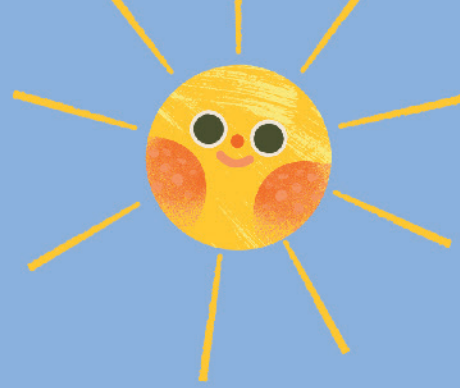

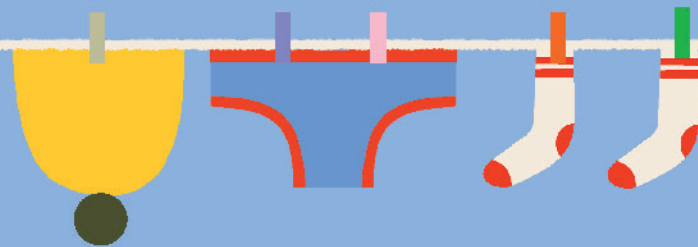
I hope you like it . . .
