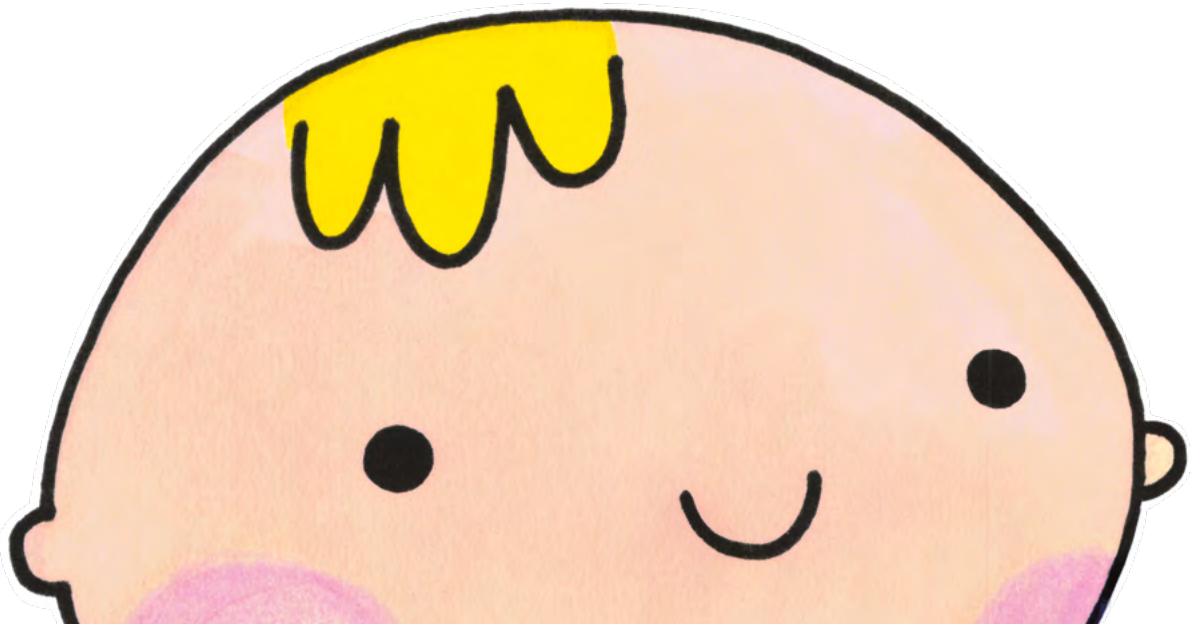

when Daddy loved going to the bathroom shop to try out new baths.



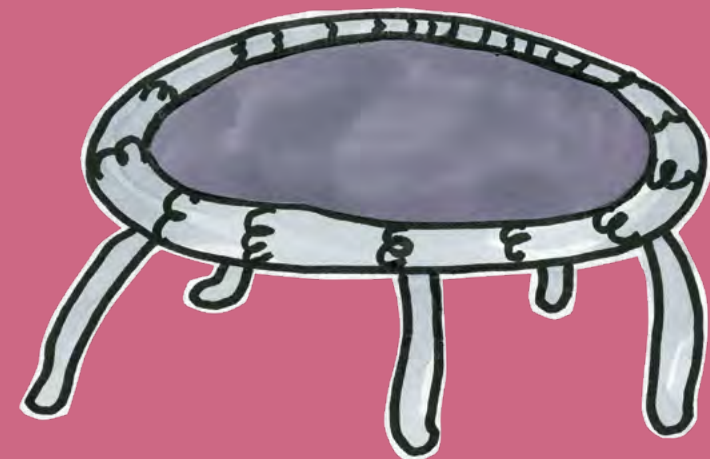
Bathing was Daddy's most favourite thing to do.
