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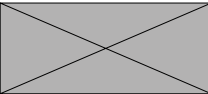

There was no space for . . .

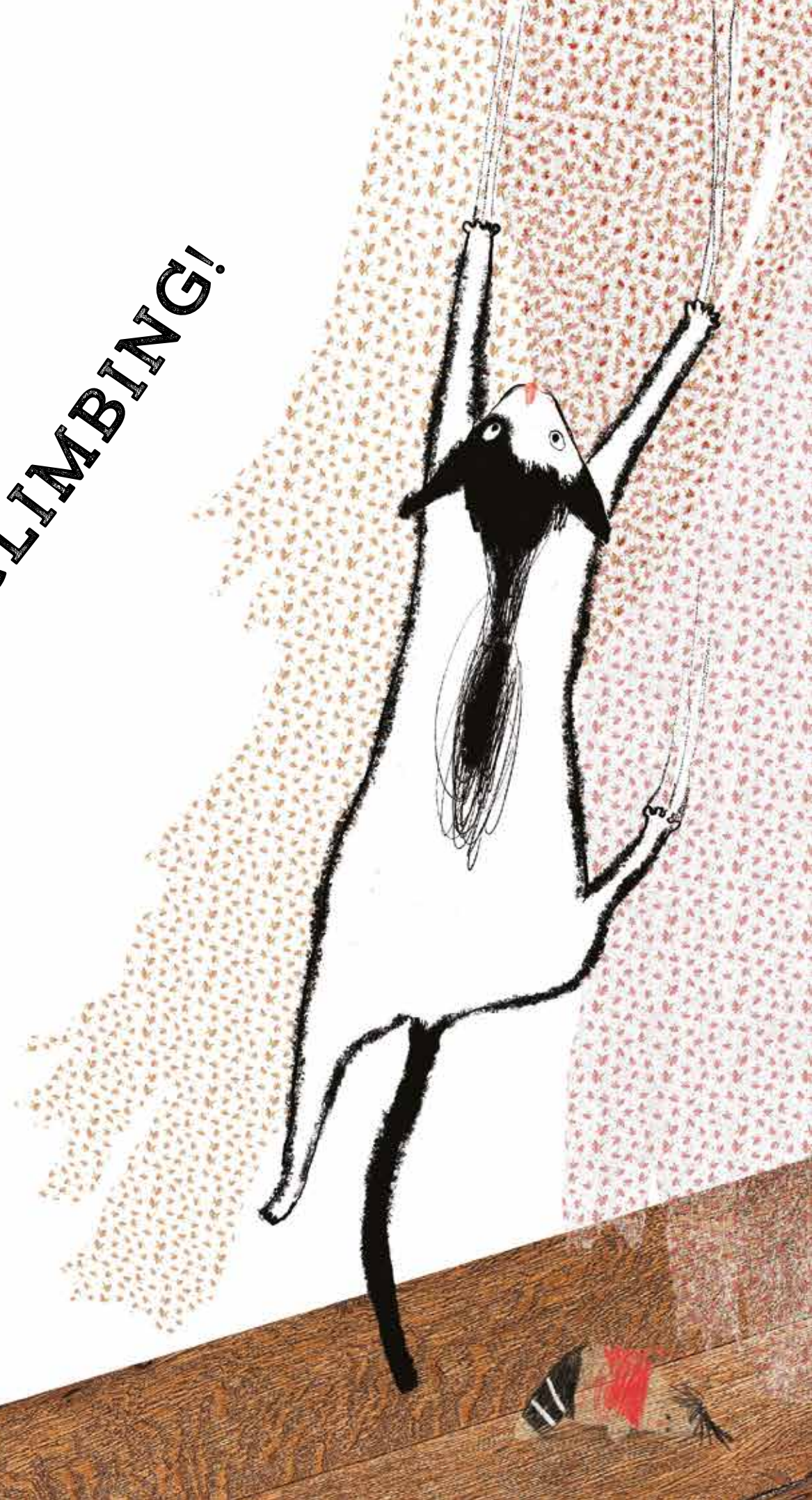
