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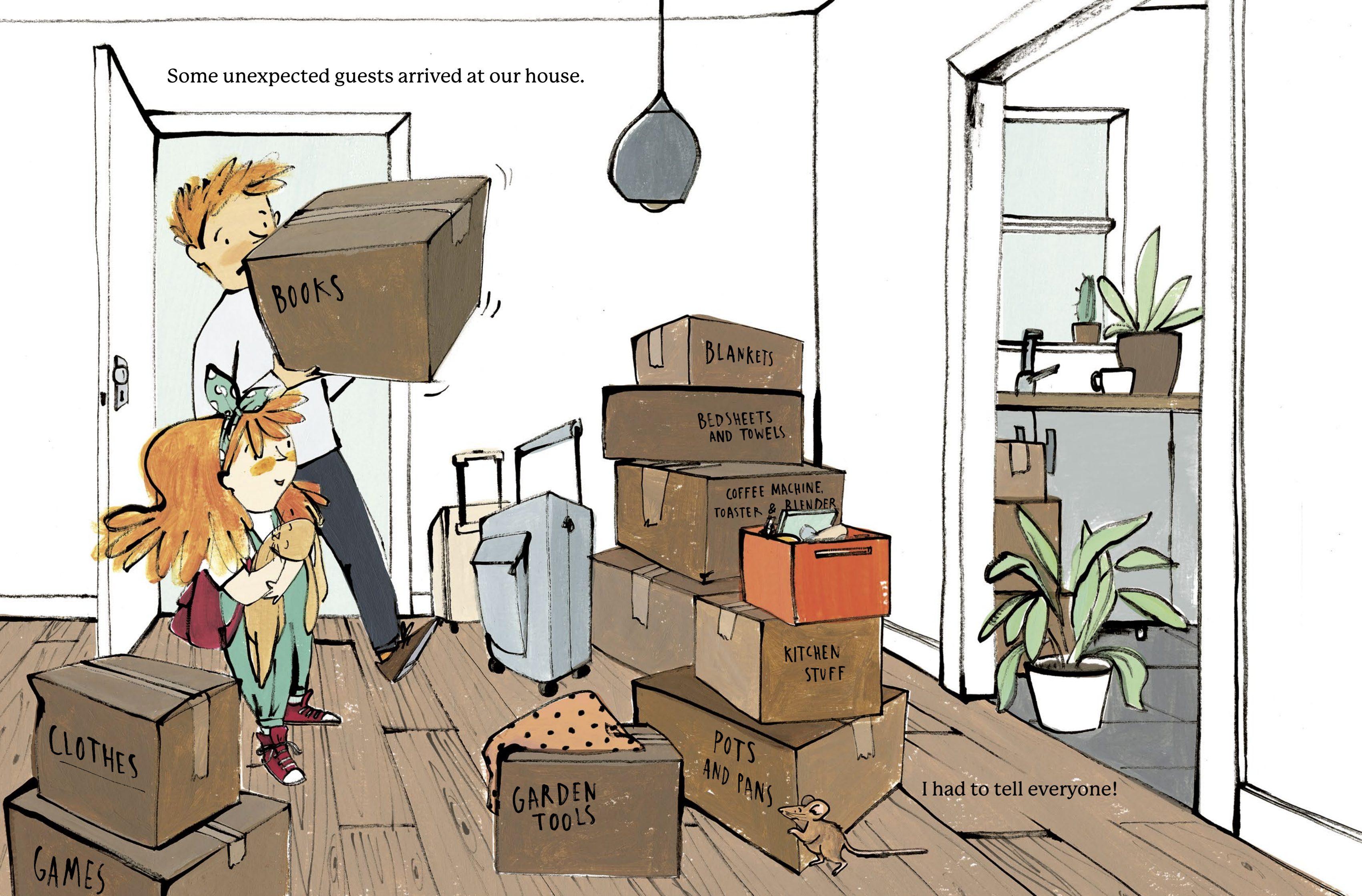
UNEXPECTED GUESTS

good with blue fur.)



