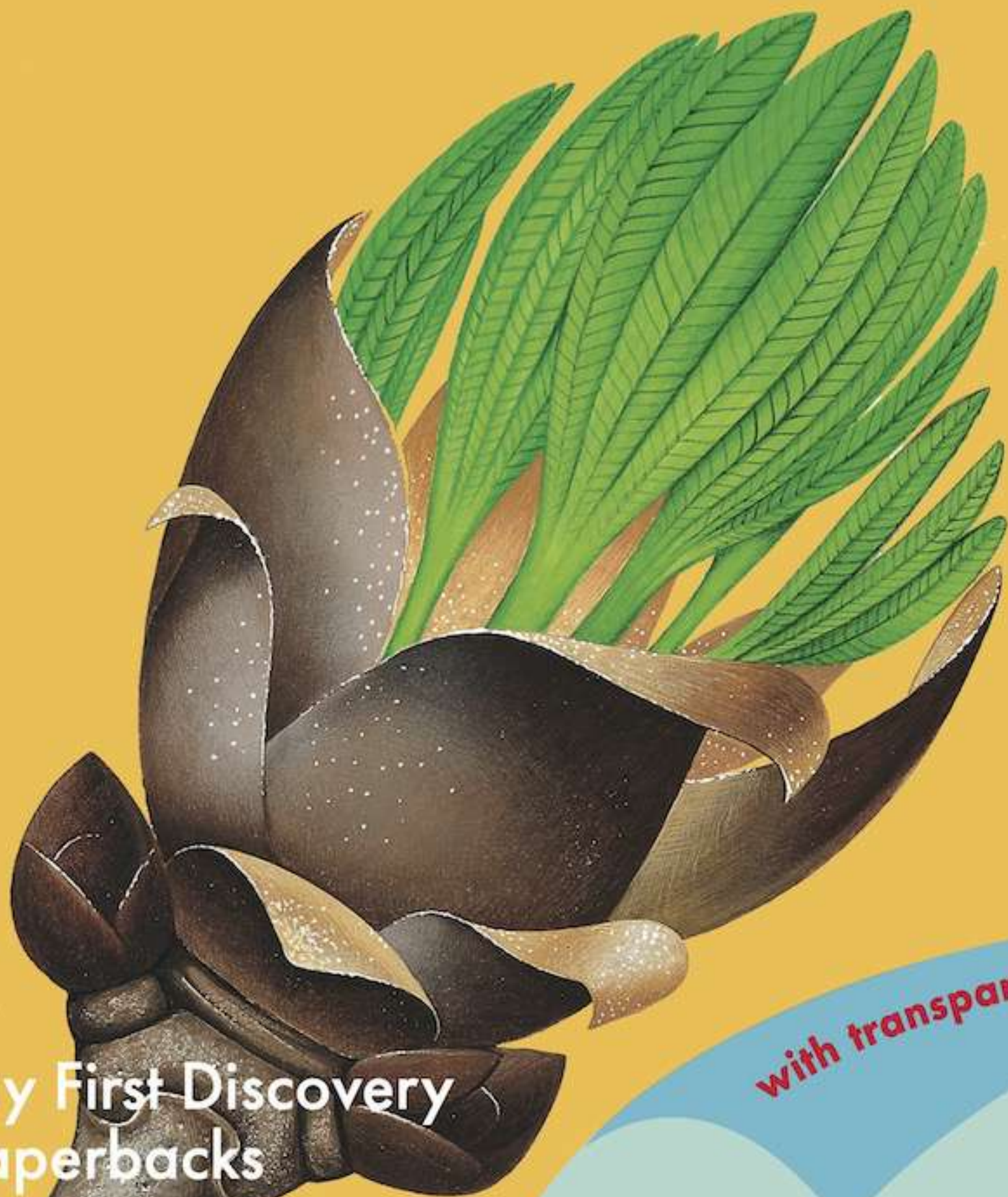

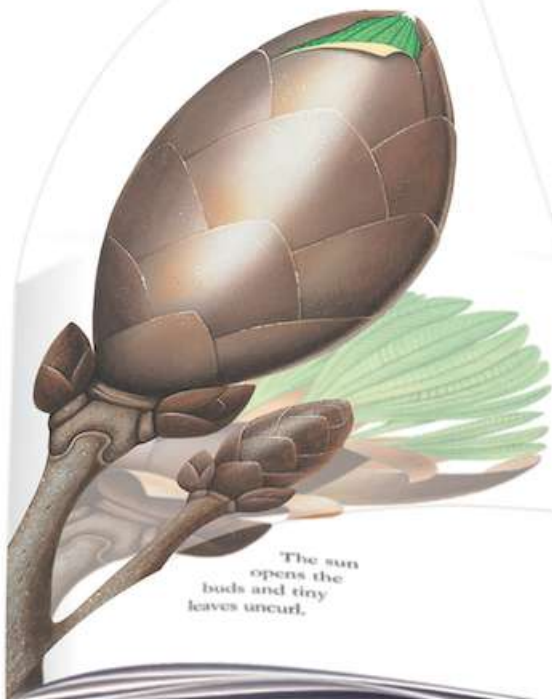

of every branch.

