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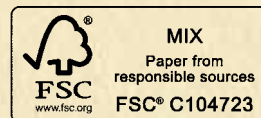
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FRED THE *Pépé Smit* (very demanding) DEER

too SMALL!



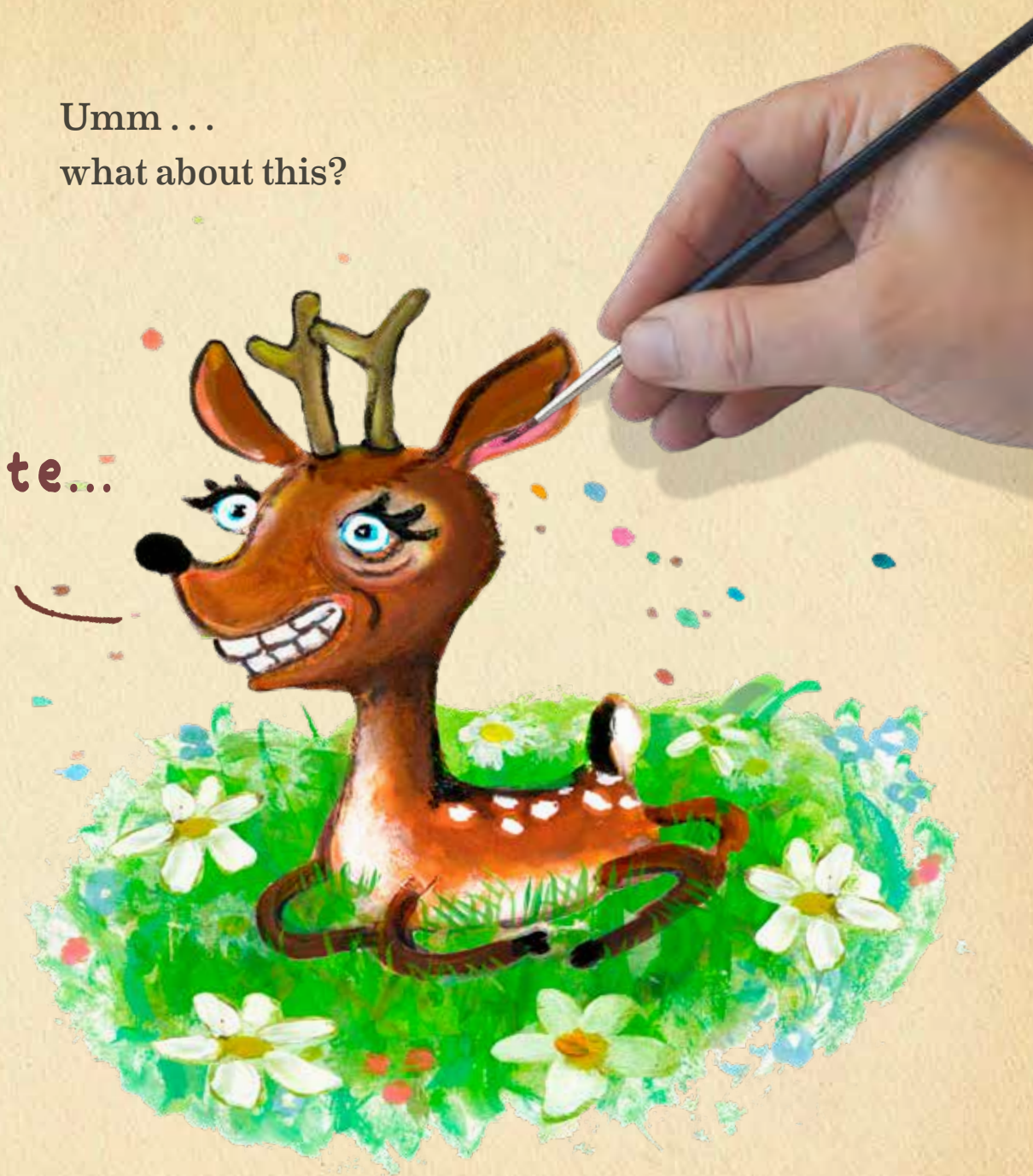
Oh! Like this, then?

