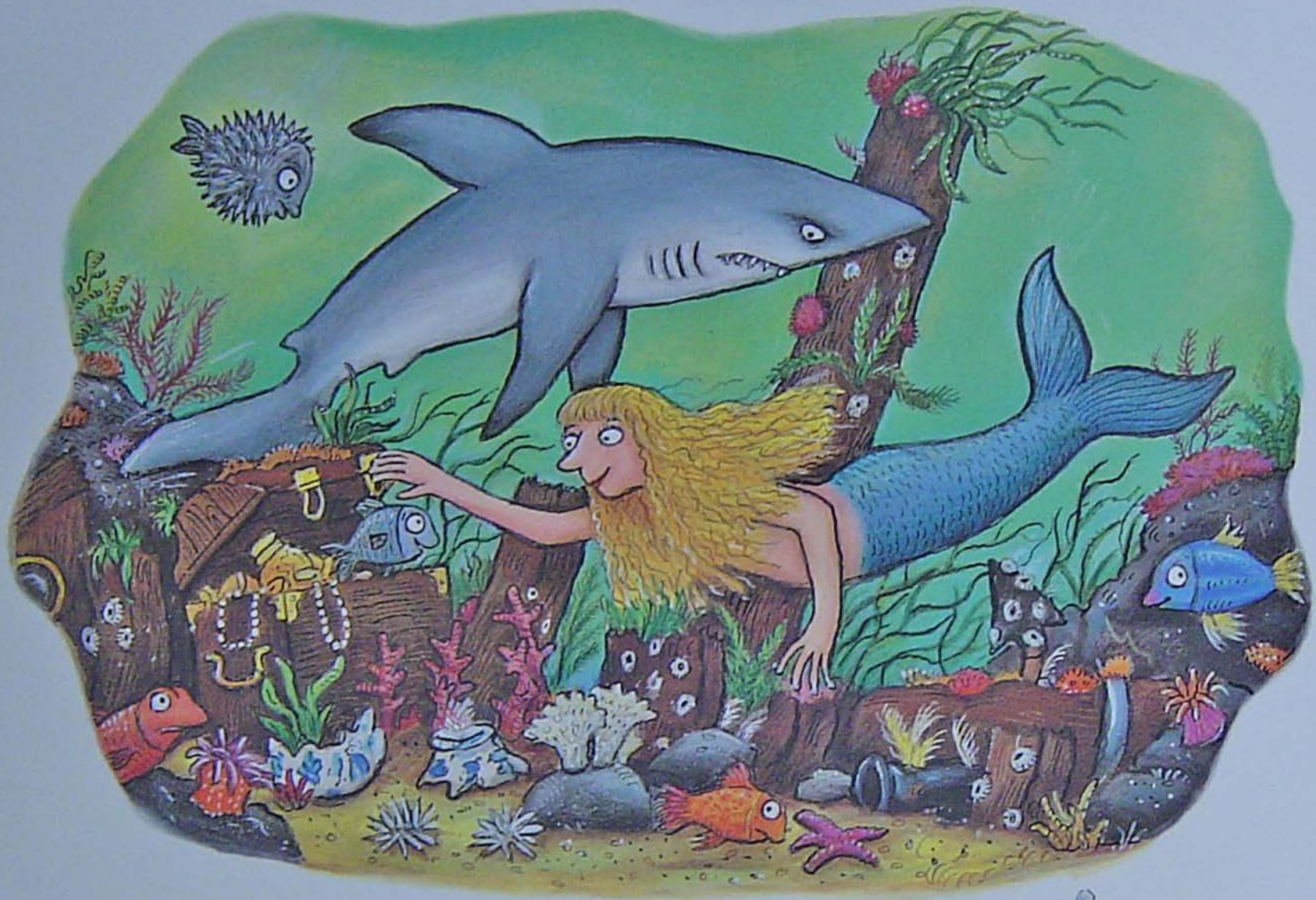

"Oh, no, she didn't." "OH, YES, SHE DID."

