Maisie said that we should forget ALL ABOUT IT and NEVER go near the basement again.

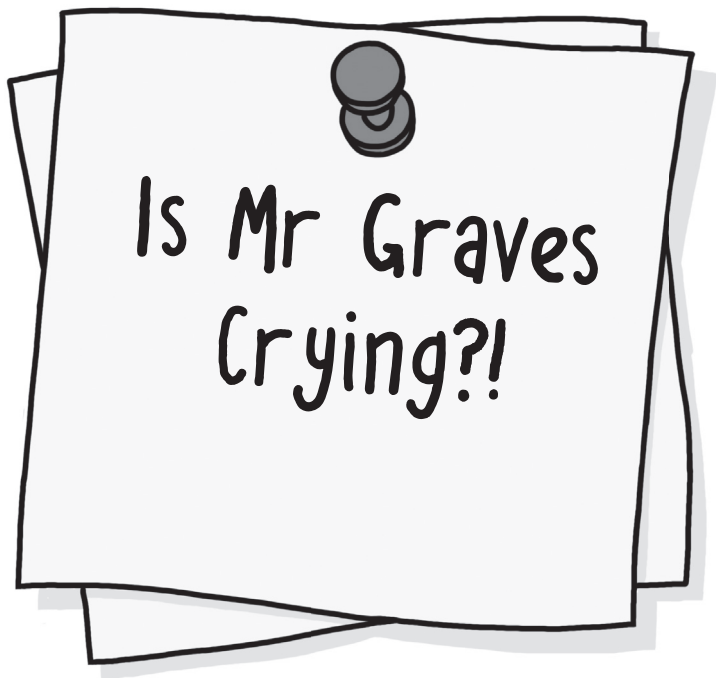


But then we heard **WAILING** and

I just shrugged, because it was obvious he

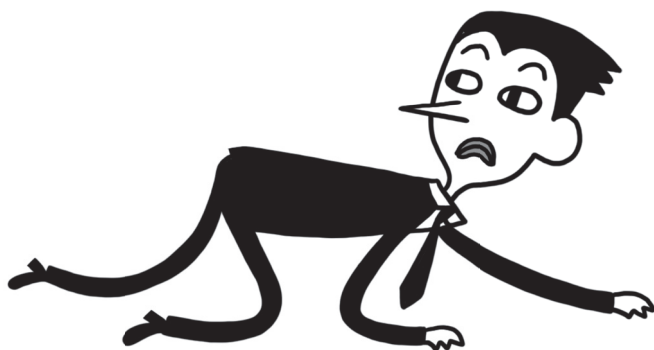


was looking for something but I had