Okay. So that is Fred.

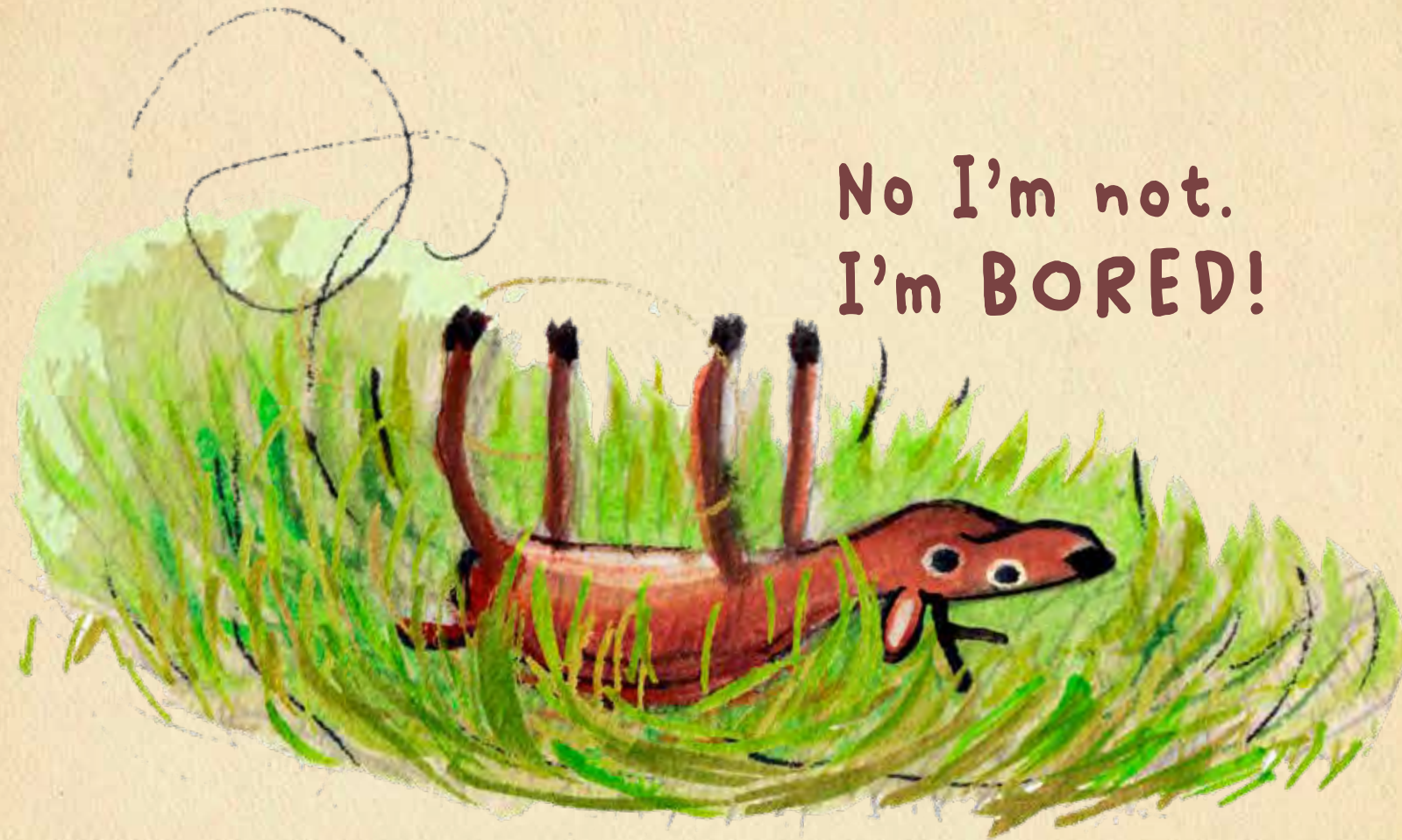


Fred lives in a big forest. He plays hide-and-seek between the trees.
