Stormy Weather

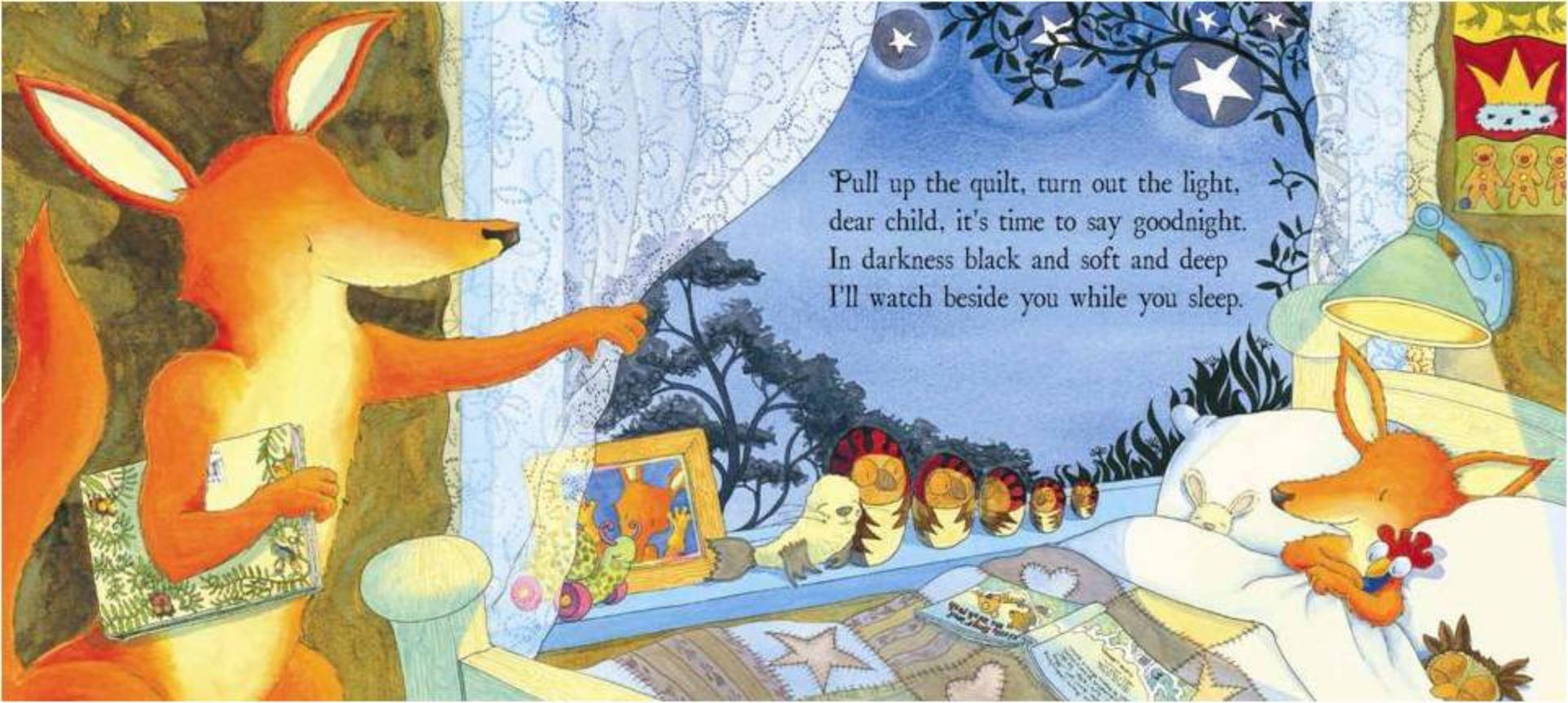
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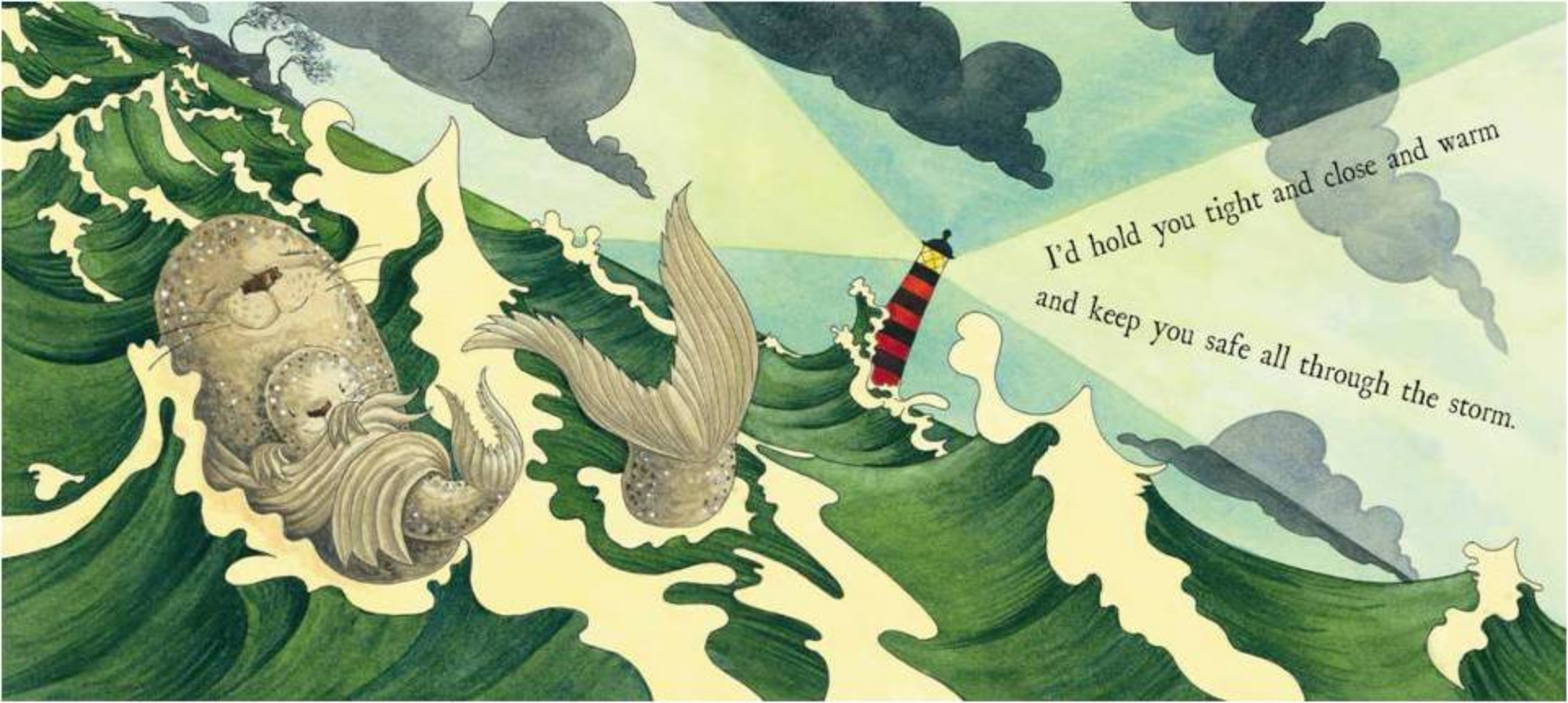


Pull up the quilt, turn out the light,