SOFA SCRATCHING,

DANIELA STAMATIADI

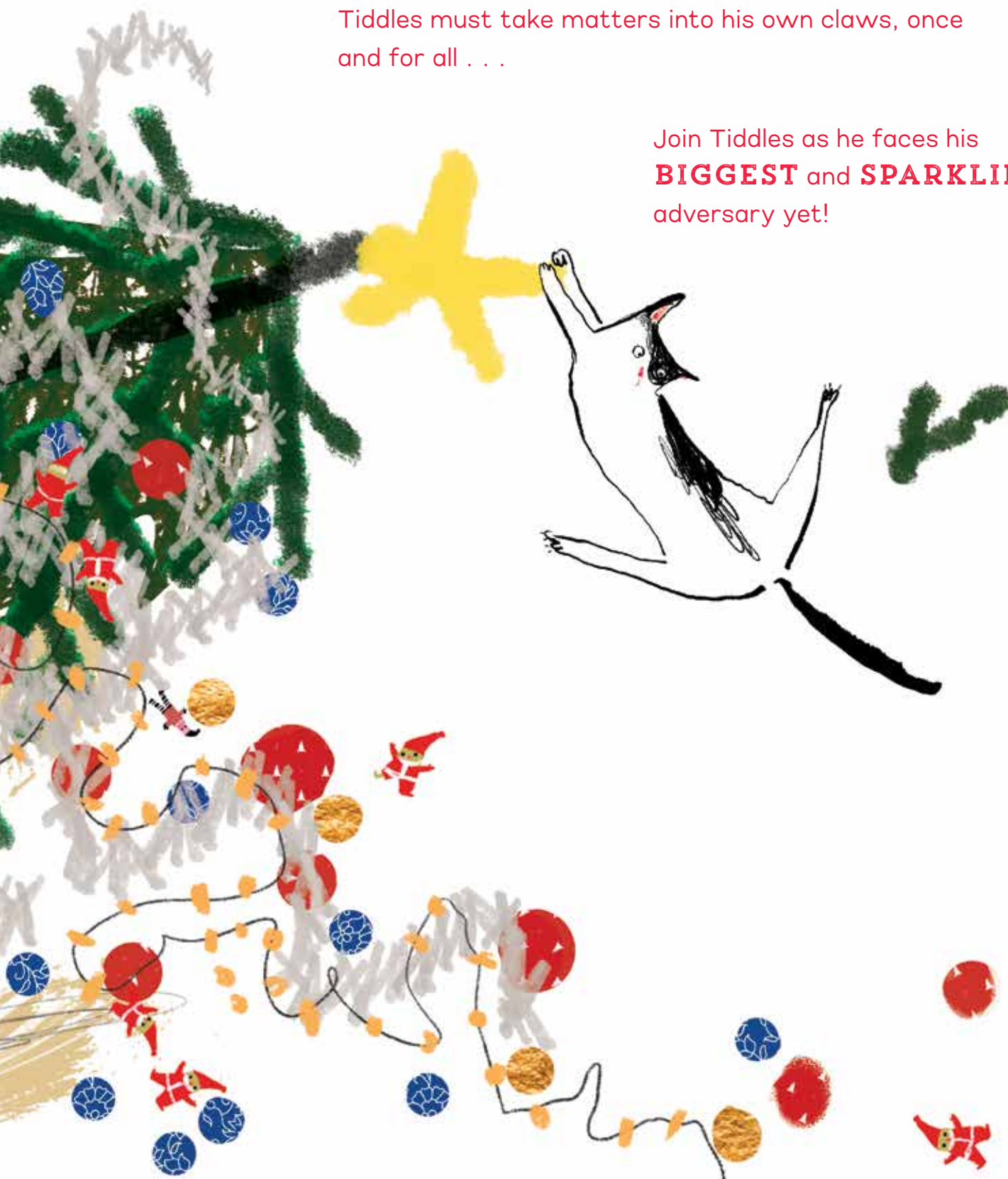

Her third book with her own text, *A Whole New Monkey*, was created in 2024.
