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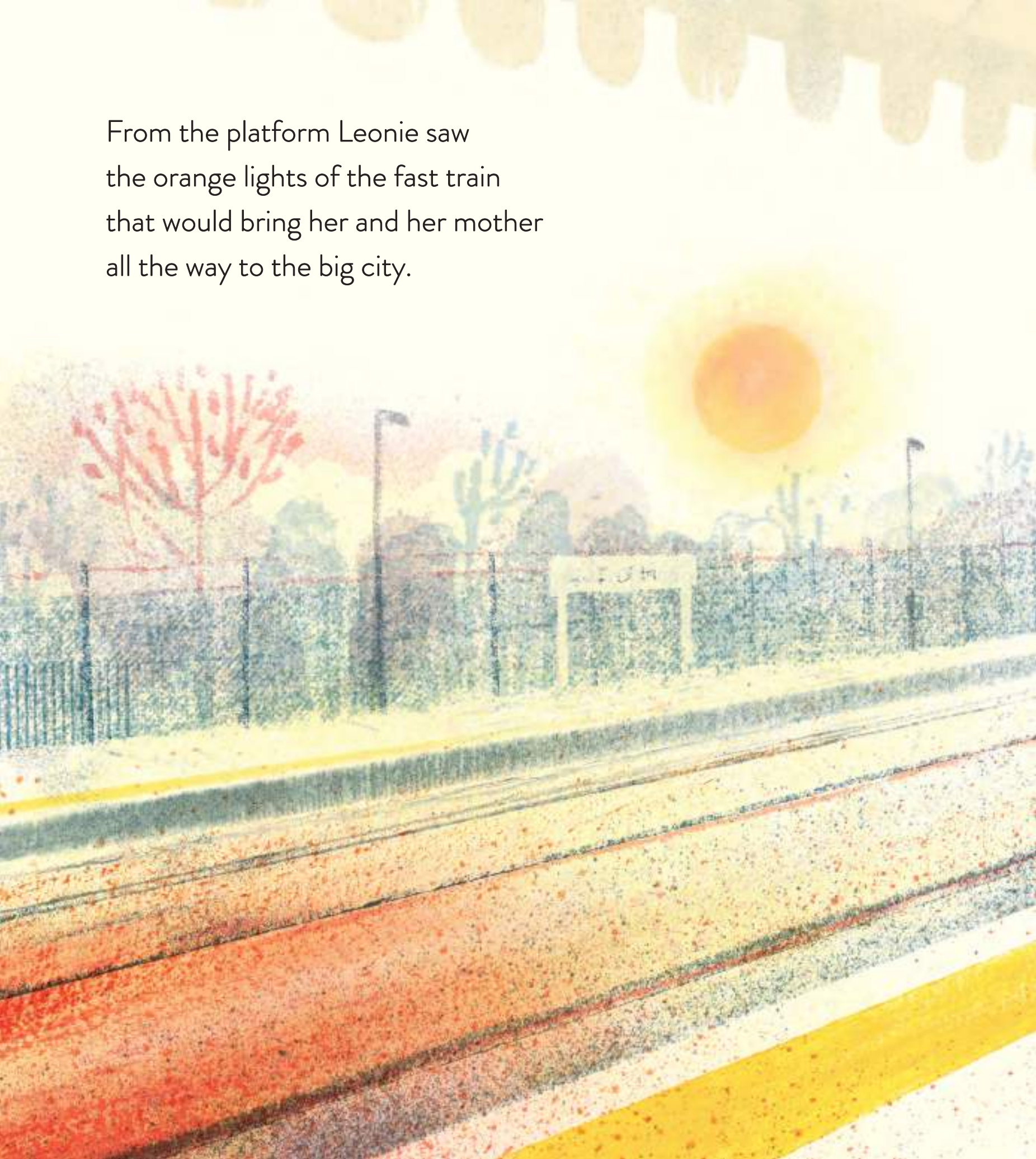


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From the platform Leonie saw

From head . . .

