next to him doing it also.





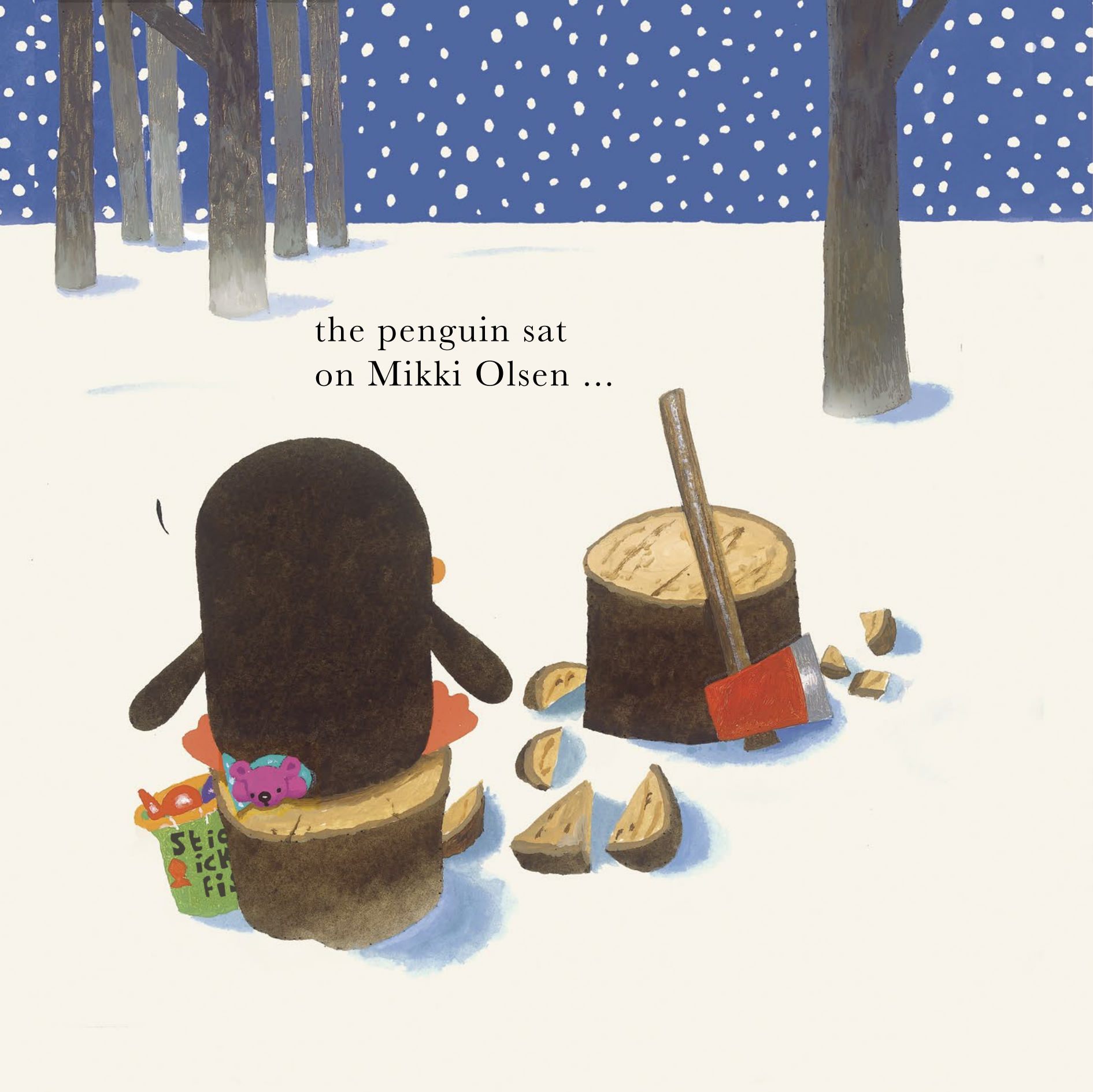
Because the last thing the penguin wanted was to lose Mikki Olsen.
