Chapter 1: Dr Kim's Camp

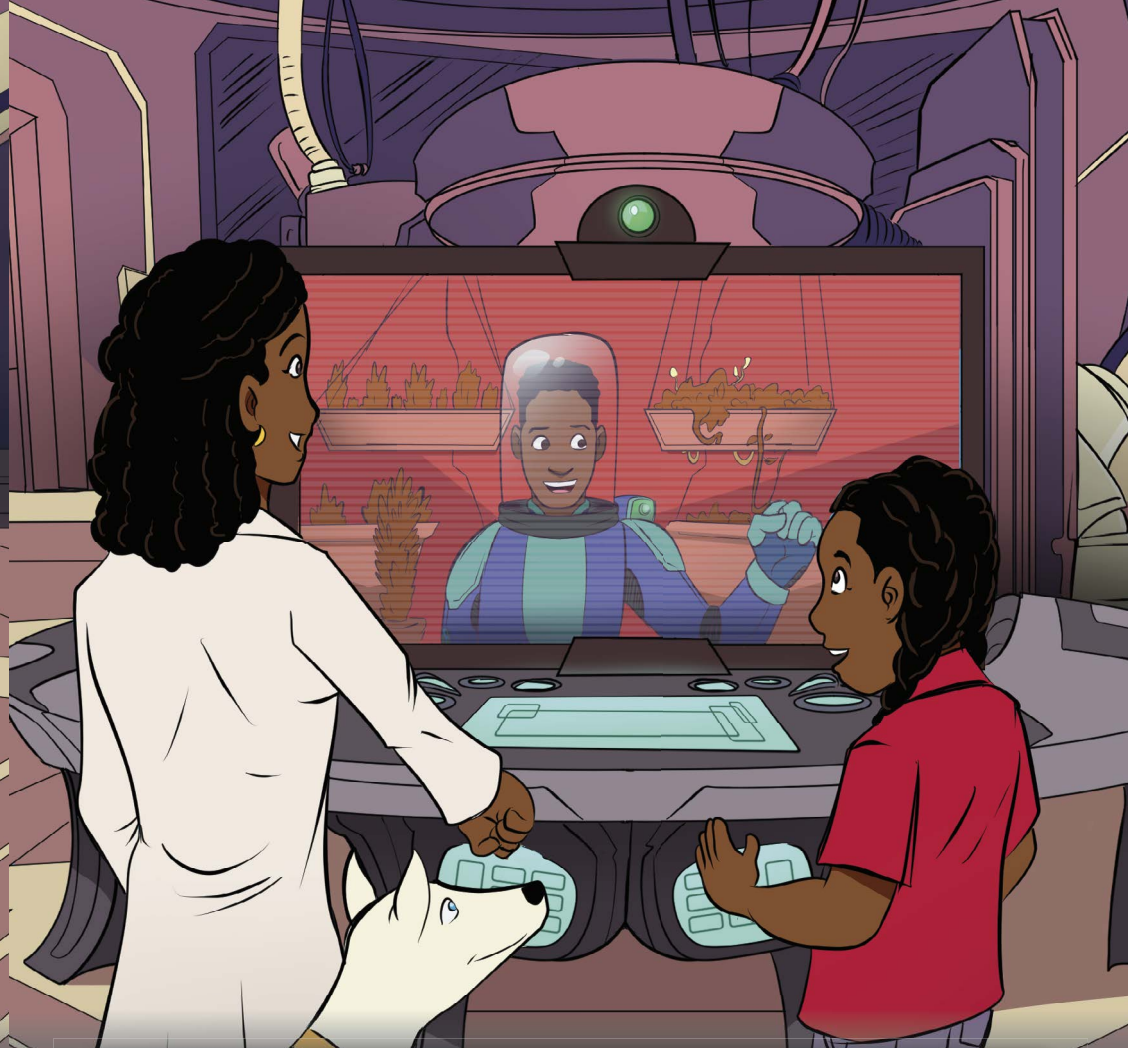


Mel is Dom's sis. Dom is on the Red Planet. Mel is a big planet fan.

