his baseball cap,



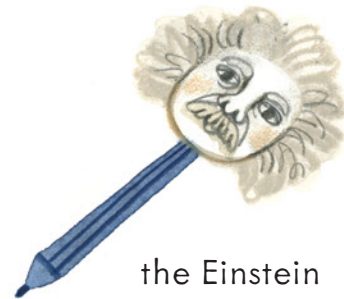
his special sweater with the dogs,



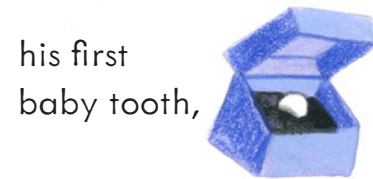
his favorite
