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Animals in the zoo

1 Someone starts by saying:



I went to the zoo and I saw a tiger and a...

2 The next person has to think of an animal that starts with the last letter of the animal that's been said.



They repeat the phrase, naming both animals:

I went to the zoo and I saw a tiger, a rhino and an ostrich...



4 Take it in turns to add animals, without repeating any.

5 Continue until someone can't think of an animal that follows on.

Beach target game



You need to be on a sandy beach to play this game.

1 Draw a line in damp sand with a stick. Find a smooth pebble for each person.






2 Six steps from the line, draw a small circle in the sand. Add a larger circle around it, then two more circles, like this:

3 Stand behind the line and take it in turns to throw a pebble onto the circles. You get points as follows:





Keep score in the sand: Fiona | Bex | Write five like this:

4 The first to 20 points wins.

Variation

If you're on your own, keep trying to beat your highest score.



Big fat spiders

Someone starts the game by asking someone else a simple question, such as:

What do you like to eat for lunch?

The other person replies:



Try not to laugh. If anyone laughs, they're out.

Someone else asks another question...

What do you brush your hair with?



...and the next person says:

Everyone has to keep trying not to laugh.

5 Keep taking it in turns to ask questions. Each time, someone else has to answer "Big fat spiders!".
