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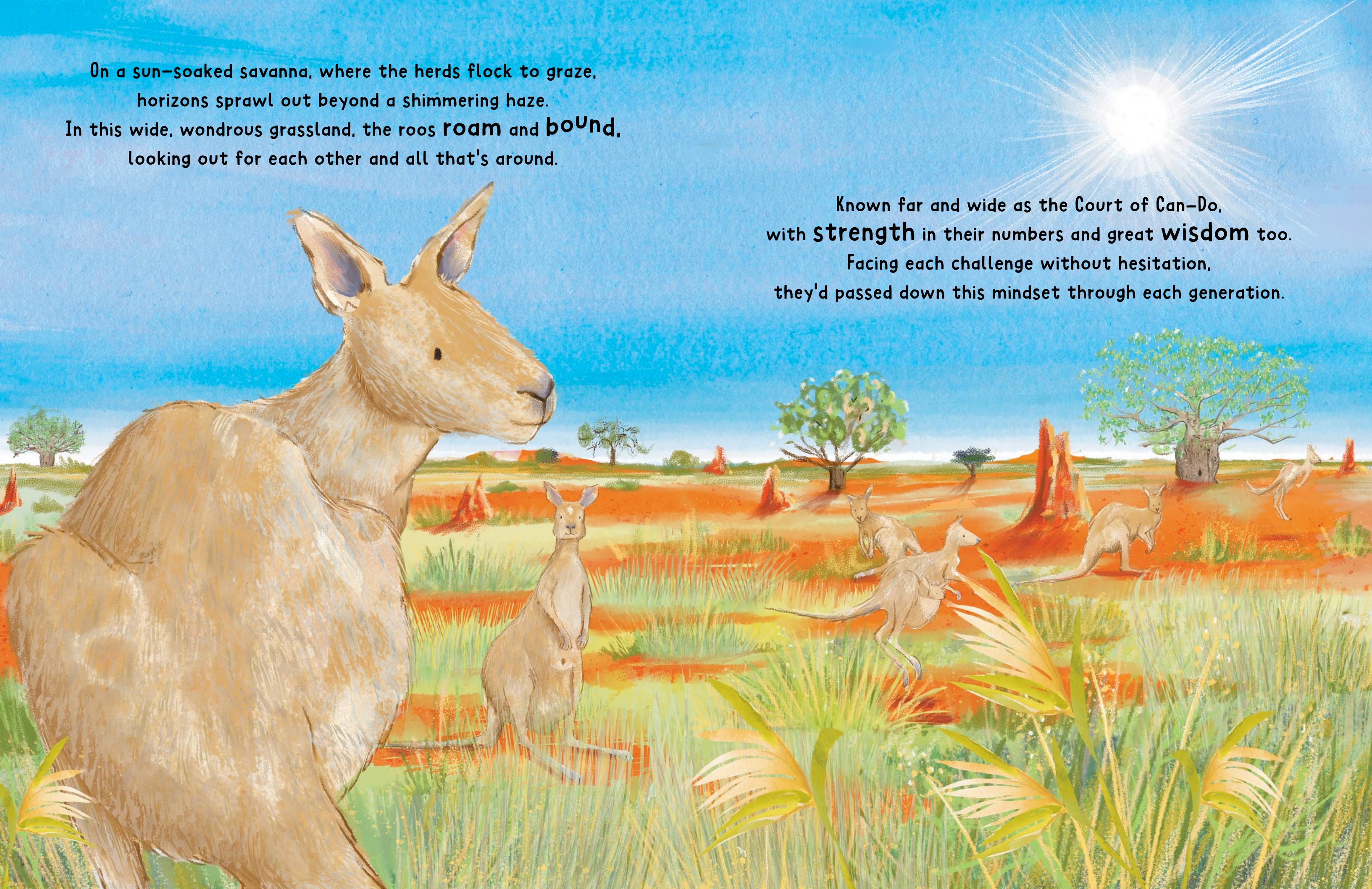
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On a sun-soaked savanna, where the herds flock to graze,
