WINSTON

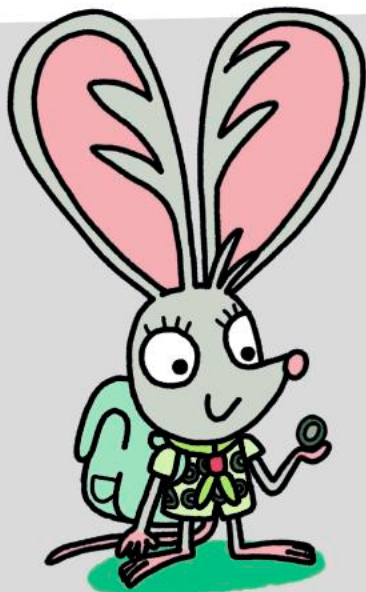
Winston is a Woggle Scout leader who is keen to relive his days as an adventurer.

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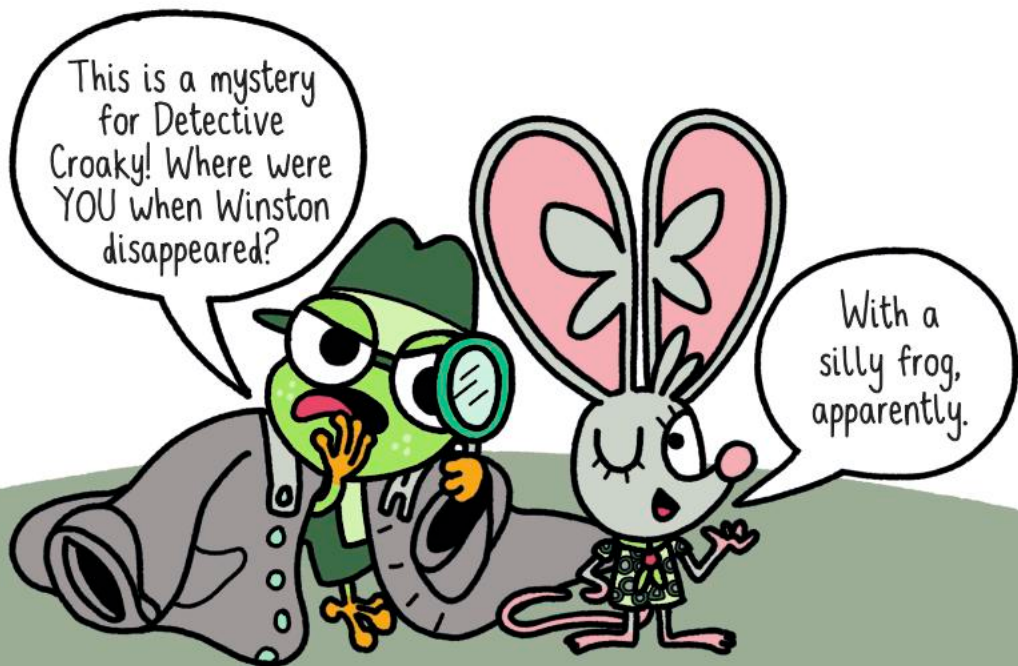
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‘Where could he be?’ asked Sheena as she and Croaky Hopper searched the Woggle Scout hut for Winston, their leader.