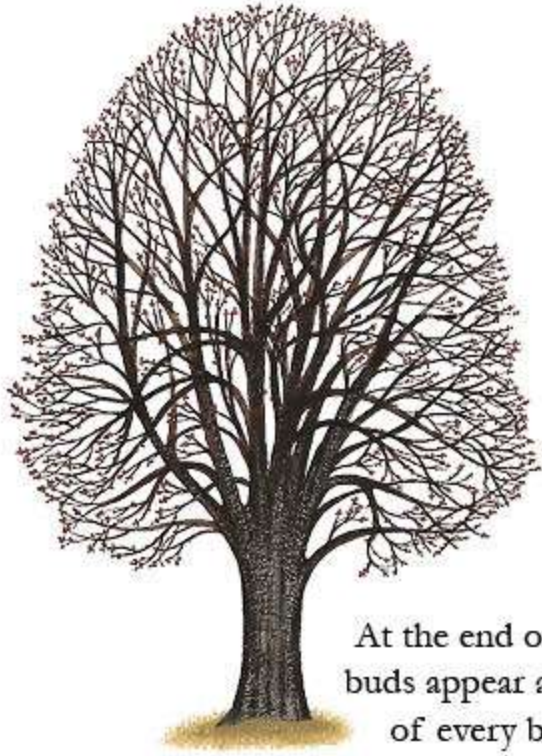


The sun

A conker is the seed of a horse chestnut tree. It grows slowly and a tiny tree shoots up.

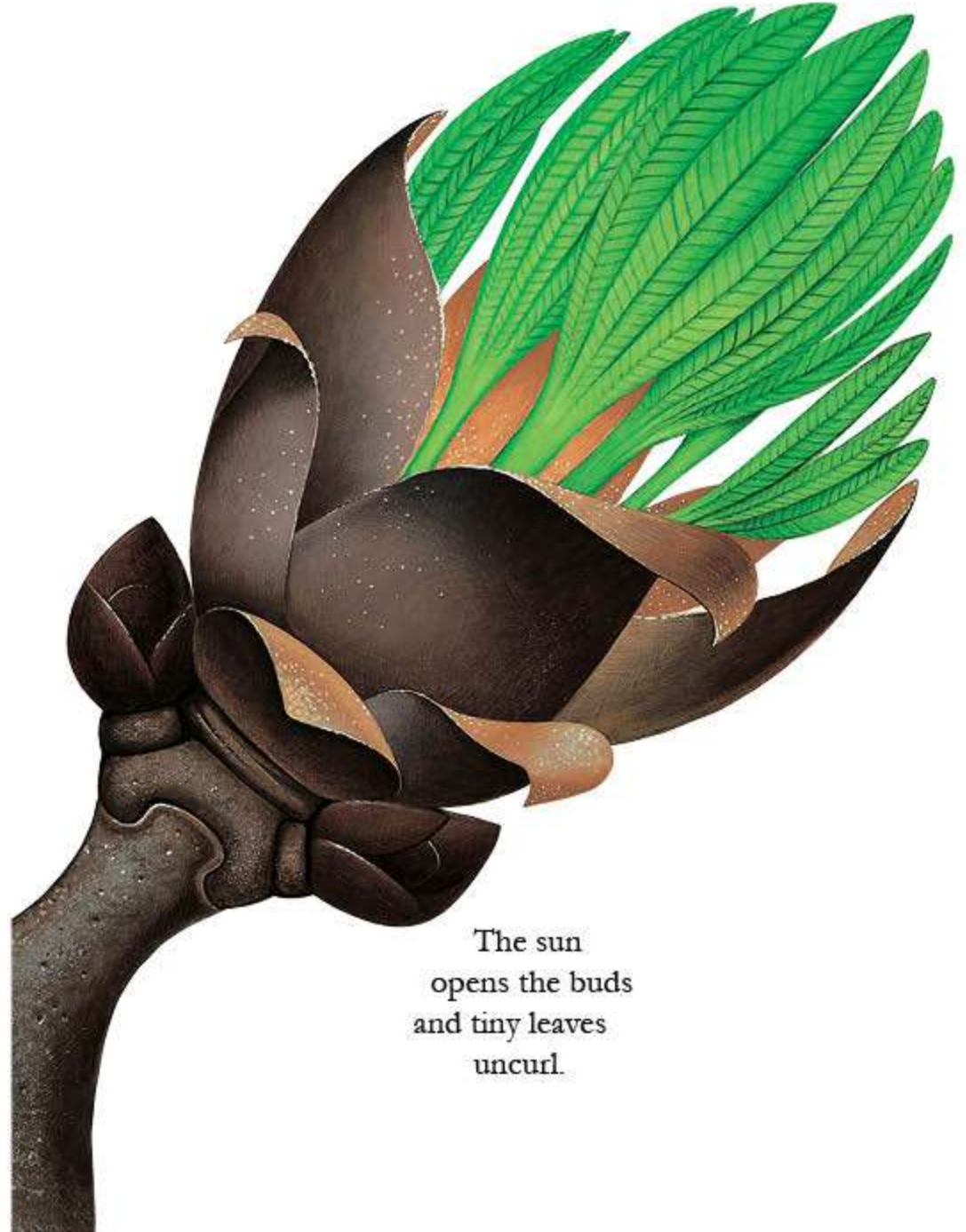


Roots reach down into the ground under the tree to find food and water.
