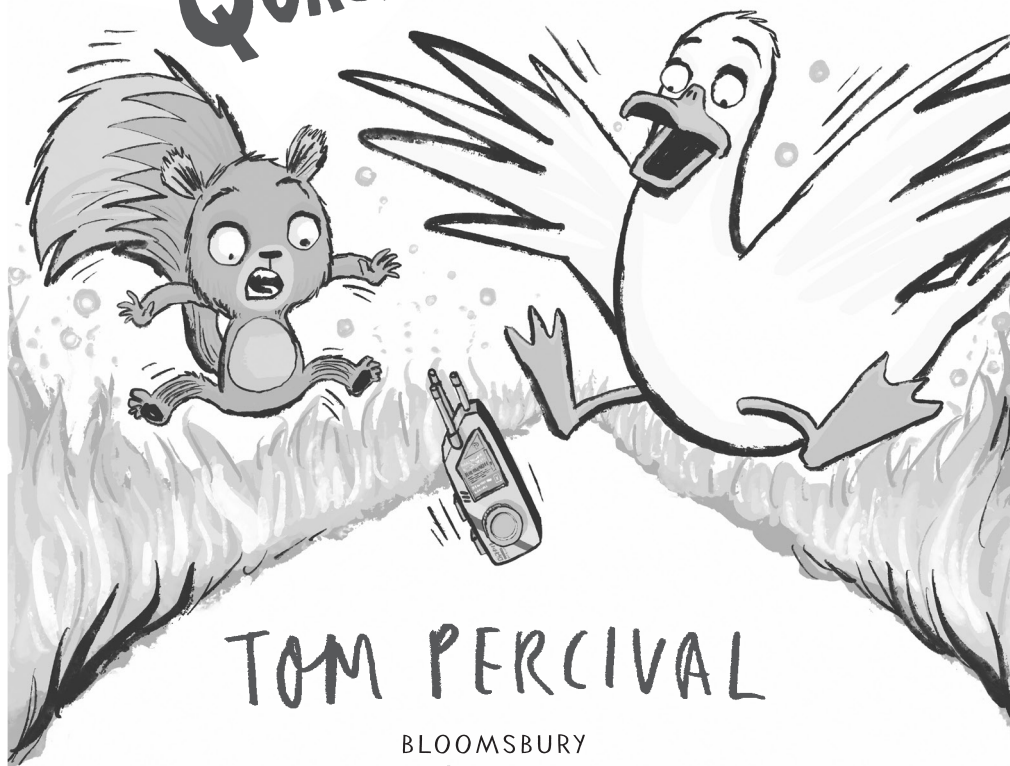

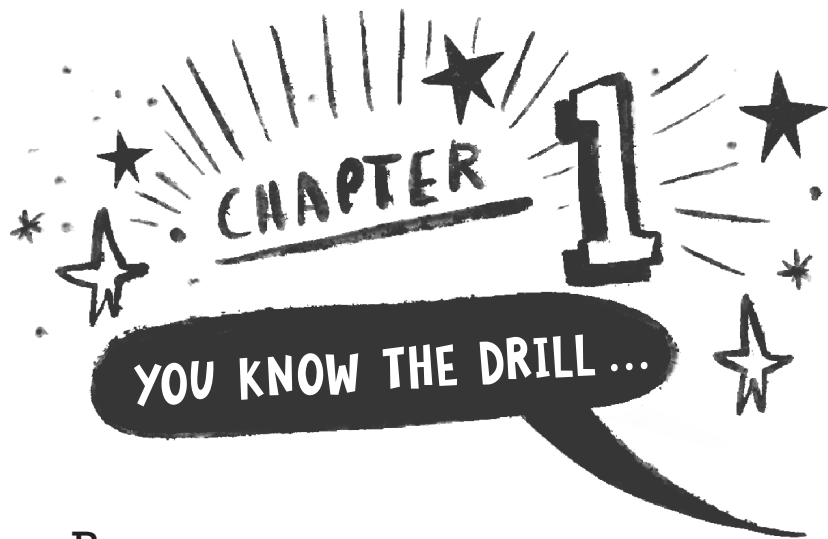

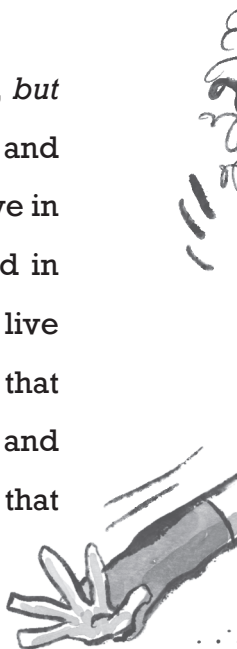

'Quack,' quacked Duck. 'Quack, quack, quack-ity, *QUACK!*'

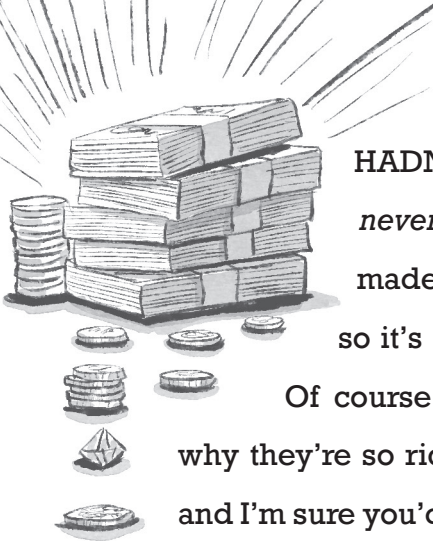

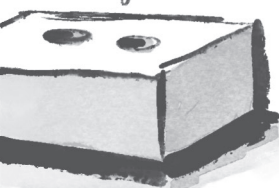




HADN'T happened, they would *never* have had the adventure that made them so fantastically rich, so it's all swings and roundabouts!
