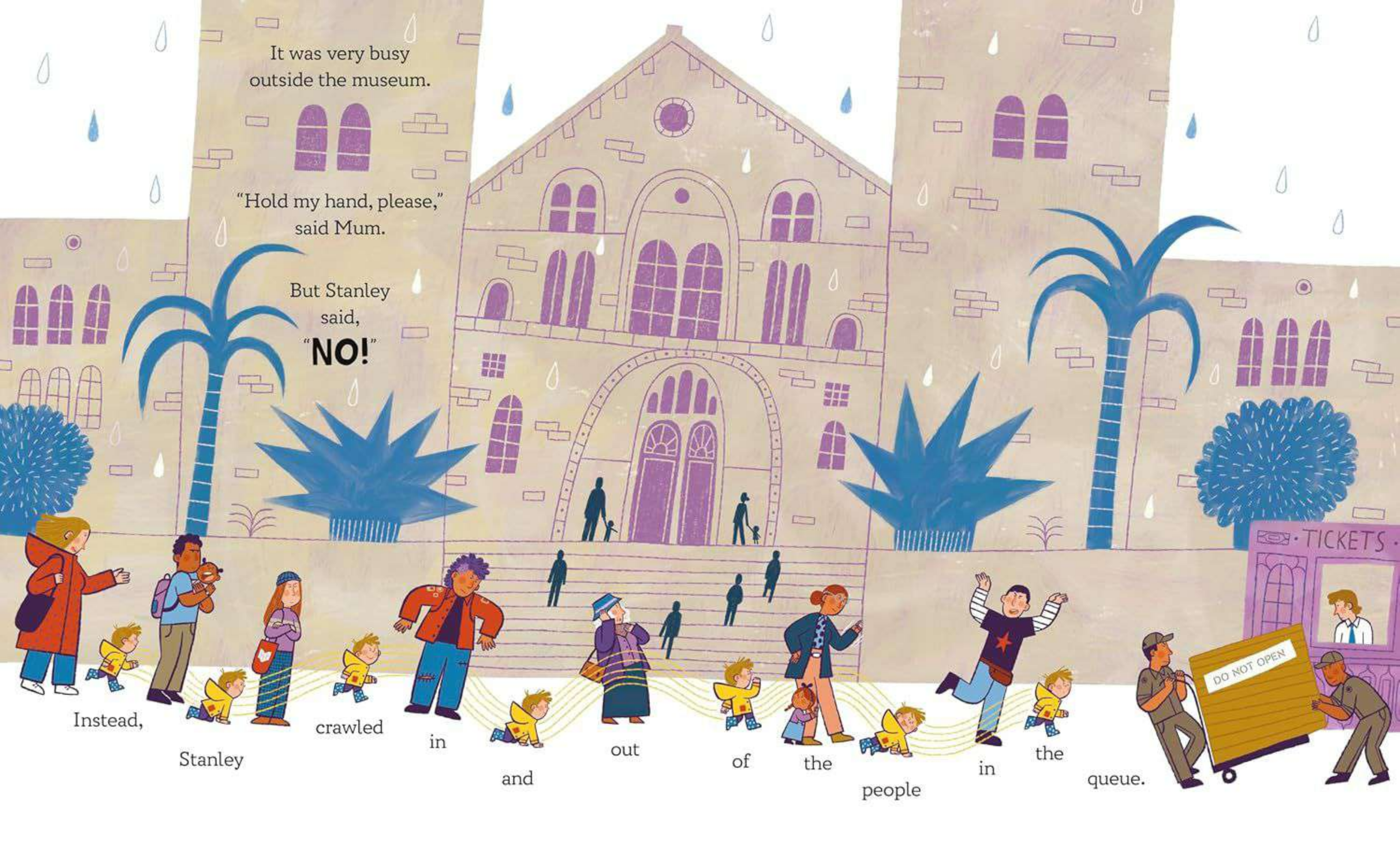

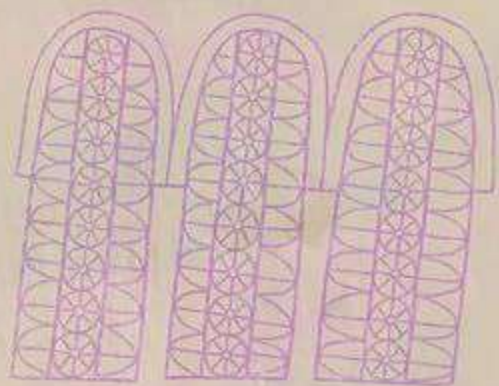

AND a Triceratops."



