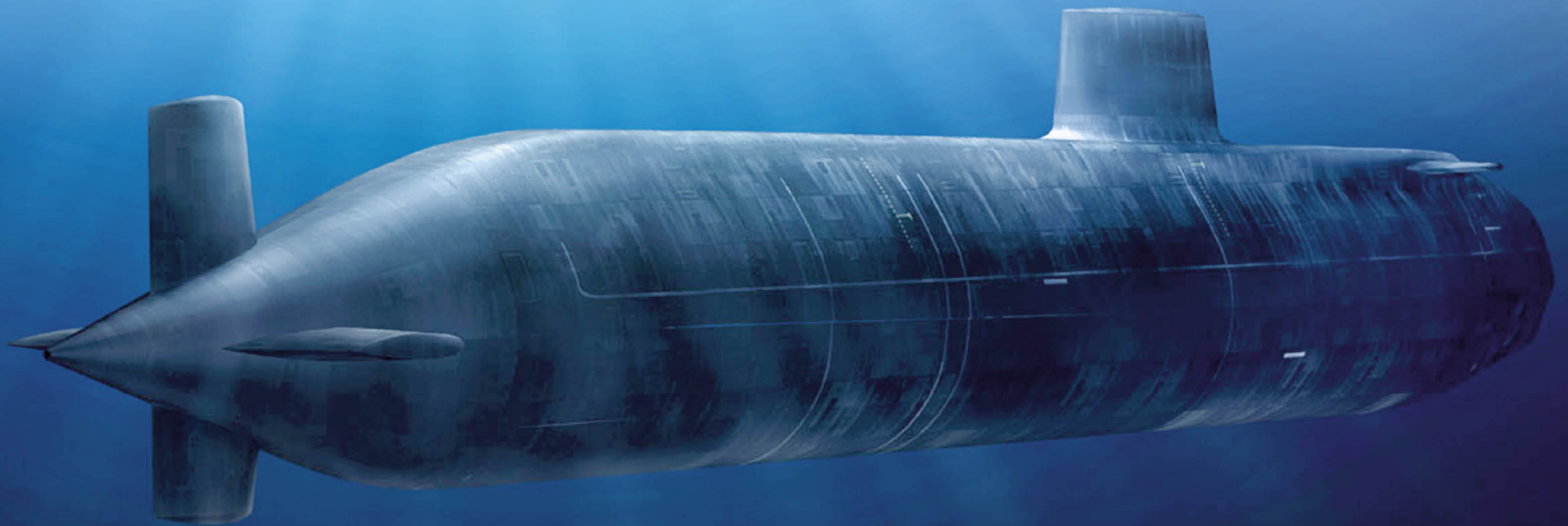


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A strange shape appears

Glossary

Hatch

An opening used to get into a submarine

Octopus

An aquatic animal that has eight arms, each with two rows of suckers

ROV

Short for remotely operated vehicle, an ROV is a robotic submersible that people can control from the deck of a ship

Sail

The raised part near the front of a submarine

Shark

A fast-swimming fish that has sharp, pointed teeth and at least one fin on its back



Submarine

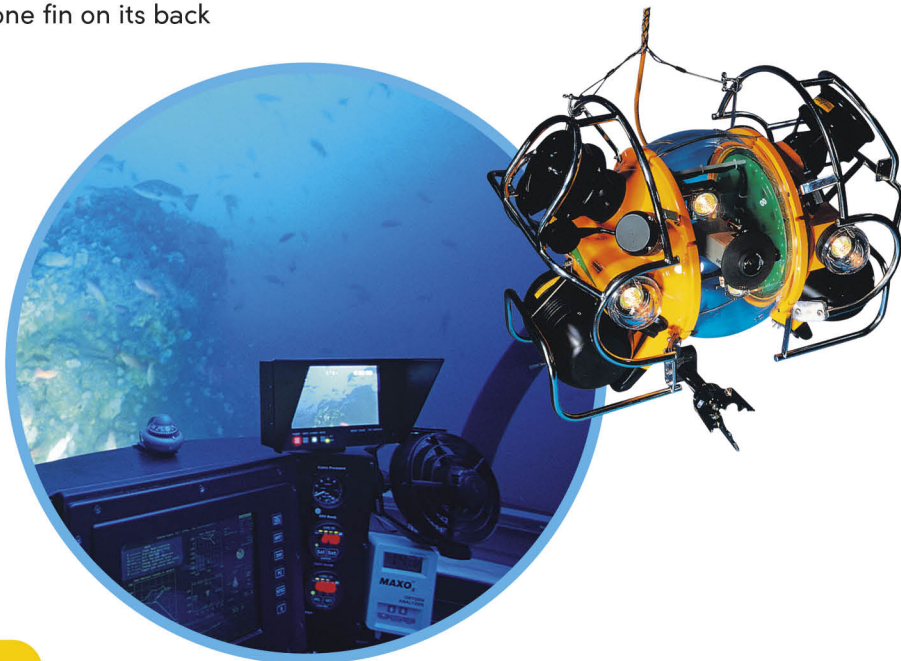
[sub-muh-REEN]

An underwater craft that can travel with more than 120 people inside

Submersible

[sub-MER-suh-bull]

An underwater craft that is used for deep-sea studies



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