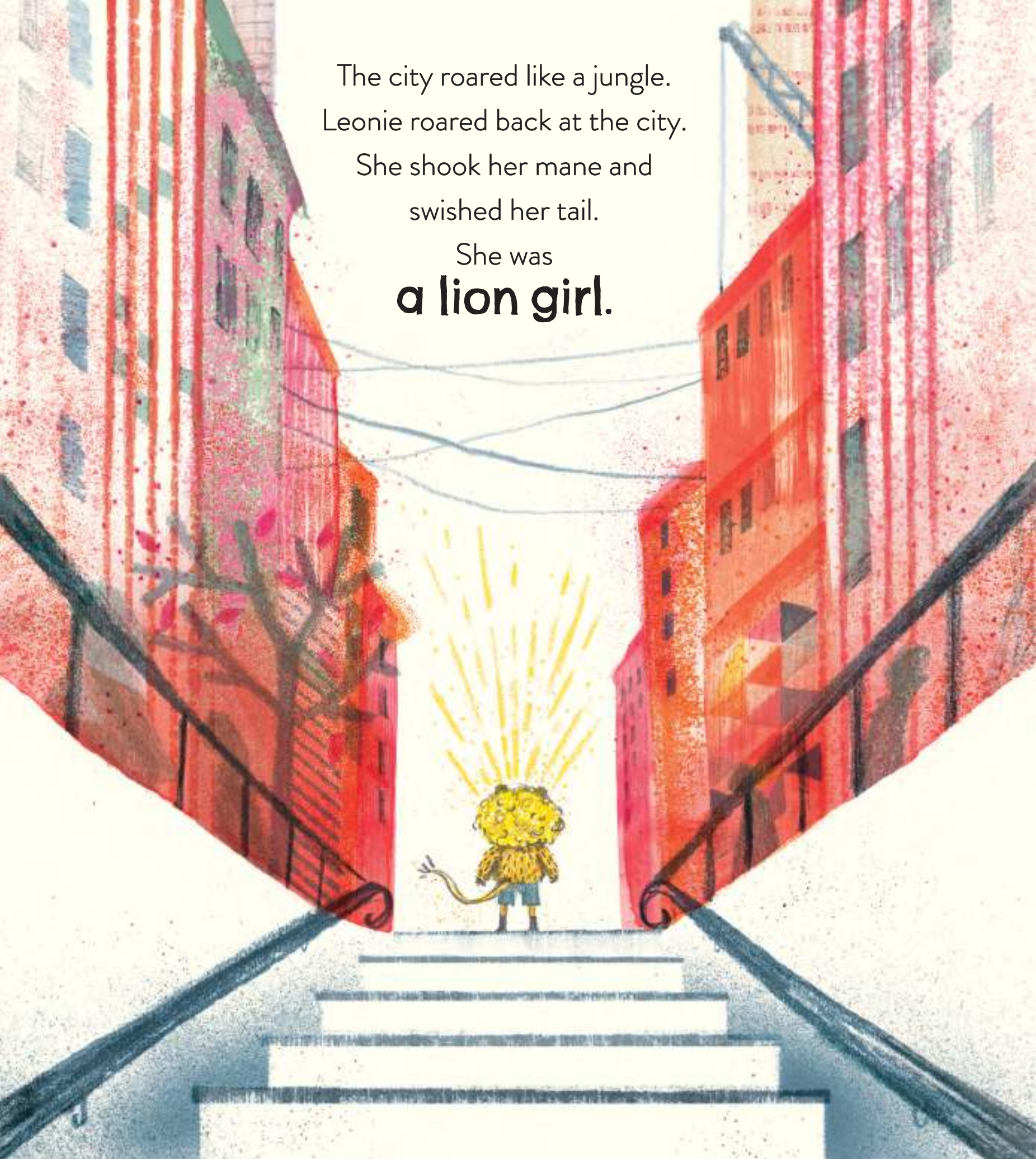


. . . to tail.
