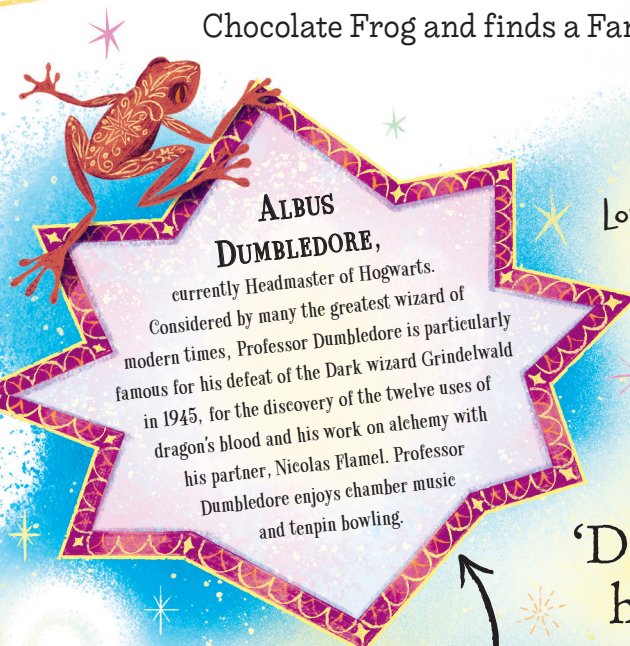

Dumbledore's Office

If students get into trouble, they are sent to see Dumbledore (something Harry and Ron know all about).

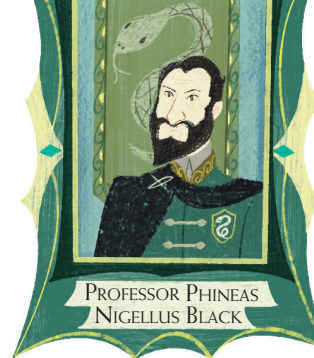

A rare, enchanted object used to study stored thoughts and memories

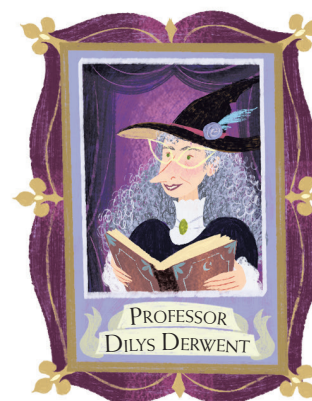
Curious silver instruments

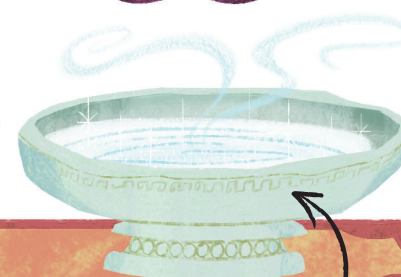

Fawkes

Dumbledore's companion is Fawkes, a magical phoenix. Fawkes is very intelligent, gentle and extremely loyal to Dumbledore.

Very few wizards have ever succeeded in taming a phoenix

Acts as a look-out for Dumbledore (sends a flash of flame and a feather to warn of danger)

Can often be found on his golden perch in Dumbledore's office

Fawkes's feathers form the core of both Harry's and Lord Voldemort's wands

Will defend Dumbledore in battle

“Fascinating creatures, phoenixes. They can carry immensely heavy loads, their tears have healing powers and they make highly *faithful* pets.”

Phoenix song is enchanting to listen to

Fawkes is roughly the size of a swan

Can magically disappear from one place and reappear in another, even inside Hogwarts (which is said to be impossible)

THE LIFE-CYCLE OF A PHOENIX

The phoenix lives to a very old age as it can regenerate. On its Burning Day, the phoenix bursts into flames and rises again from the ashes as a chick.