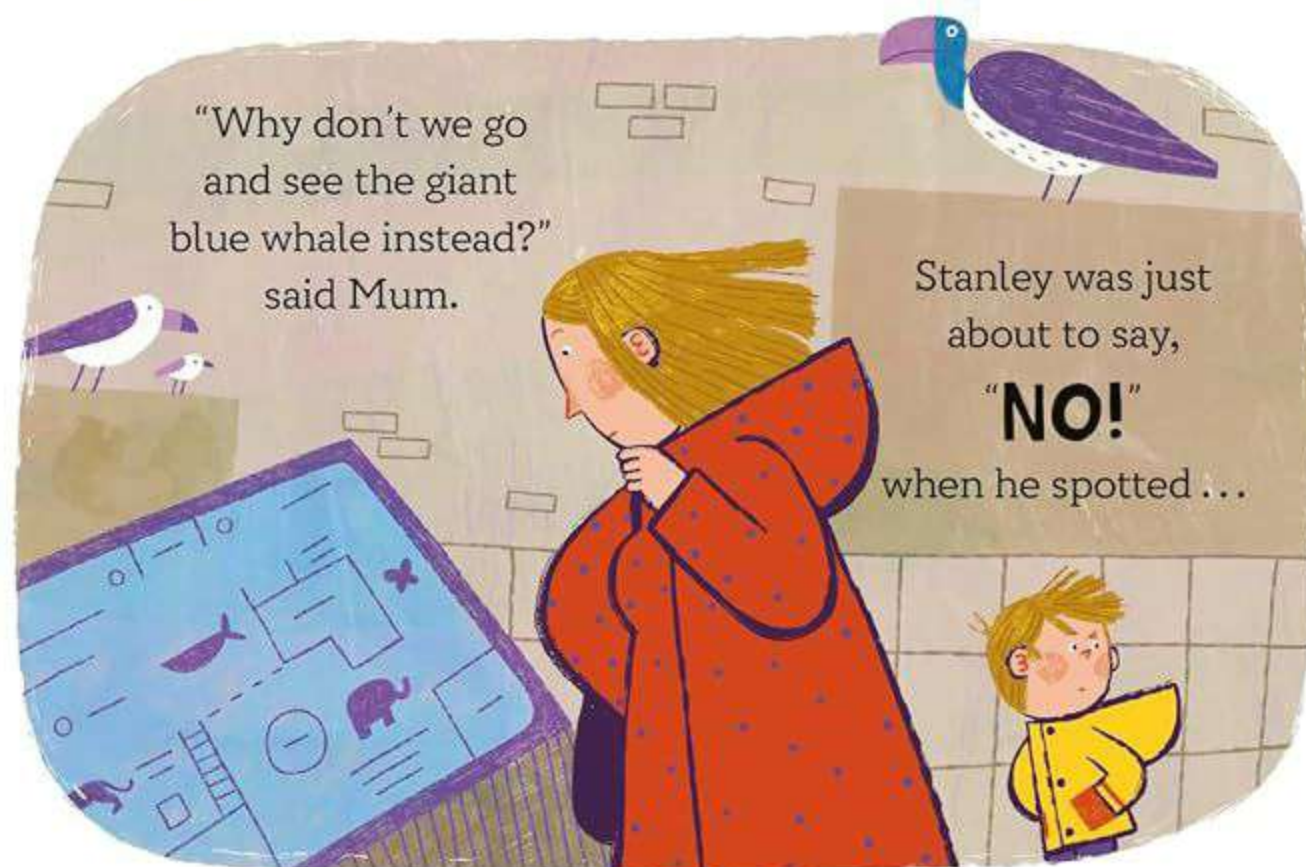
But Stanley
