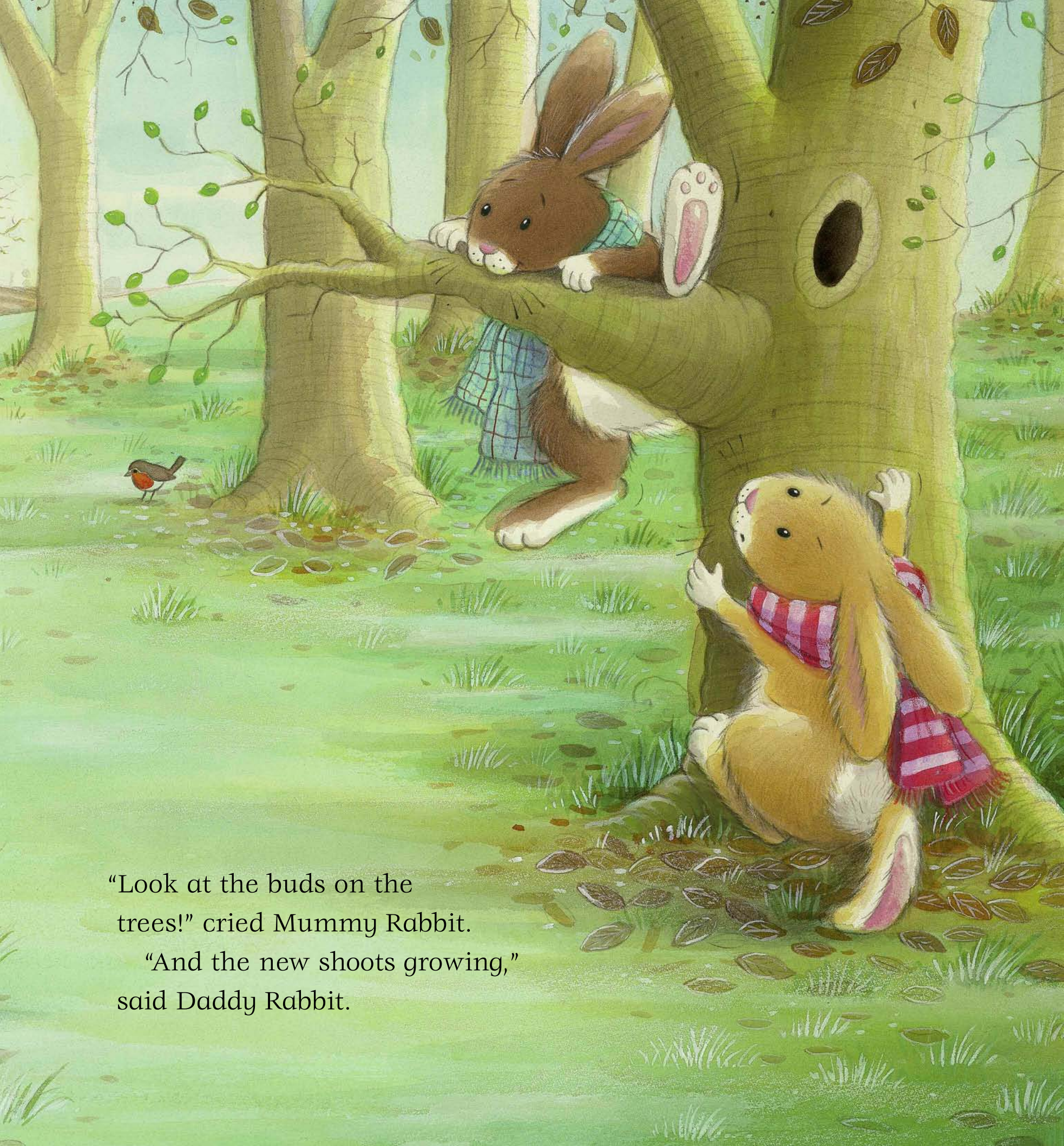

through the woods.



