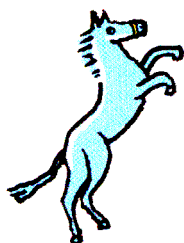

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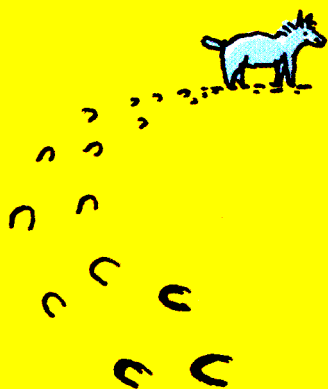
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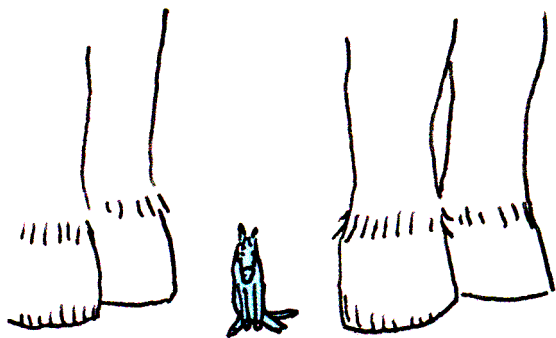

a very small horse.

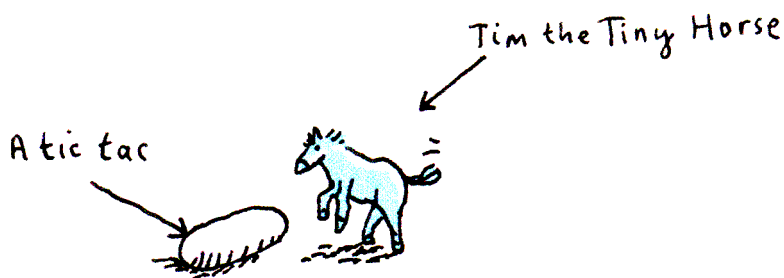
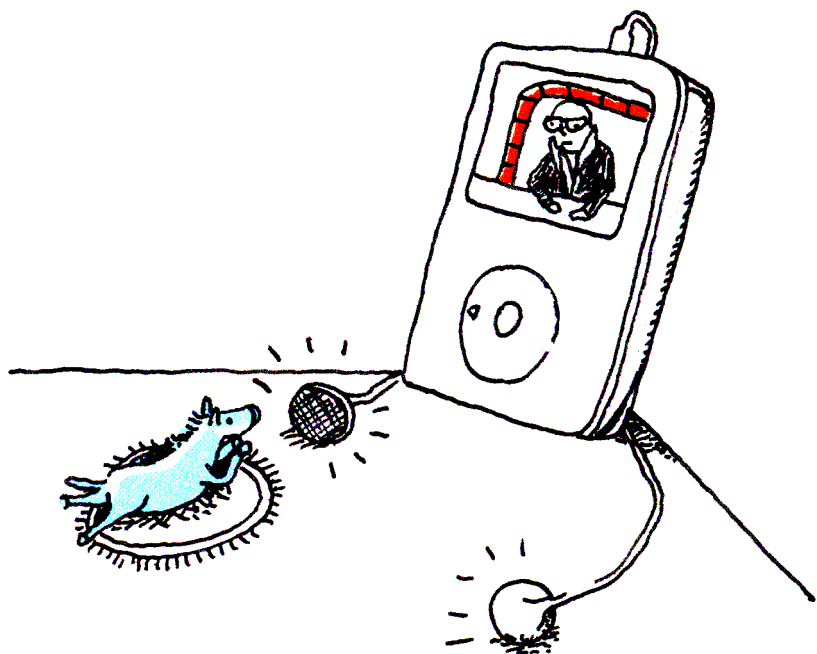
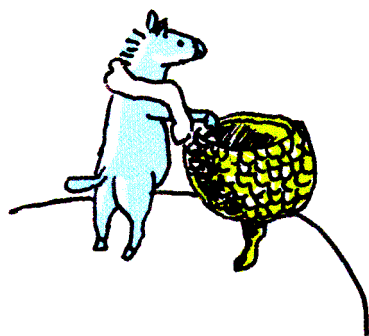


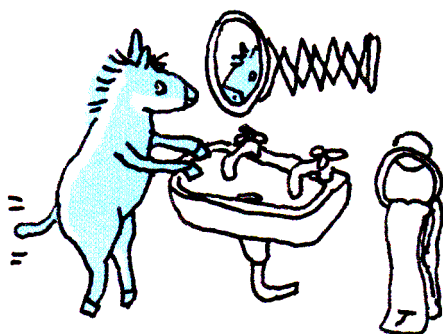
Diagram to show relative size
of Tim the Tiny Horse



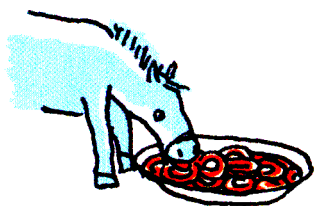
So small is he in fact that he could use an iPod as his main T.V., with the headphones as speakers (his ears are too small to need a sub-woofer) ... but he doesn't.



He is so small that he could use an acorn cup as a basin, but chooses not to.



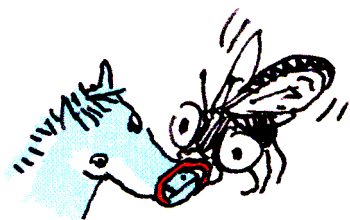
As he doesn't really go for that Rustic Look.



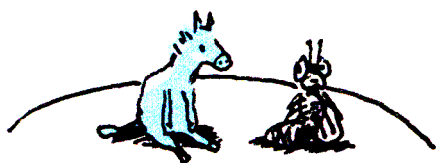
He is so small that on
