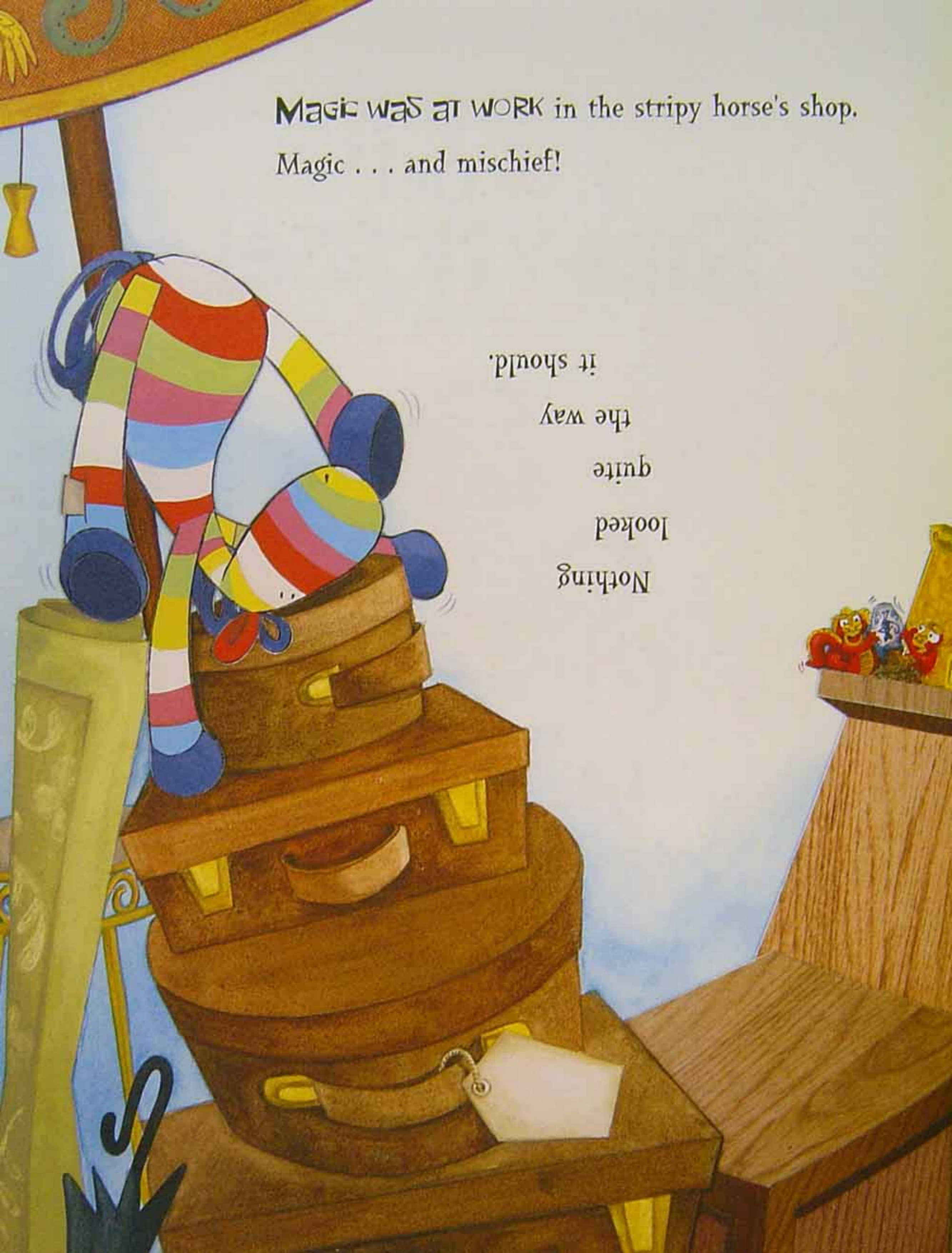

"I've been filled with pepper."