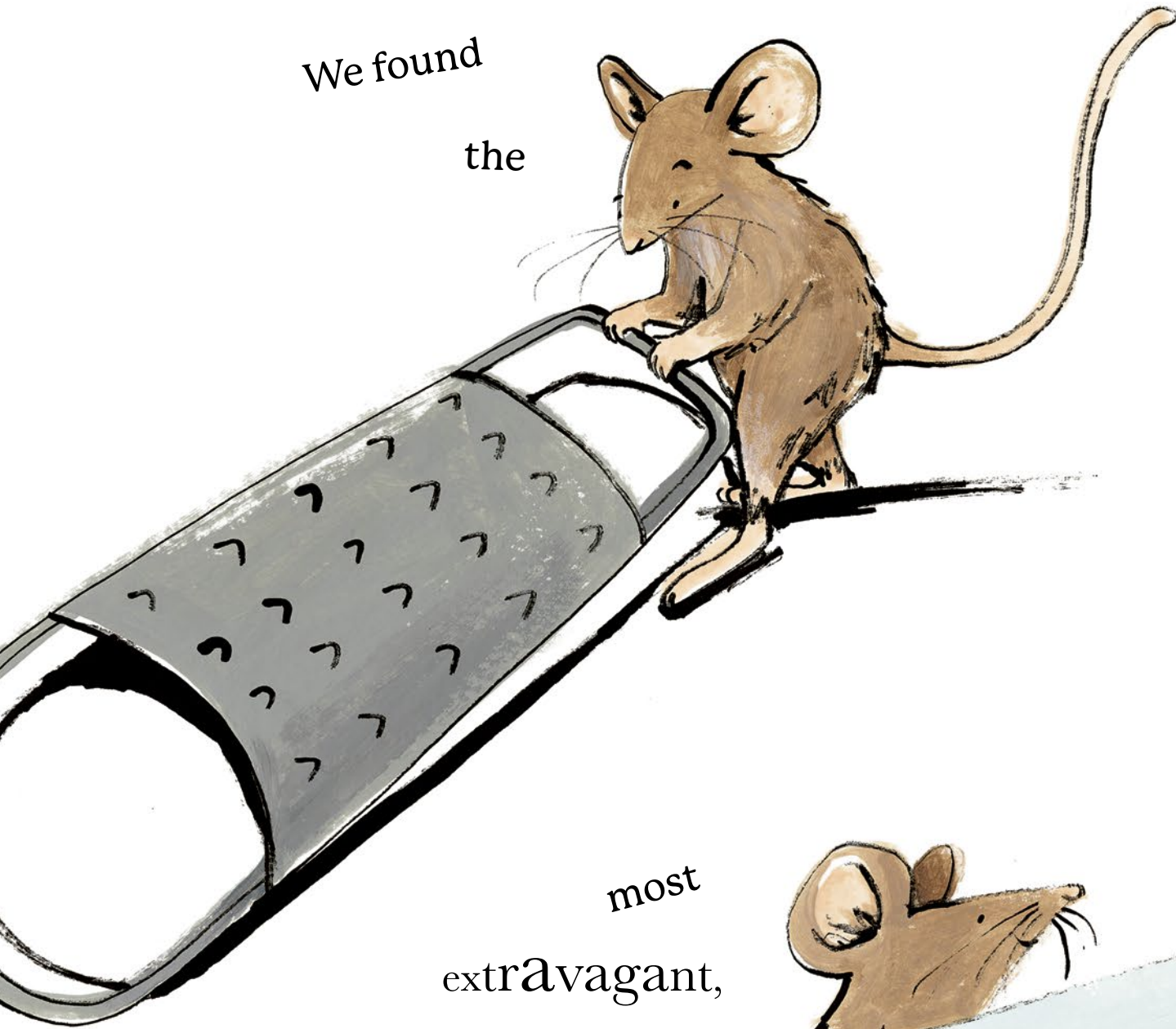
But Uncle Rupert says all sorts of things . . .
