Louie saw something completely and utterly **terrifying**...



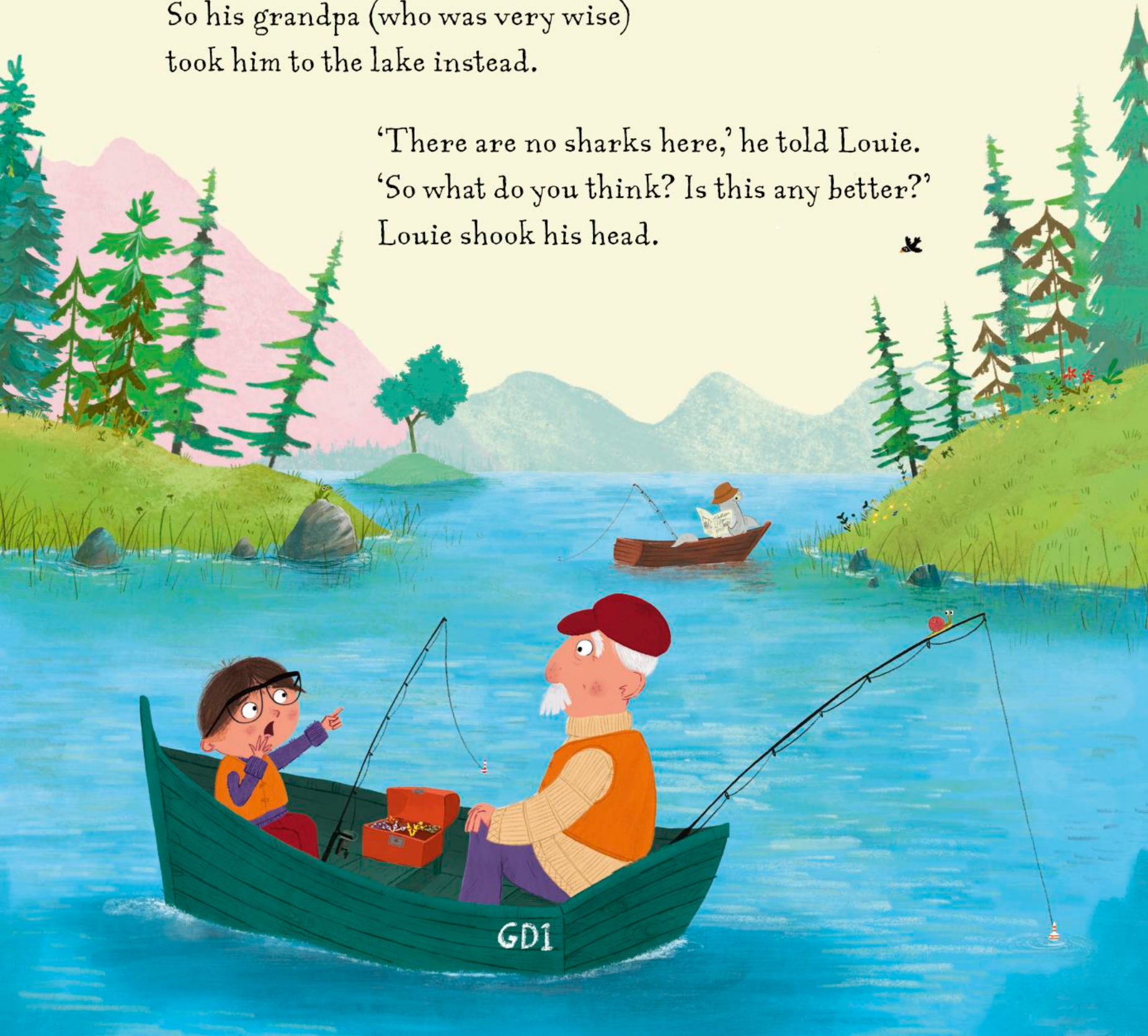

made Louie **JUMPY**...



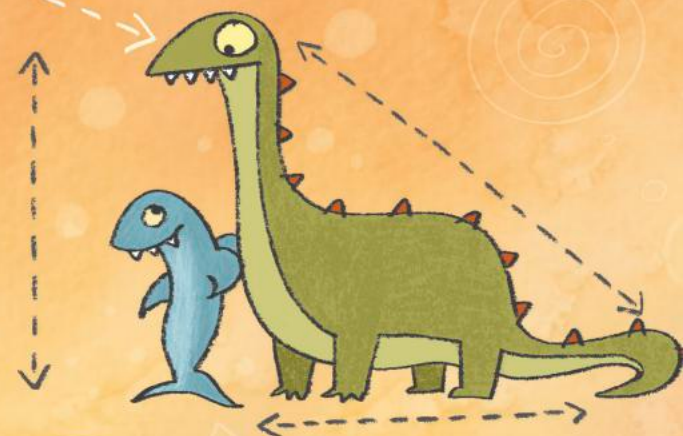
paddling pools gave him the
