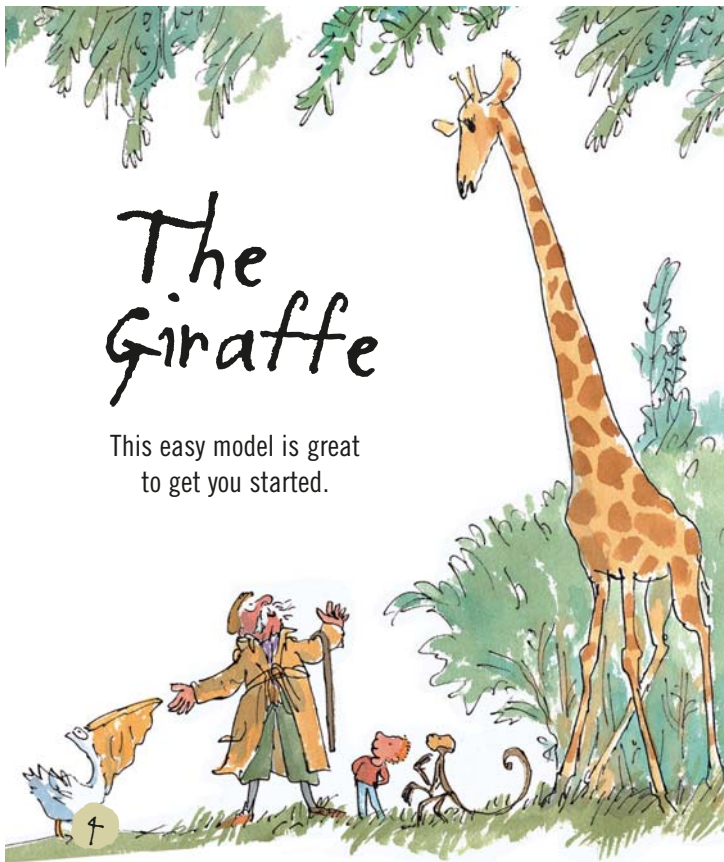

The Giraffe

This easy model is great to get you started.

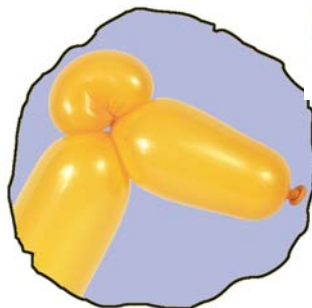


You Will Need:

- 1 long yellow balloon
- mini marker pen from kit
- a brown marker pen

Step 1

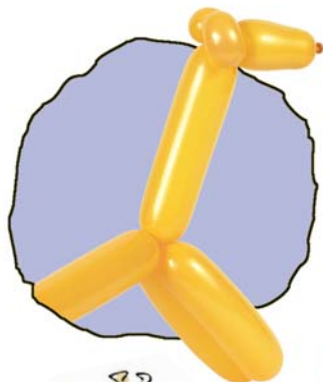
Nose: Inflate the balloon to 75 cm. Twist a 9 cm bubble at the knotted end. **Right Ear:** Twist a 4 cm bubble. Fold it back to the head and **ear-twist** the two together.



Step 2

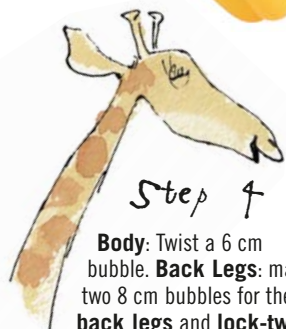
Left Ear: Twist another 4 cm bubble for the second ear. Bend this back in the same way as for the first, and **ear-twist** it in place behind the **nose**.





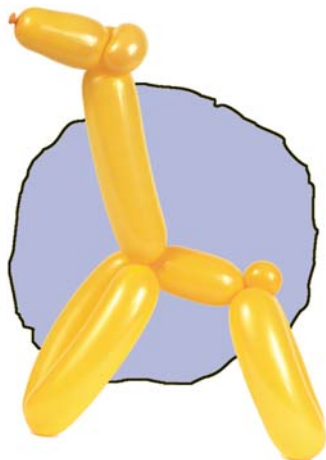
Step 3

Neck: Twist one 17 cm bubble.
Legs: Twist two 10 cm bubbles for the front legs. **Lock-twist** the legs together.



Step 4

Body: Twist a 6 cm bubble. **Back Legs:** make two 8 cm bubbles for the **back legs** and **lock-twist** them together. **Tail:** Formed by the remaining 8 cm of balloon.



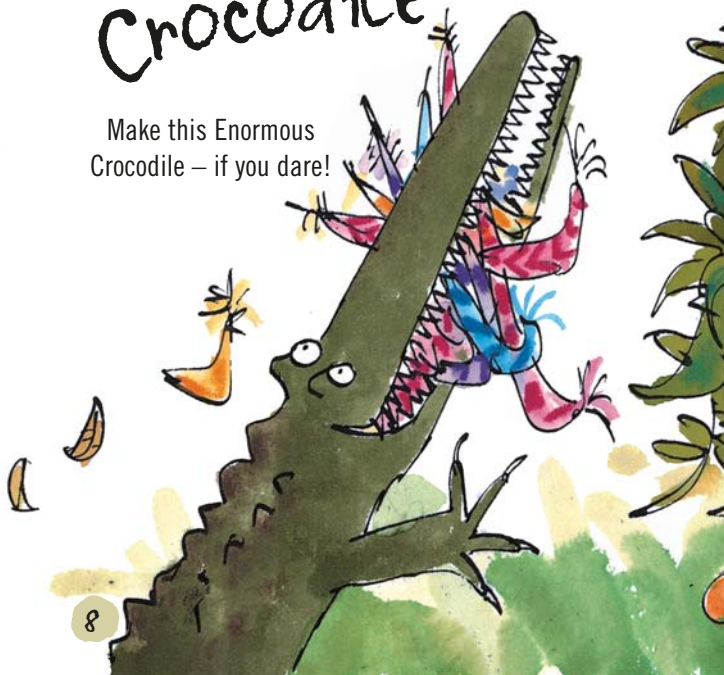
Step 5

Complete by drawing on eyes with the mini marker pen from the kit. Make your giraffe look more realistic by drawing on patches with a brown marker pen.



The Enormous Crocodile

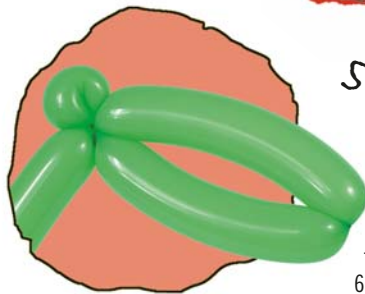
Make this Enormous Crocodile – if you dare!



You Will Need:

- 2 long green balloons
- 1 long white balloon
- mini marker pen from kit

Step 1



Jaws: Inflate a long green balloon leaving a 6 cm tip and make two 25 cm bubbles. Twist the knot in to join the bubbles together. **Neck:** Make a 6 cm **ear-twist**.

Step 2

Neck: Make two 8 cm bubbles and **lock-twist** them together. **Knobbles:** Twist three small bubbles and push them in-between the previous two **lock-twisted** bubbles. The remaining balloon forms one part of the body.
