The real story

Based on events that happened at Paignton Zoo Environmental Park, Devon, England, in June 2010.

It began when a small tawny owl chick landed in the lion enclosure at Paignton Zoo and came face-to-face with Indu, a seven-year-old female Asiatic lion. As the crowds gathered, worries over the owlet's safety grew, but a rescue attempt was impossible because zoo keepers could not enter the enclosure.

Lions are renowned as cunning hunters and deadly carnivores.

They can weigh in at up to 180kilos while the owlet would have been a matter of grams. The owlet could have been swallowed in one easy mouthful. Indu looked at the owlet and the owlet looked at Indu – but nothing more happened.