But the doc cannot fix it.

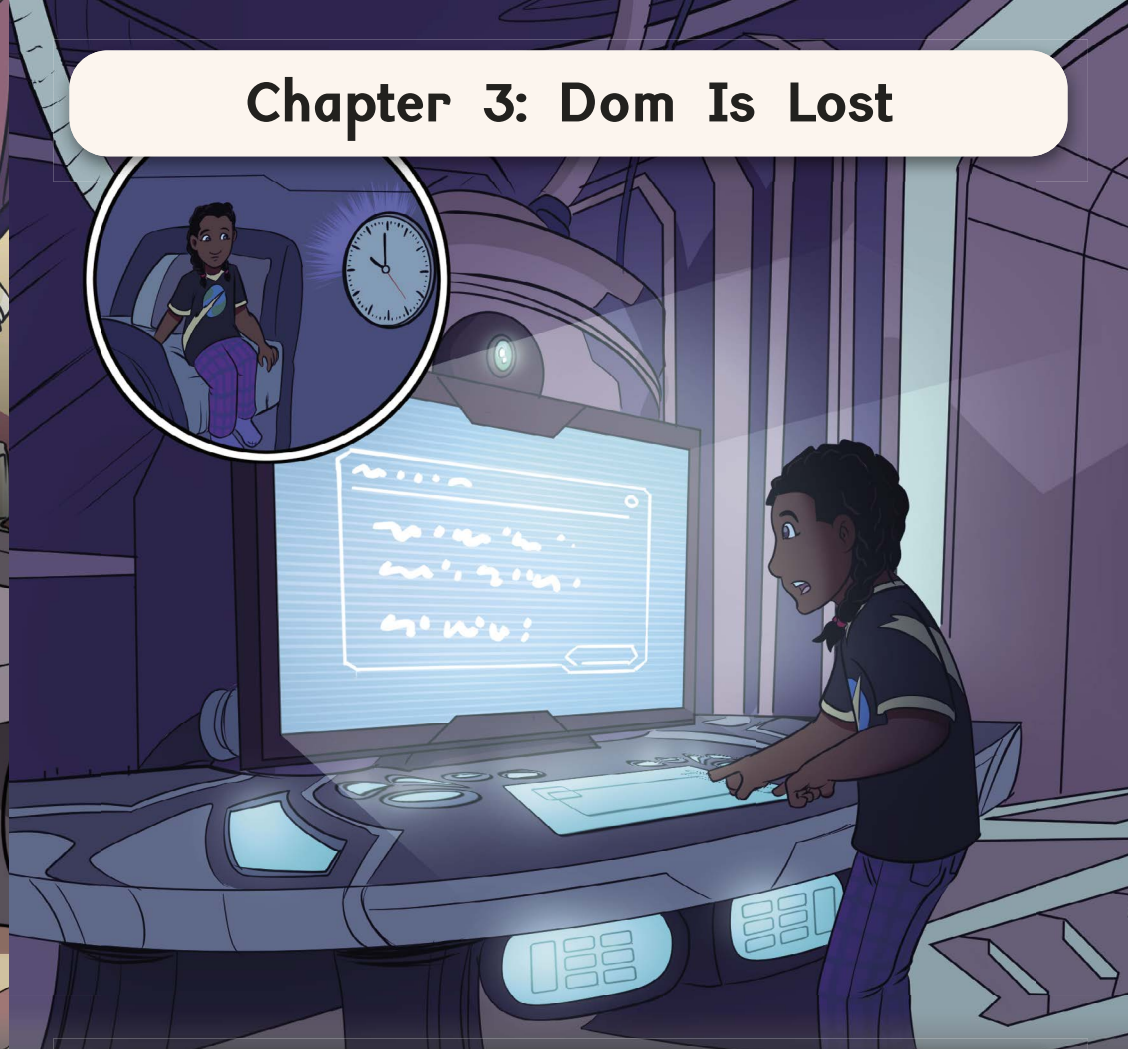
Chapter 3: Dom Is Lost
