Birds are animals that have:

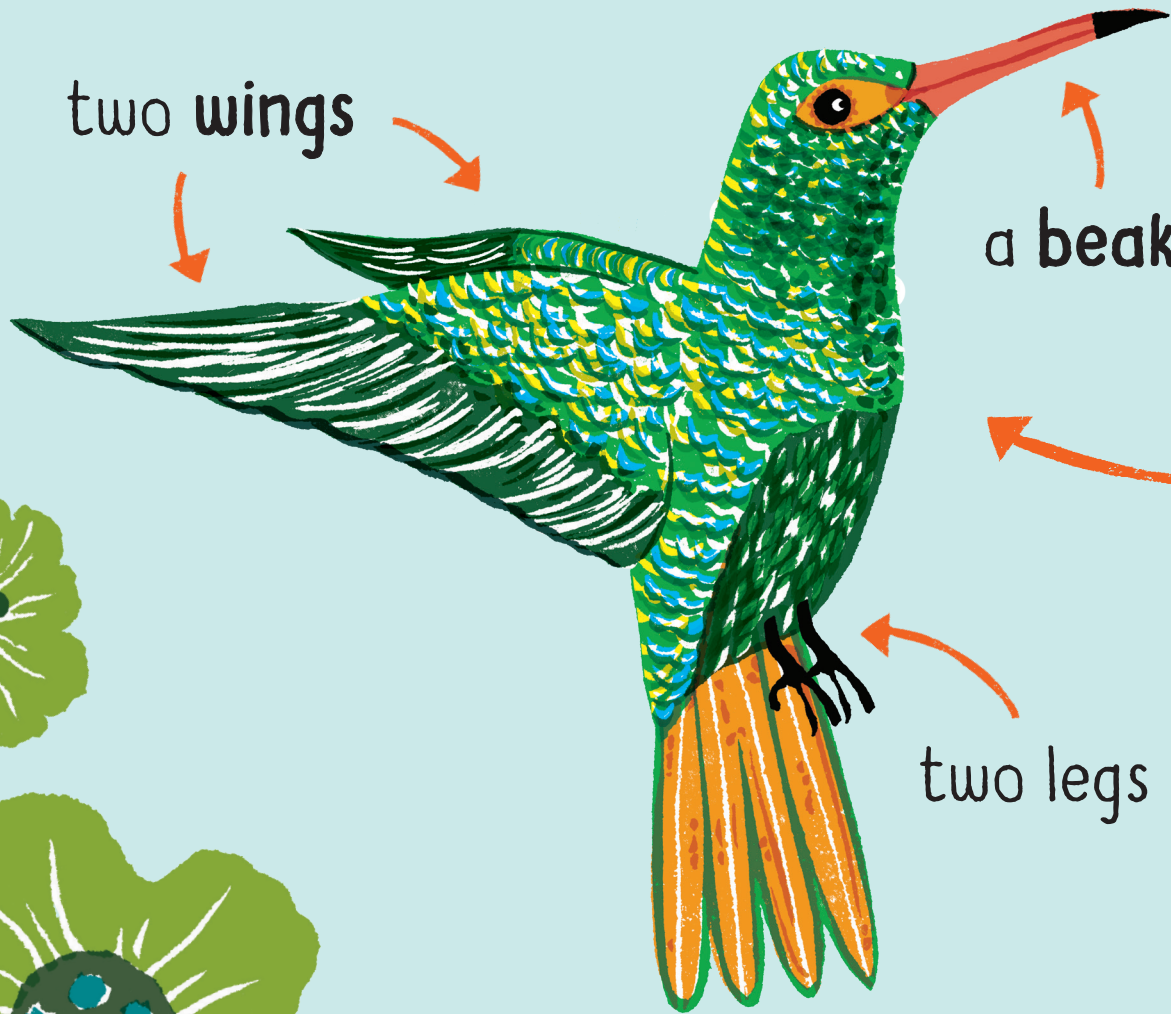
two wings
