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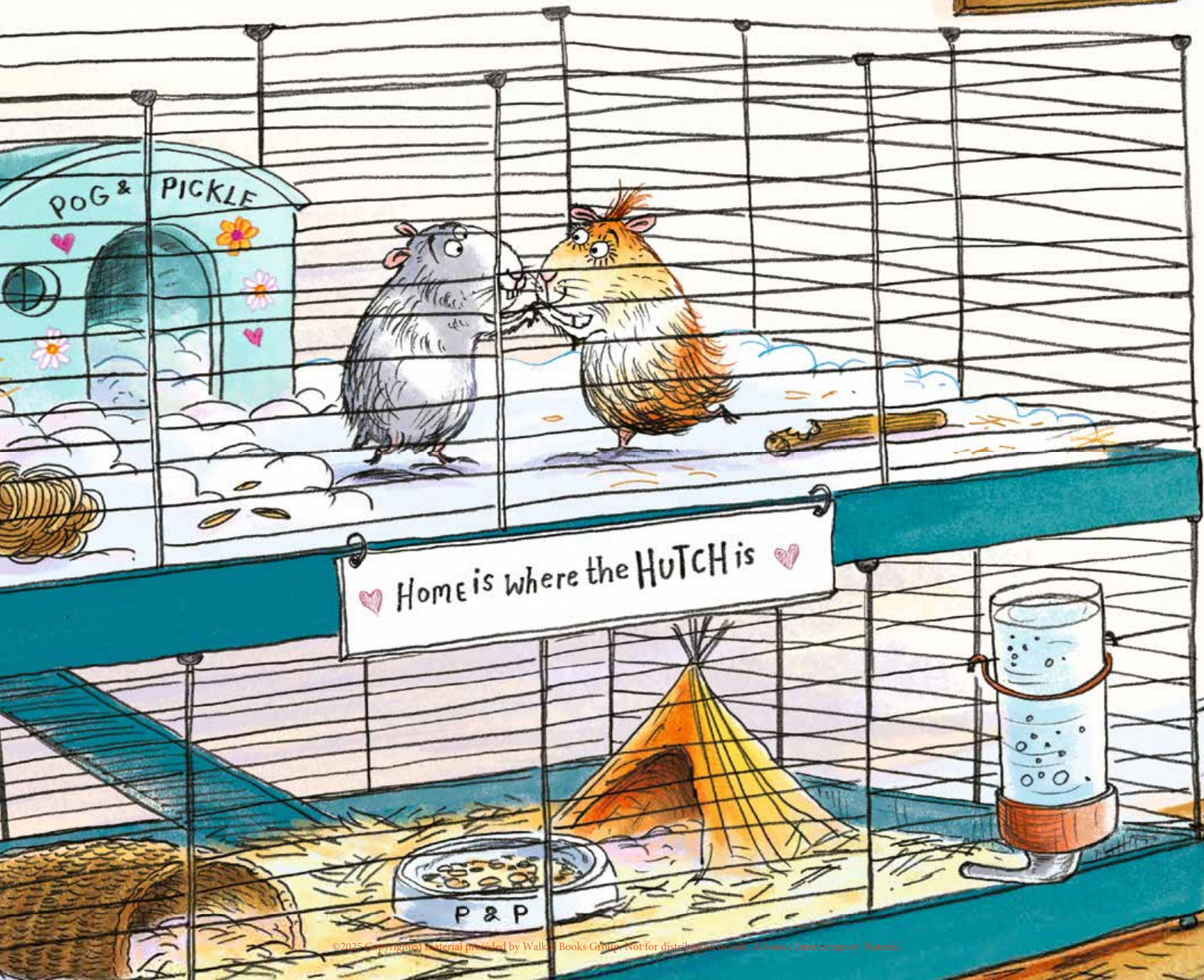
pog and Pickle's GREAT ESCAPE



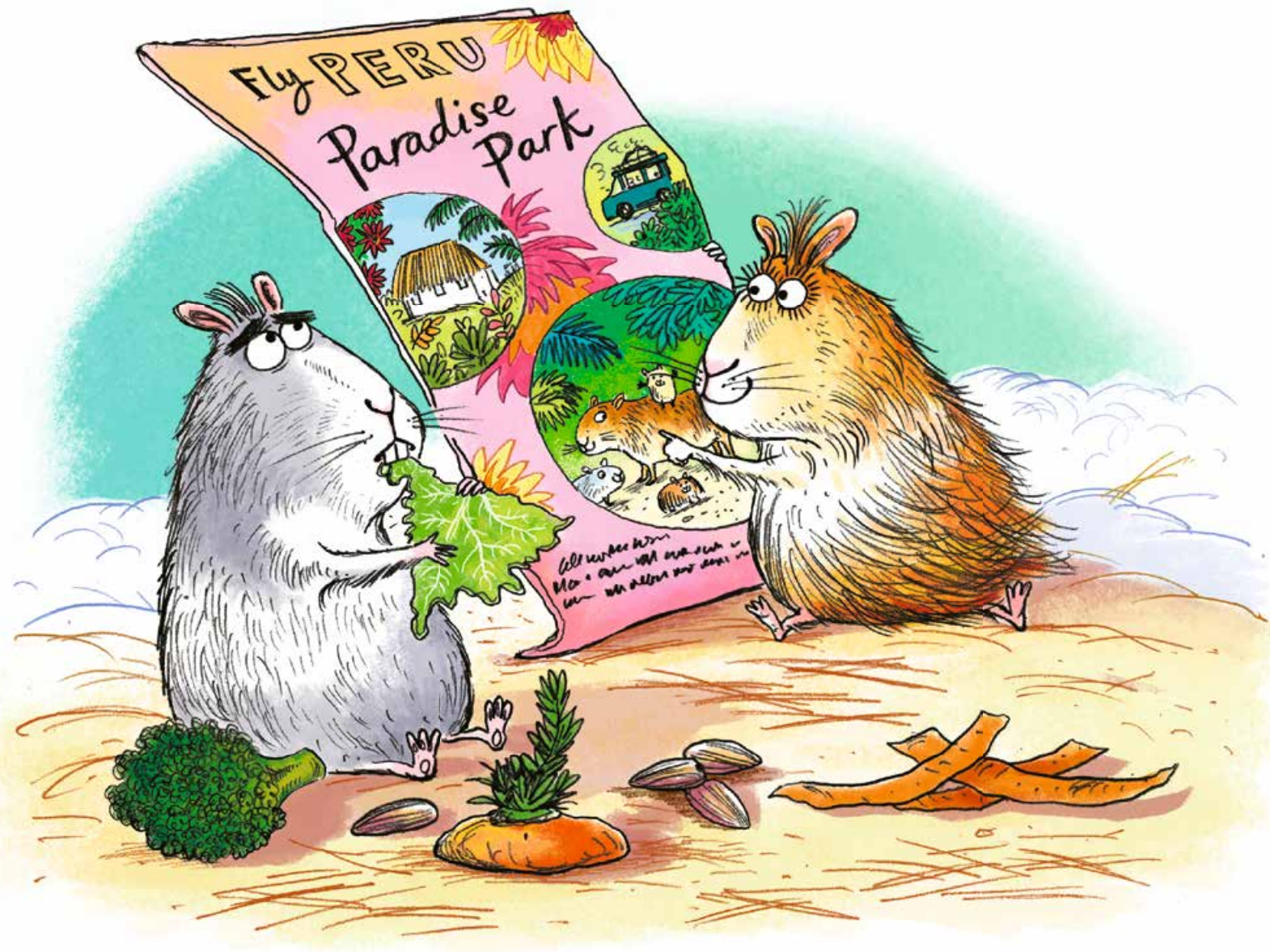

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There once was a house with a mummy and daddy,

A cat and a budgie, a fish and a dog...

