The Big Bottom Hunt

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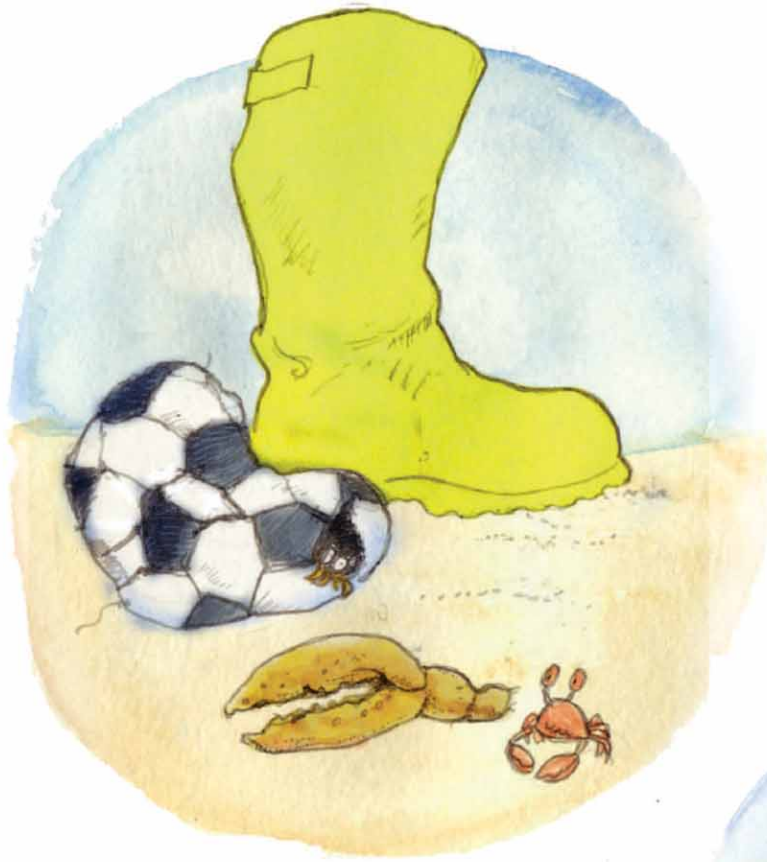
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On the day of the big bottom hunt, Sandy and Ella went beach-combing. They took a bucket, a net and a magnifying glass.