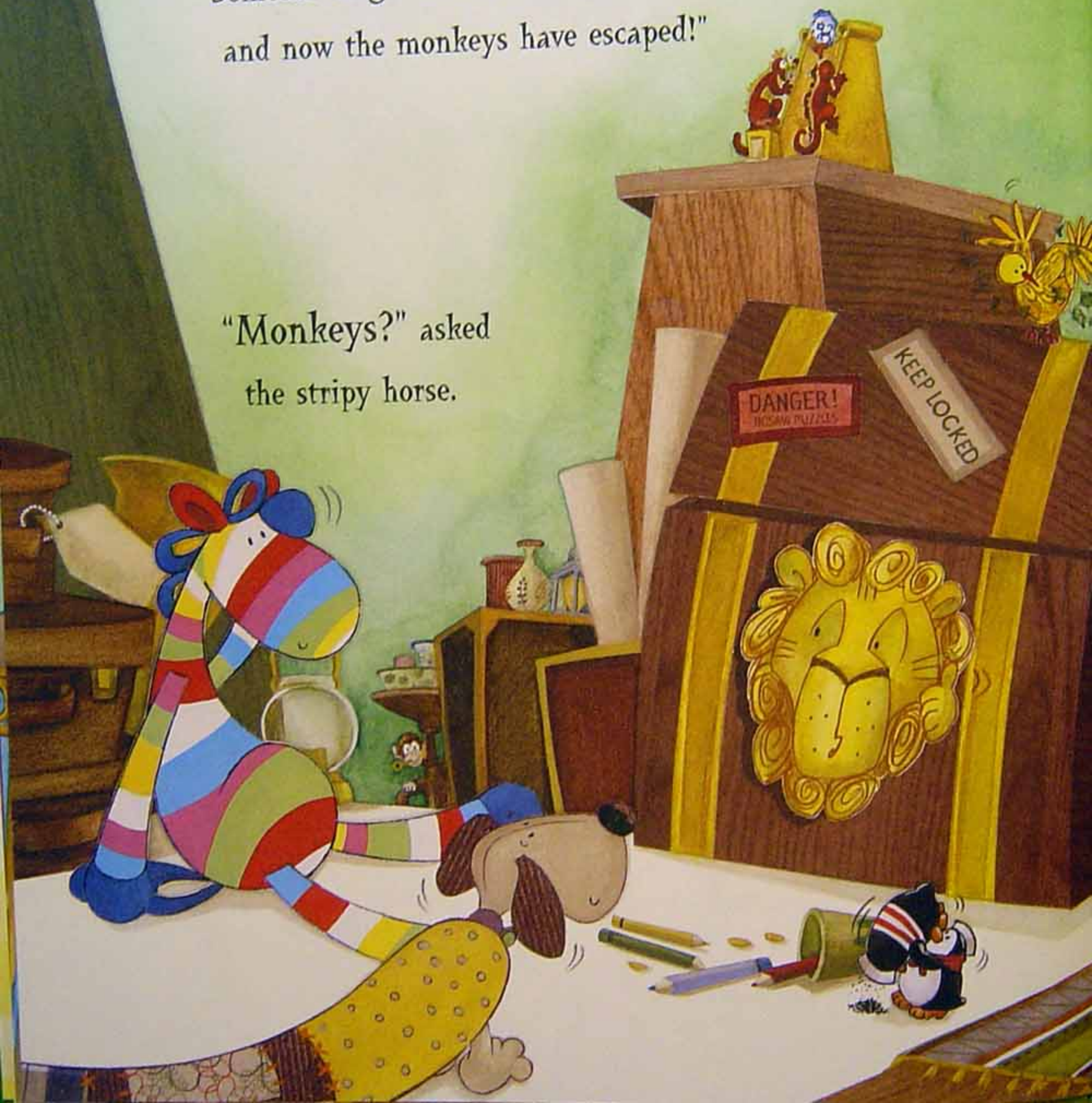
"And I've been been filled