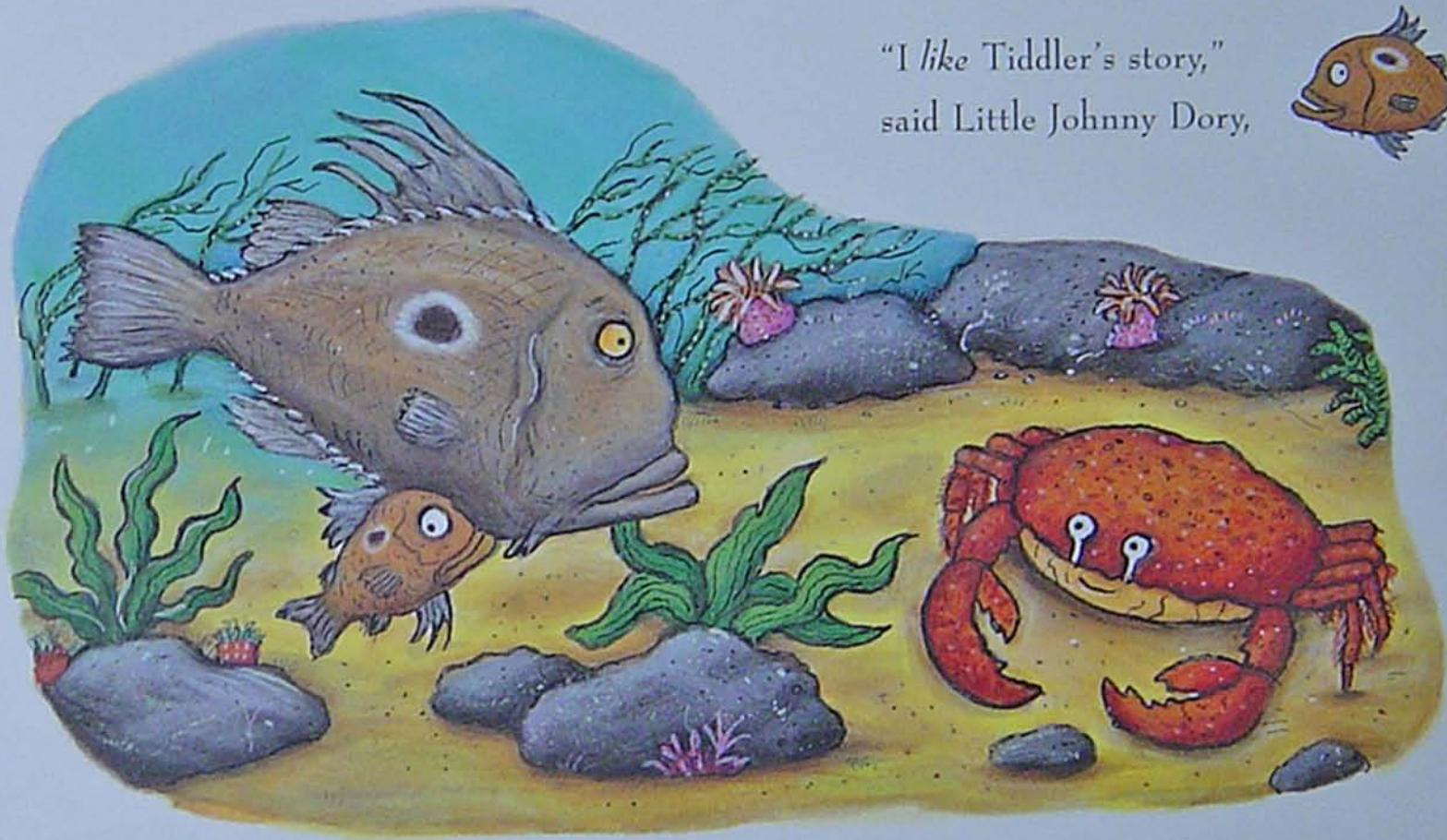

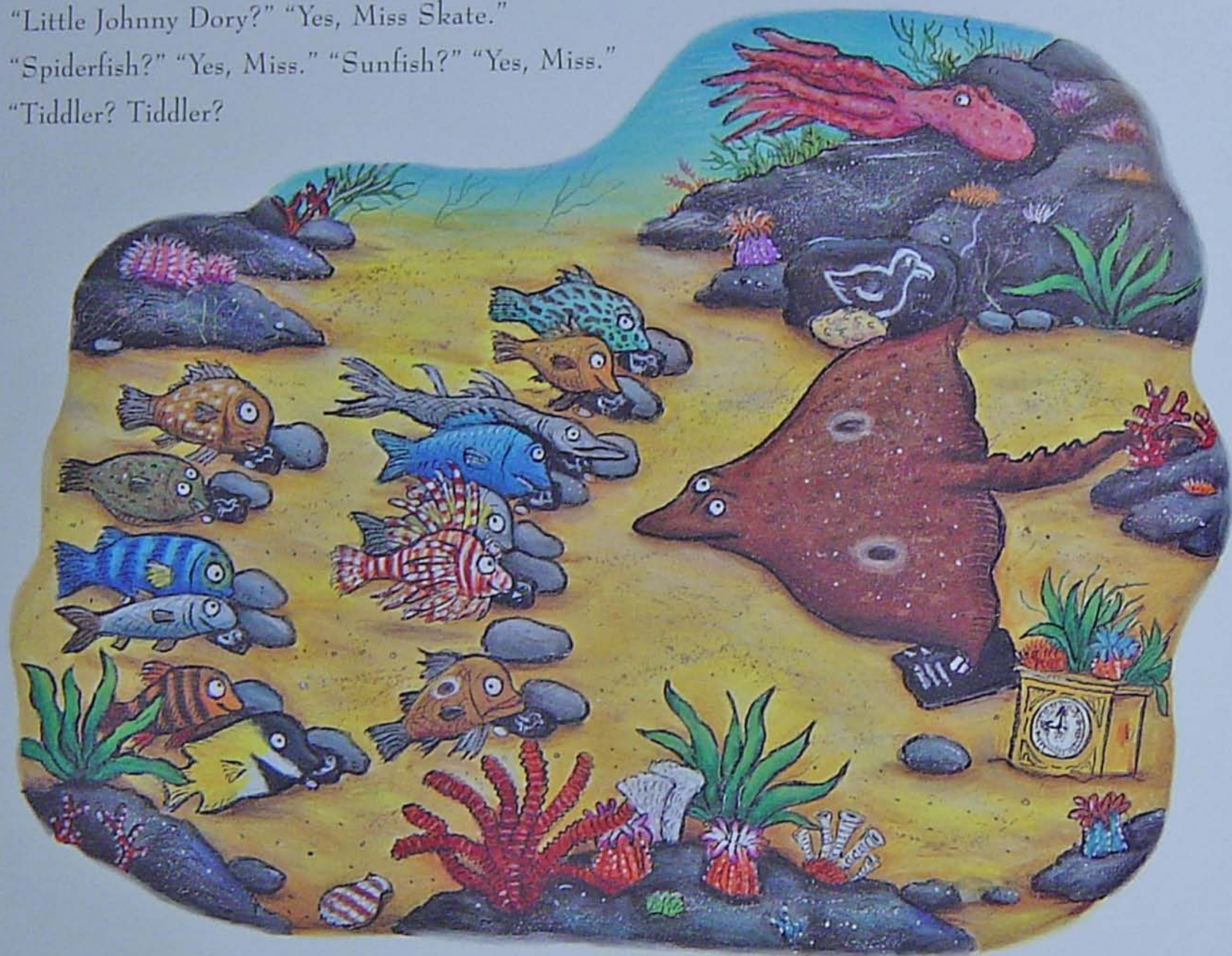
"Just a silly story," said Dragonfish and Dab.
