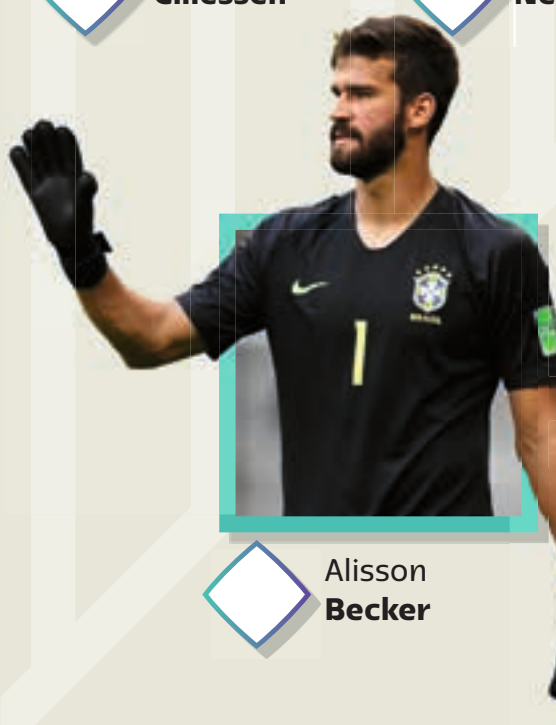

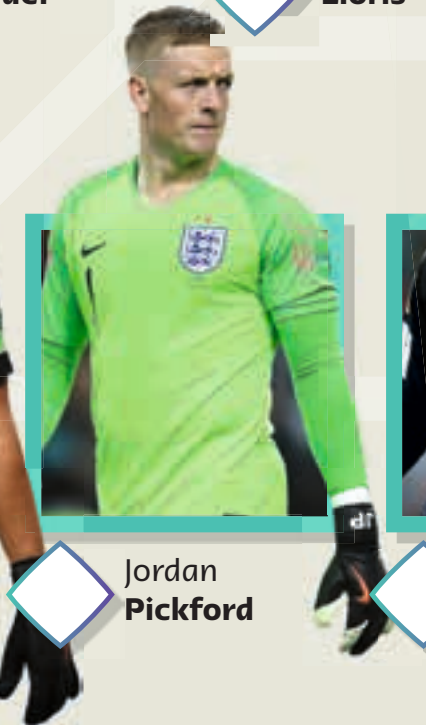