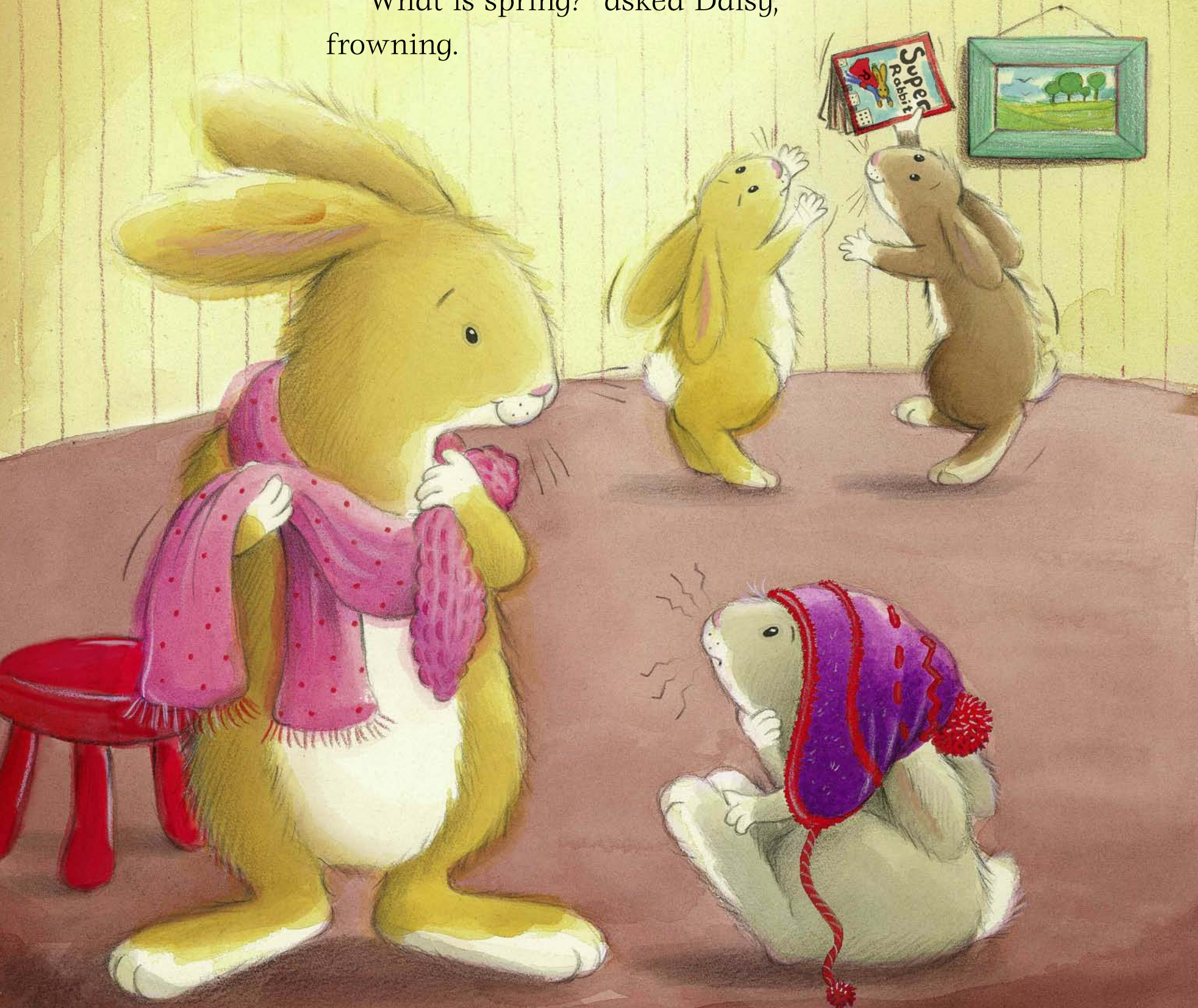


"Look at the buds on the trees!" cried Mummy Rabbit.