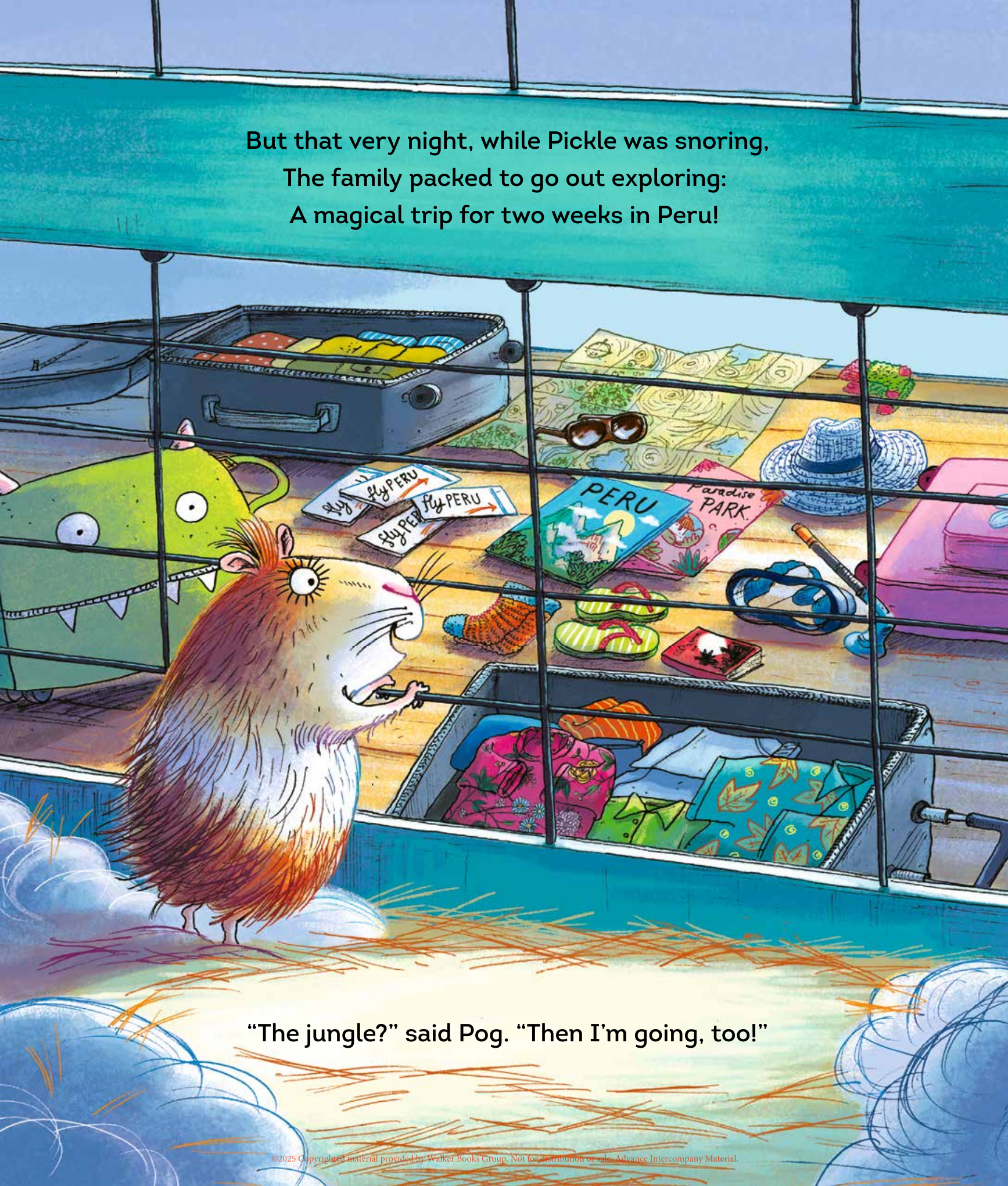
And a guinea pig pair named Pickle and Pog.
